LHP Robby Snelling (3-0, 1.35 ERA) vs. RHP Peter Heubeck (0-3, 5.33 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm in game three of a six-game series. Tonight is Thirsty Thursday, thanks to Millennium Systems, as fans can enjoy drink specials throughout the night, including \$3 Pepsi products and \$4 domestic drafts. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game will be the ninth of 30 head-to-head match-ups in 2023, with this being the third of 18 at LoanMart Field. After dropping back-to-back games to open the series, the Quakes are 4-4 against the Storm this year. Last season, Rancho went 14-16 overall against the Storm.

LAST GAME: The Storm got off to an early lead and never looked back, winning their second straight game at LoanMart Field, 8-2 on Wednesday night. Quakes' starter Chris Campos (5-1) retired six of the first seven batters he faced, but his command faltered in the third, as he issued three of his four walks and the Storm tallied five runs to take the lead for good. Storm starter Jagger Haynes retired eight of nine before turning it over to reliever Manuel Castro (2-1), who allowed just one run over four innings. Nick Biddison collected two of Rancho's four hits on the night.

TWO IS ENOUGH: Last night's loss marks just the third time this season in which the Quakes have lost two straight games, the second time here at home (Fresno). At no point in their first 41 games, have they lost three straight games.

"NEW"ELL GUY ON TOP OF HR LEADERBOARD: Chris Newell had a heck of a week in Visalia and he's off to another good start this week against the Storm. Newell homered four times (two multi-homer games) against the Rawhide and then opened Tuesday night's series against the Storm with his league-leading 13th homer of the season. Newell is third in the league in RBIs with 32.

MORE LONG-BALL TALK: The Quakes smashed three home runs on Saturday and then belted four on Sunday, giving them their best two-game stretch of the year with seven. After popping another on Tuesday, the Quakes have 43 home runs on the year in 41 games. Rancho entered this series with more home runs than games played for the first time this year. They are the only team in the league that's averaging anything close to one home run per game. San Jose is the second most prolific home run hitting club, as they have 33 in 41 games. Lake Elsinore has 24 in 37 games.

ROSTER MOVES: After injuring his right shoulder on April 26, Kyle Nevin, who was the league's leading hitter at the time (.385 in 16 games) was activated from the IL and went 1-for-4 in Tuesday's return to the lineup. Also joining the Quakes from Extended Spring Training in Arizona is RHP Carlos Martinez. They are taking the roster spots of RHP Darlin Pinales (Extended AZ) and INF Jose Izarra (IL).

PETER HEUBECK: Right-hander Peter Heubeck makes his ninth start for the Quakes and second against Lake Elsinore. In his last outing, he gave up two runs on one hit with two walks over three innings in a loss at Visalia on May 19. In his lone start against the Storm, he allowed just two hits over 3.1 scoreless inning in a no-decision on May 2 In 2022, Heubeck went 0-1 with a 7.39 ERA over 15 games (13 starts). Heubeck was a third round pick (101 overall) in the 2021 draft out of Gilman High School in Baltimore, Maryland.

ROBBY SNELLING: Left-hander Robby Snelling makes his seventh start overall and second start against the Quakes. His only appearance against the Quakes was a win on May 4, as he struck out nine and allowed one hit over five scoreless innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed just two runs on four hits over 5.2 innings in a no-decision at San Jose on May 12. Snelling was drafted 39th overall by the Padres, as a Competitive Balance Pick in the 2022 draft out of McQueen HS in Reno, NV. Snelling is rated by MLB Pipeline and Baseball America as the fifth best prospect in the Padres' system coming into the year.
