

SHOREBIRDS EDGED BY ONE IN FIRST HALF FINALE: The Delmarva Shorebirds came up short in a back-andforth affair against the Augusta GreenJackets in the final game of the first half. Delmarva cashed in on an early in the third that scored Noelberth Romero to make it 1-0 Shorebirds. Augusta took the lead in the fourth on a two-run double by **Andrew Keck.** They'd tack onto that lead an inning later with an RBi single by **Ethan Workinger** to extend the advantage to 3-1. In the bottom half of the frame, the Shorebirds reclaimed the lead with thanks to an error with the bases loaded off the bat of Samuel Basallo to score a run, followed by a tworun single by **Trendon Craig** to put Delmarva in front 4-3. But the GreenJackets would tie the game in the sixth with a successful first-and-third steal, and then took the lead for good in the ninth on an RBI single by **Bryson** Worrell as the GreenJackets would top the Shorebirds 5-4 in final game of the first half.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Bradley Brehmer draws the start to open the second half for Delmarva and he'll the first round pick of the Atlanta Braves from last July, **Owen Murphy.** Murphy was the 20th overall pick as a standout, two-way player out of Riverside-Brookfield High School in Illinois but the Braves signed him on as a pitcher at tonight marks his 11th start of the season. The right-hander had a strong start to the season in April with an ERA of 1.59 in three short starts but his ERA in June is 11.42, allowing 11 earned runs in 8.2 innings with 5 strikeouts and 7 walks.

BACK LIKE HE NEVER LEFT: Trendon Craig has had an instant impact for the for the Shorebirds since rejoining the team on June 9 after two months on the IL. In ten games since returning, Craig has a batting average of .351 (13/37) and has collected 4 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI, while also stealing 5 bases. Craig has reached in all 16 games he's played in and his current streak is the best run by a Delmarva hitter this season.

MOVING UP THE LADDER: Samuel Basallo's strong first season in affiliated baseball has elevated him to inside the Top 100 overall prospects for Baseball America as he comes in at No. 80 on the mid-season list. Basallo is now ranked the No. 7 prospect in a deep, Oriole's farm system and he is one of eight Baltimore prospects currently in the top 100.

GETTING OVER THE HUMP: The Shorebirds have played in a lot of close games this season and will look for better fortunes in the second half. Through the first 65 games, Delmarva is 3-10 in one-run games and are 4-32 in games where they are either tied or behind after seven innings. The Shorebirds are also 1-5 in extra innings, scoring just one run in extras in those five losses combined.

STARTING FRESH: Delmarva will look to turn the page into the second half after a tough ending to the first. The Shorebirds entered May 28 down just one game in the standings but since then are 5-17, the worst mark in the league in that span, falling to 11 games behind first-half champion Down East.

CLEANING UP THE DEFENSE: Since May 9, the Shorebirds defense has been up-and-down as they've committed a Carolina league-high 61 errors. Those 61 hiccups in the field have resulted in 37 unearned runs, also the most in the league during in that span.

ANOTHER ONE GOES UP: Starting pitcher Juan Nunez is the latest Delmarva player to earn a promotion to High-A Aberdeen. He is now the sixth member of the Shorebirds' Opening Day Roster to move up, joining Jackson Holliday, Maxwell Costes, Creed Willems, Douglas Hodo, and Reese Sharp.

LET'S TURN IT AROUND: The Shorebirds are hoping to get back on track with the second half set to begin this week against a team that had their number in 2022, the Augusta GreenJackets. Last season, the affiliate of the Atlanta Braves were 11-1 against the Shorebirds including a six-game sweet at Perdue Stadium in early August.

TODAY'S STARTER: Bradley Brehmer gets the ball to begin the second half of the season as he makes his team-high 11th start of 2023.

LAST OUTING (6/16 vs SAL): Brehmer took a no-decision last time out against the Salem Red Sox by allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 8 hits last Friday night. Salem did the bulk of their damage in the fourth inning as they scored five runs on him to quickly erase a 5-0 deficit. The Red Sox would go on to win the game 10-6.

vs. AUGUSTA: This will be the first time Brehmer faces the Augusta GreenJackets in his career.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched his final year of college at the University of Indiana after three seasons at Wright State. Made 17 appearances, 14 as a starter and earned a 5-4 record with a 5.30 ERA. The sinker baller collected 77 strikeouts with 33 walks across 74.2 total innings with his top performance of the season coming on April 23 versus Nebraska where he dealt 6 innings on the mound and stuck out a season-best 11 Corn Huskers. Allowed just 1 run on 3 hits as his quality start led the Hoosiers to an 8-1. Was selected by the Orioles in the 12th Round of the 2022 Draft.

STAYING GROUNDED: Brehmer has been one of the best ground ball pitchers not just on the Shorebirds, but across all of Single-A. The sinker specialist leads the team with 9 double plays on the ground, which is also tied for the most in A-Ball. He's created the most ground ball outs in the Carolina League with 74 as he owns a strong 2.21/1 ground out/air out ratio.



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

HITTING COACH



Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

DEVELOPMENT COACH



Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization. Prior to joining the Orioles, Murray worked with three other MLB clubs (Tigers, Marlins, and Angels), most recently as a Baseball Information Assistant with the Detroit Tigers in 2021.
