MOOSIC, PA (March 27, 2026) - The New York Yankees have announced the Opening Day roster for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. The initial 2026 roster for Manager Shelley Duncan features nine members of the 40-man roster, five of the Top-30 prospects in the Yankees farm system and 16 players with Major League service time.

Gil was the American League Rookie of the Year in 2024. Lagrange and Rodríguez are ranked as the #2 and #3 prospects in the Yankees' system according to MLB Pipeline. Jones (6), Beck (22) and Cohen (28) are also members of the top-30 in the organization.

Thirteen players on the initial roster have played for Duncan during his tenure with the RailRiders. DeJong paces all players with over eight years of Major League service time and 925 big league games.

NEWS & NOTES

COMING OUT ON TOP - The RailRiders took 14 of the 18 games against the Bison last season. The team was 8-4 in matches played on the road. Only one contest was postponed due to rain and SWB rapped up their summer at Sahlen Field. Back in 2024 the RailRiders went 16-7 against their Toronto counterpart.

BECK'S BEEN HERE BEFORE - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's opening day starter is Yankees #22 prospect Brendan Beck. Last summer, Beck began his season in Double-A but was promoted to the RailRiders on June 22. In 15 games started, the righty threw held an 8-3 record for a 4.44 earned run average. In 77.0 innings pitched he allowed just 38 walks to 115 strikeouts. The 27-year-old was acquired in the 2nd round of the 2021 draft out of Stanford University.

OPENING DAY SPLIT - In the last team years of Opening Day's SWB is exactly 5-5 in its record. During that time the first contest of the summer has been postponed once in Buffalo (2017) and cancelled once altogether (2020). For the start of the 2025 season, the RailRiders Opening Day fell on Friday, March 28 at Lehigh Valley. The Yankees farm team dropped to the Phillies prospects 5-4.

SEMIQUINCENTENNIAL VICTORY - Manager Shelley Duncan has been in charge of the RailRiders since the 2023 season. Since then he has guided his team to 249 wins over the course of three summers. This puts the skipper 3rd on the all time in wins on Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's managerial history. Duncan is behind Dave Miley (714) and Marc Bombard (574).

ABOUT OSWALDO - The Yankees assigned utility player Oswaldo Cabrera to their roster to start off the season. The 27-year-old has spent over three years of service time on the big league roster. After batting .243 with 11 home runs in 34 games last season, Cabrera exited the game on May 12 at Seattle with a left ankle fracture after a collision at home plate in the ninth inning. A pretty gruesome injury. He underwent surgery on his left ankle on 5/15. The switch hitter played in 10 spring training games to prepare, hitting .211 with two walks and four strikeouts. Oswaldo showed defensively at second base, shortstop, third base, and right field.

THE MARTIAN LANDS - The other wordly outfielder joins the RailRiders roster after spending the entirety of 2025 with the Yankees. In 123 games with NYY, he hit .257/.331/.388 (98-for-381) with 58R, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 10HR, 47RBI, 41BB, 3HP, 4SF and 23SB. Domínguez appeared defensively in left field in 100 contests. The switch hitter was on both of the Yankees' ALWCSS and ALDS rosters. He appeared in one postseason game, going 1-for-1 with 1R and 1 double in ALDS Game 4 vs. Toronto.

THE RIVALRY - The Triple-A Yankees and Blue Jays prospects have matched up quite a bit throughout the years. The RailRiders have the edge with 260 victories to the Bisons' 219 wins. The two teams will play each other in three separate series this summer including this opening weekend at Sahlen Field. SWB and Buffalo will play six games at PNC Field from April 28-May 3 and then not again until they have a half-a-dozen more from July 1-July 12 at the Bison's home.

MARCH MADNESS - The first ever Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's game in March came on the 31st of the month back in 2023. The RailRiders topped the Bison 2-1 at home. The next season three total contests were played in March where SWB went 2-1. In 2025, they fell 1-2 in the third month of the year. So the RailRiders are currently 4-3 in March and will look to add to the early victories. The team will play an unprecedented four contests in March.

SCOUTS SAY: "Beck's control and command are more impressive than any of his individual pitches, the best of which is a solid low-80s slider with two-plane depth. His low-90s fastball peaks at 94 mph without much life and his upper-70s downer curveball are both fringy but he survives because he locates them well. He has little faith in a low-80s changeup with modest sink. A good athlete, Beck repeats his delivery with ease while working fast. Not only does he fill the strike zone better than any Yankees farmhand, but he also moves his offerings around all four quadrants to keep hitters off balance."

PERSONAL: Full name is Brendan Thomas Beck... pitched four years at Stanford (2018-21), going 22-10 with a 3.11 ERA, 15V and 2CG (289.1IP, 257H, 122R/100ER, 69BB, 289K, 24HR) in 55G/46GS... earned Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and All-Pac-12 First-Team honors in 2021 after going 9-3 with a 3.15 ERA (108.2IP, 38ER) in 17 games (15 starts)... was named a First-Team All-American by the ABCA (American Baseball Coaches Association) in 2021... was tabbed by Baseball America as the No. 80 overall prospect in the 2021 Draft... his older brother, Tristan, is a pitcher in the Giants organization.
