LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones earned their 8th-straight home victory with a 2-0 shutout vs. Aberdeen on Tuesday night...RHP Brendan Girton struck out 8 over 4.2 innings of 2-hit ball, walking 1...RHP Eduardo Herrera (1.0 IP), LHP Ryan Ammons (1.1), and RHP Brian Metoyer (2.0) combined for 4.1 innings of 2-hit scoreless relief to seal Brooklyn's 4th shutout win of the year...The game's only 2 runs scored in the 6th on 2B Marco Vargas' 2-run single...3B Boston Baro added 2 hits, including a double.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn is 1.5 games back of first-place Greensboro (32-13) and 1.5 games up on third-place Hudson Valley (29-16) with 20 games remaining in the first half... Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half...Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./ at Aberdeen).

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park on Tuesday with a 2-0 victory vs. Aberdeen...The triumph was the Cyclones' 8th-consecutive home win...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 17-5 (.772)...No one else in the league has more than 14 home victories (Greensboro and Hudson Valley)...The 17 home wins are tied with Detroit's High-A West Michigan for the most at the High-A level... Miami's Triple-A Jacksonville has recorded the most home wins in Minor League Baseball (21).

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in Friday's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit. 647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059), and OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week last week, it is the first time Brooklyn hitters have won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has reached safely in 19-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .375.487/.563/1.050 with 14 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 18 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 13 walks to 7 strikeouts...Báez had a 10-game hitting streak since May 15 vs. Winston-Salem snapped on Tuesday...He went 16-for-30 (.533) at the plate with 9 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 12 RBI, and 7 walks to 1 strikeout...Last Tuesday, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...During May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (21) and is 2nd in batting average (.361), on-base percentage (.471), tied for 3rd in hits (26), 4th in OPS (1.040), tied for 7th in total bases (41), and tied for 8th in slugging percentage (.569).

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore...The 2024 first-round pick enters Wednesdy tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also tied for 2nd in runs scored (35), 3rd in OPS (.975) and on-base percentage (.444), tied for 3rd in doubles (11), 4th in slugging percentage (.531) and extra-base hits (19), 5th in walks (32), tied for 5th in total bases (76), and 6th in hits (45)...The 22-year-old had an 11-game hitting streak since May 8 at Asheville snapped last Friday, but has reached base safely in 19-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .344/.506/.672/1.178 with 19 runs scored, 6 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 20 walks to 14 strikeouts, and 7 stolen bases.

CAN EW BELIEVE IT?: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week last Monday...In 5 games vs. Winston-Salem, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Wednesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is 3rd in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.365) and stolen bases (33), tied for 3rd in triples (6), and 8th in on-base percentage (.457)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (19)...He is also 2nd in hits (31), tied for 4th in triples (2), 5th in batting average (.341), tied for 5th in runs scored (19), 7th in on-base percentage (.419), and tied for 10th in total bases (43)...The 2023 4th-round pick enters Wednesday riding a 30-game on-base streak since April 18.... During the on-base streak, Ewing has hit .348/.445/.487/.932 with 24 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 16 RBI, 20 walks, and 26 stolen bases.

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season... The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Entering play on Wednesday, Reimer is tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (26), tied for 7th in doubles (16), and tied for 9th in OPS (.997)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (38), OPS (.997), extra-base hits (26), doubles (16), and hits (51)...Reimer is also 2nd in slugging percentage (.588), total bases (94), RBI (34), and batting average (.319), tied for 5th in triples (3), 7th in on-base percentage (.409), and tied for 8th in home runs (7).

REHAB REPORT: The Cyclones have a pair of rehabbers on their current roster... RHP Frankie Montas is scheduled to make his 2nd Major League rehab start on Thursday night vs. Aberdeen on SNY...The 32-year-old is currently on New York's 60-day injured list with a right lat strain...Montas made his 1st start on Saturday

vs. ABERDEEN: After taking 4-of-7 from Jersey Shore, Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game series with the Iron-Birds...Aberdeen enters the series after splitting a 6-game homestand with Wilmington...The IronBirds are 12-13 on the road this season and dropped 4-of-6 to Brooklyn in Aberdeen from April 15-20...Aberdeen boasts 8 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Vance Honeycutt (5), INF Griff O'Ferrall (7), RHP Michael Forret (8), RHP Trey Gibson (15), INF Aron Estrada (16), C Ethan Anderson (18), INF Leandro Arias (21), OF Austin Overn (30)...Forret is currently on the injured list...In 270 meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 142-128 (.526)...Brooklyn is 73-71 (.507) in 144 games at Maimonides Park.

at Jersey Shore, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits, walking 2 and striking out 1, over 1.1 innings and 37 pitches...The Dominican native signed a 2-year, \$34 million deal with the Mets in December...OF **Rafael Ortega** rejoined Brooklyn on Tuesday for his 2nd Minor League rehab stint with the club in 2025...The 34-year-old appeared in 6 games for the Cyclones between April 12-20, going 2-for-24 (.083) at the plate with a double and 2 RBI...Ortega signed a Minor League deal with New York in November.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...
The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Wednesday with 103 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (121), and tied for 9th in Minor League Baseball...Miami's High-A Beloit leads MiLB (133)...The 103 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 46 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 31 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 72 steals through 46 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: With May 18's 7-6 walk-off victory vs. Winston-Salem in 10 innings, the Cyclones completed their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...It was the first time the team had won 6-straight games since September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...The Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown during that win streak...Additionally, the Cyclones' 31-15 record through 46 games is tied for the franchise's best record through 46 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)... Brooklyn opened the 2007 and 2010 seasons with a 31-15 mark through 46 contests.

