**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Quakes embark on a six-game road trip tonight, with game one of a six-game set against the Inland Empire 66ers at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes will return home on Tuesday, July 30 to face San Jose.

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today's game is the 19th of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the seventh of 12 at home in 2024. The Quakes are currently 12-6 against the 66ers in 2024 (5-1 here in San Bernardino). Last year, the Quakes went 8-4 at San Manuel Stadium, 14-13 overall against the 66ers.

**LAST GAME:** The Storm scored the game's final eight runs on Sunday evening, taking a 9-2 win over the Quakes at LoanMart Field. Lake Elsinore's bullpen held Rancho to just two hits over seven scoreless innings, helping the Storm win the series by taking two of three. An RBI single from Jacob Campbell against Sean Paul Linan (3-2) gave the Storm a 3-2 lead in the fourth. Storm reliever Johan Moreno (4-1) tossed two innings of scoreless work to get the win. Rancho's Jeral Perez slugged his team-leading tenth homer of the year, giving the Quakes a 2-1 lead in the first, but they'd finish with just four hits on the day.

**CATCHERS WHO HIT:** The Quakes have gotten some incredible offensive production lately from their two catchers, as Jesus Galiz and Carlos Rojas are the top two hitters for the Quakes in the second half. Galiz, who saw a nine-game hitting streak come to an end on Friday, is hitting a team-high .420 (21-for-50) in the second half, raising his average to .280 entering today's game. Rojas is batting .404 in 13 second-half games, now a team-best .301 overall.

**THE PITCHING:** The Quakes and the 66ers have the two worst ERAs in the league, with Rancho at 5.74 and Inland Empire just slightly better at 5.57. The second half of the year has been more brutal to Inland Empire, as they have a league-worst ERA of 6.36 in 24 second-half games, while the Quakes are at 5.86. The root of the cause is walks issued, as these two teams have issued more walks than anyone else in the Cal League in 2024. Rancho has walked a league-high 492 batters in just 771.1 innings. Inland is next with 458 walks in 787.1 innings.

**ON "DECK"ER:** Cameron Decker has been a steady presence offensively since rejoining the Quakes on June 25, hitting .322 (19-for-59). He's also slugged four home runs and 12 RBIs over 16 games. Decker opened the year in Rancho, but struggled, hitting just .143 with two RBIs in nine games before being sent to the Arizona Complex League.

**FOUR-HORSE RACE:** While the San Jose Giants are trying to distance themselves from everyone else in the North (currently a ten-game lead over non-playoff teams), the South Division is a much closer race. Coming into the week, the four teams are separated by just three games and just two games ago, they were separated by only one game. Should first-half South champ Lake Elsinore win the division in the second half, the final playoff spot goes to the team with the next best record in the second half.

**CAM DAY:** Cam Day will make his 12th start and 17th appearance of the year, his fourth against the 66ers. In three starts against Inland Empire, he's 0-1 with a 13.94 ERA, allowing 16 runs on 24 hits over just 10.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed five runs on five hits over four innings in a no-decision at Stockton on July 11. Day signed as an undrafted free agent with the Dodgers, after playing collegiately at the University of Utah.

**RILEY BAUMAN:** Right-hander Riley Bauman makes his 18 start of the year and his fourth against the Quakes. In three starts against Rancho, he's 1-0 with a 6.59 ERA, allowing ten runs on 16 hits over 13.2 innings. In his last start overall, he allowed four runs on six hits over five innings in a no-decision vs Modesto on July 13. Bauman was an Angels' 13th-rounder in the 2023 draft out of Abilene Christian University in Abilene, Texas.
