### OFFENSE QUIET IN 4-0 LOSS TO KNIGHTS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were shut out 4-0 by the Charlotte Knights in Tuesday's series opener from Truist Field. **Dru Baker's** two-run home run in the second inning got the scoring started. The score remained that way until the eighth. Charlotte added a pair on an RBI single from **Jason Matthews** and a bases-loaded walk from **Jacob Gonzalez**. Jacksonville out-hit Charlotte 7-4, but the Jumbo Shrimp went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position and stranded nine runners on base. No Jumbo Shrimp advanced past second base.

### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville homered just two times in the seven games from May 2-9 - the fewest total of any Triple-A team. The Jumbo Shrimp have now gone deep in 13 of the last 14 games since that point, including an International League-season-best 13 consecutive contests from May 10-24. During these last 14 games, Jacksonville has bopped 29 long balls, the most of any team in Triple-A. Thus, 29 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 132 hits, or 22.0 percent, have been home runs since May 10.

### GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 562 strikeouts through 52 games, a rate of 10.8 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 57 more punchouts than Norfolk, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. Thus, the Tides' 505 strikeouts are closer to 12th-place St. Paul (455) than they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 87.2 average exit velocity against is the best such figure in Triple-A.

### ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

**Matthew Etzel** got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 17 contests, however, the League City, Texas native is a scorching 22-for-69 at the plate, slashing a robust .319/.390/.638/1.028 with two doubles, one triple, six home runs, 19 RBIs, eight walks and 19 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks tied for fourth in the IL in both homers and runs, tied for fifth in RBIs, 10th in SLG, 17th in OPS and tied for 19th in hits.

### MEN OF STEAL

The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp swiped 305 bases, blowing past the previous club record of 192 set by the 1979 Jacksonville Suns. The 2026 Jumbo Shrimp got off to a slower start in the steals department, with their 29 stolen bases through the season's first 24 games placing in a tie for 13th place in Triple-A. Since that point, however, has been a completely different story; Jacksonville's 64 steals are far and away the most in Triple-A since April 24. Second-place Syracuse's 48 steals are as close to 15th place as they are to the Jumbo Shrimp in first place. Moreover, Jacksonville's 86.5 percent success rate is sixth-best in Triple-A during this stretch.

### APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp lost for the eighth time in 11 games on April 30 at Durham, dropping the club a season-high 6.0 games out of first place in the International League. Since then, however, Jacksonville has rattled off 15 wins in the last 22 games, winning three of their last four series' in the process and slicing their deficit in the standings to just 2.5 games. Over these last 22 games, the Shrimp have outscored their opponents 138-102 (+36). The club is collectively hitting .267/.347/.456/.803 while holding their opponents to a .227/.328/.382/.710 line. Jacksonville has out-hit their opponents 206-160 over these last 22 games.

### ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs 21 times in the 30 games since. During this stretch, the club ranks eighth in Triple-A in runs (190, 6.3 per game). They also place in the top 11 in home runs (3rd, 42), hits (7th, 284), doubles (T-8th, 57), slugging (10th, .448), OPS (11th, .800) and average (11th, .269).

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A in defensive efficiency, turning 72.2 percent of balls put into play into outs... The Jumbo Shrimp are just 4-for-35 (.114) with runners in scoring position over the last three games... **Andrew Pintar** has a .960 OPS in his last 19 games.

### ABOUT BRANDON

-White was originally selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2018 draft out of W.F. West High School (Chehalis, Wash.). He opted to honor a commitment to play at Washington State University, where he appeared in 30 games, including 29 starts, over three seasons (8-12, 5.69 ERA, 131.1 IP, 153 H, 67 BB, 119 K).