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 46 games of the 2025 season on Sunday at Jersey Shore...Through Brooklyn's first 8 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 6-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 3-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 8-0-2 in a series of any length.

MARCO POLO: IF Marco Vargas has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the end of April...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 20 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 34 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 34-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting .287/.399/.361/.760 with 25 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 19 RBI, 23 walks, and 11 stolen bases.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning on May 9 at Asheville... RF Eli Serrano III, DH A.J. Ewing, and CF Carson Benge clubbed back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP Yeriel Santos...lt marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...2B Luke Ritter, 1B Joe Genord, and C José Mena first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS Jesús Báez added a 4th home run in the frame, marking the first time in Mil.B's Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in Mil.B this season... Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 126 vs. Knoxville...Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa blasted 5 home runs in the 7th inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul...Brooklyn enters Wednesday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (41)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (49) has hit home runs through the team's first 46 games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and OF A.J. Ewing (27)...Of those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Fell one out shy of qualifying for the victory last Thursday at Jersey Shore, settling for a no-decision...Yielded 1 run on 4 hits over 4.2 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 7...Surrendered a solo home run to 3B **Carson DeMartini** in the bottom of the 1st...Threw a season-high 91 pitches and 62 strikes (68.13%)...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** with a runner at 1st and 2 out in the bottom of the 5th and Brooklyn leading 3-1...Bequeathed runner did not score...Beck (1.1 IP), RHP **Ben Simon** (2.0), and RHP **Saúl García** (1.0) combined to twirl 4.1 innings of 1-hit shutout relief to seal a 4-1 Cyclones win.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Registered a no-decision in his professional debut on 4/8 vs. HV (4.1 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st victory of his pro career piggybacking off Major League rehabber RHP Paul Blackburn on 4/19 @ABD (4.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...Struck out a career-high 9 over a career-long 5.0 innings to earn the win on 4/25 @JS (5.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 9 K)...Picked up the win piggybacking off of Blackburn again on 5/2 vs. WIL (4.1 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K)...Tossed a career-long 6.0 innings, earning the victory, on 5/14 vWS (6.0 IP, 2 H, R, ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...Punched out 7 over 4.2 innings in a no-decision on 5/22 @JS (4.2 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 7 K).

DUCK TALES: Gordon spent his four-year collegiate career at the University of Oregon...As a junior in 2024, the Santa Clarita, Calif. native accumulated a 7-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER in 94.2 IP), 46 walks, and 87 strikeouts in 17 starts for the Ducks...Gordon was named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention...Recognized on the University's Dean's List in the Winter of 2023...Served as Oregon's Opening Day starter in 2024...Was the Game 1 starter in every regular-season series, as well as the Santa Barbara Regional and the Bryan-College Station Super Regional...Led the PAC-12 in games started (17)...Also ranked 2nd in innings pitched (94.2), tied for 3rd in wins (7), and 8th in strikeouts (87)...Gordon was initially recruited to Eugene as a two-way player.

ON THE MEND: The 23-year-old returned to the bump for the Ducks in 2024 after missing and redshirting the entire 2023 season due to a UCL injury that required internal brace surgery to correct...Despite missing an entire campaign, Gordon still finished his career at Oregon tied for 10th in program history in games started (28)...Finished his college career with a 14-9 record, a 5.22 ERA (106 ER in 182.2 IP), 1 save, 89 walks, and 155 strikeouts in 51 appearances (28 starts).

SUMMER FUN: Following his freshman season at Oregon, Gordon spent his summer of 2021 pitching for the Bend (Ore.) Elks of the West Coast League...In four starts, the right-hander posted a 2-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (10 ER in 22.2 IP), 7 walks, and 29 strikeouts...Gordon was teammates with a pair of former Cyclones that summer, spending time on the pitching staff with LHP **Eli Ankeney** (2023) and RHP **Kade Morris** (2024).

BOTH WAYS: Gordon finished his high school career at West Ranch High School in Stevenson Ranch, Calif., before attending the University of Oregon...The 23-year-old spent his sophomore and junior seasons at Notre Dame High School...Was a freshman when Cincinnati Reds RHP **Hunter Greene** was a senior...During high school, the right-handed pitcher also served as a gifted outfielder, hitting .414 (12-for-29) with a home run, 4 RBI, and 1.204 OPS in a COVID-shortened senior season...In high school, Gordon faced off as a hitter against 2024 National League Rookie of the Year and Pittsburgh Pirates RHP **Paul Skenes**, who attended El Toro High School (Lake Forest, Calif.), registering a double.

FORE!: R.J. is far from the only athlete in the Gordon family...R.J.'s father, **Jason**, is an accomplished professional golfer who has played on the Canadian PGA Tour, the PGA Tour, and the Nationwide Tour.
