TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve begin their first road trip of the season, a six-game series at Akron with the Cleveland Guardians affiliate. Akron is loaded with returners like RHP Aaron Davenport and Tommy Mace in the rotation along with INF CJ Kayfus and OF Joe Lampe. INF Travis Bazzana, the No. 1 overall pick in 2024 out of Oregon State, highlights their prospect group. Bazzana was born in Austrailia and made history with Chase Burns (Italy, selected No.2 overall by Cincinnati) as the first pair to be born overseas and selected at the top of the draft.

On the mound, lefty Rodney Boone takes the ball. Boone was Cleveland's 8th round pick in 2021 out of UC Santa Barbara. The Orange, CA native attended Tustin HS in Tustin, CA. Boone lists his favorite sports teams as the New England Patriots, LA Dodgers and Houston Astros and enjoys jet skiing, body surfing, hiking and playing with his dogs in his spare time. Last season he made 3 starts against Altoona and tossed 13.1 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and just 5 hits allowed and 6 walks.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson became the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve, when he arrived on August 27, 2024 in Curve. PA. This season, <u>Johnson opens as the youngest in the Eastern League</u> at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7thyoungest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old).

Johnson's 85 walks last season were 9th-most by a minor league player and he's reached base safely in 12-of-17 games with the Curve. He wallopped his first homer of the season on Tuesday, April 8 at Akron, a three-run shot that traveled an estimated 392 feet.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters have a 1.00 ERA, 2nd among Double-A staffs.

DIXON BANGS: Infielder Brenden Dixon, who swatted eight homers last season for the Curve, banged Altoona's first home run of the season on Opening Day on April 4 against Chesapeake. Dixon added a double in Saturday's 2-0 defeat to the Baysox.

2024 IN REVIEW: The Curve totaled a 62-76 mark during the 2024 season, marking the 11th time in franchise history that Altoona finished with a record under .500. Since the cancelled 2020 season, Altoona has had a winning record just one time (2022) in four seasons. Returners Kervin Pichardo (Team MVP) and Sammy Siani (Unsung Hero) return to the Curve lineup.

PROSPECTS PARTY: Seven Curve players are ranked among the Pirates Top 30 according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. Termarr Johnson (No. 4 MLB/No. 5 BA) headlines the group, which also features LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7/No. 10), INF Jack Brannigan (No. 11/No. 14), INF/OF Mitch Jebb (No. 13/No. 14), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14/No. 15), RHP Alessandro Ercolani (No. 21 BA), RHP Wilber Dotel (No. 27 BA).

THE TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH ALTOONA: Five alumni went on to make their major league debut during the 2024 season. RHP Jared Jones (3/30, PIT), RHP Paul Skenes (5/11, PIT), C Grant Koch (5/29, PIT), LHP Luis Peralta (8/24, COL) and RHP Mike Burrows (9/28, PIT) all reached the major leagues for the first time. In 2025, RHP Thomas Harrington (4/1, PIT) and LHP Omar Cruz (4/1, SD) have both made their major league debut, totaling 219 alumni who have gone onto the major leagues.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.



This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
