NOTES AND NUGGETS

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a couple of hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

✦ **Carter Jensen** joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he's hitting .253 (21-for-83) ... he leads the club with 8 homers and 22 RBI since arriving and ranks 2nd with 49 total bases, with 12 of 21 hits going for extra-bases ... his 12 walks are tied for the team lead.

✦ **Dairon Blanco** is hitting .276 (21-for-76) since June 24 ... 12 of his 21 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 7 doubles, 1 triple and 4 home runs ... his 42 total bases are 3rd on the team this half.

✦ While **Joey Wiemer** is hitting just .154 (16-for-104) this half, his 16 RBI are 2nd on the team since June 24 ... his 12 walks are tied for the team lead in this stretch.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 129 bases this year, and only been caught 24 times ... 129 steals rank 6th in the International League and 9th in Triple-A.

✦ 129-for-153 in steal attempts is a 84.3% success rate, tied for the best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and tied 5th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 86.5%, 90-for-104).

LOUISVILLE SLUGGER

Since last year, **Drew Waters** has had more success against the Louisville Bats than any other International League player.

✦ In 20 games against the Bats between 2024 and 2025, Waters is hitting .419 (31-for-74) with 14 extra-base hits (7 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers) and 16 RBI.

✦ Waters has .494 on-base percentage and .770 slugging percentage, for a 1.264 OPS against the Bats ... all of those marks are the highest among 38 players with at least 60 plate appearances against the Bats since 2024.

✦ When Louisville came to Werner Park in April, Waters was the International League Player of the Week, going 10-for-26 (.526 average) with a league-best 20 total bases, including hitting for the cycle on April 2 ... ended the 2024 regular season with 4 straight 3-hit games in Louisville, named the IL Player of the Week.

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel made his Storm Chasers debut July 12, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

✦ With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most-experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing only **Rich Hill** (14 years, 141 days MLB service), who made 9 Omaha starts ... Keuchel is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024).

✦ **Joey Krehbiel**'s Omaha debut last Thursday makes him the 15th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... by comparison, Omaha had 9 players in their 30's appear in a game both last year and in 2023.

JETTING OFF WITH JENSEN

Carter Jensen has been one of the hottest hitters in the Minors since the calendar flipped to July, after a slow start to his time in Triple-A.

✦ Among 713 Minor League hitters that have taken at least 70 plate appearances in July, Jensen ranks 4th in slugging percentage (.738) and 5th in OPS (1.176).

✦ In 17 games since July 1, Jensen is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with 4 doubles, 7 homers and 21 RBI, while drawing 12 walks ... his 21 RBI this month are tied for the 12th-most of any Minor League player and tied for the 5th-most in the IL.

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

The Omaha Storm Chasers played from behind nearly all week in Syracuse last week, having led for just a few innings in the 6-game sweep by the Mets.

✦ After leading for 18 of 27 innings in Buffalo out of the MLB All-Star Break, Omaha led for 7 of 54 innings last week in Syracuse ... the Mets led for 42 of 54 innings.

✦ The sweep in Syracuse was the 3rd time Omaha has been swept in 2025 ... the Chasers previously dropped 6 in Toledo, April 22-27, lost 6 at home to Durham, June 17-22, then the 6 games in Syracuse, July 22-27.

TIME AFTER TIME

The current Omaha Storm Chasers roster features some of the most experienced players in the International League across the last five seasons.

✦ Of the 178 players that have combined to take at least 800 plate appearances for IL teams since 2021, 6 of them are active with the Storm Chasers: **Nick Pratto** (1560 PA), **Drew Waters** (1407 PA), **Tyler Gentry** (1310 PA), **Dairon Blanco** (947 PA), **Diego Castillo** (904 PA) and **Joey Wiemer** (844 PA).

✓ Dunn is pitching in his **6th game with Omaha**, his **11th Triple-A start** and **16th Triple-A outing this year**, his **19th overall appearance this season** ... signed a Minor League deal with the Royals on June 5, made 3 appearances in the Arizona Complex League and was assigned to Omaha on June 28.

✓ Signed a Minor League contact with the Chicago White Sox in November 2024, began the year in the Charlotte Knights' (AAA) rotation, moved to the bullpen and was released on May 28.

✓ Playing his **9th professional season this year** ... Royals are Dunn's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Mariners, Reds and White Sox ... has appeared in 32 Major League games (all starts) between 2019 and 2022, his last MLB outing was with Cincinnati on September 11, 2022 @ Milwaukee.

Made his 5th appearance with Omaha, his 3rd start after a pair of relief appearances ... for the 3rd time in as many starts, could not make it through the 3rd inning and was charged with his 3rd loss (2nd while starting) ... after a 1-2-3 inning in the 1st, allowed 4 runs in the 2nd on 2-run homers to Drew Gilbert and Luis De Los Santos ... struck out his first batter of the 3rd inning but issued his 4th walk of the day to end the start ... bequeathed runner didn't score.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

✓ After signing with the Chicago White Sox on November 8, 2024, opened the season in the starting rotation for the Charlotte Knights (AAA) ... made 7 starts for the Knights before moving to the bullpen for 3 relief appearances.

✓ Struck out 17 batters across his first two starts, April 1 & 6 vs. Norfolk (BAL), across 8.1 innings (18.36 K/9).

✓ Made 1 quality start with Charlotte, on April 18 @ Nashville (MIL) ... threw 6.0 scoreless innings, with 4 strikeouts and a pair of 1-2-3 innings ... was the middle start in a 3-outing stretch between April 12 and 25, where he allowed 2 earned runs in 15.1 innings (1.17 ERA).

Spent the season on the Cincinnati Reds 60-day injured list ... made 2 rehab starts with the Arizona Complex League Reds (8/16 and 8/19) and 1 with Triple-A Louisville (8/22) ... allowed 2 earned runs in 3.2 innings (5.40 ERA).

Was acquired by Cincinnati from Seattle on March 14 with OF Jake Fraley, LHP Brandon Williamson and a PTBNL (RHP Connor Phillips) in return for 3B Eugenio Suárez and OF Jesse Winker.

✓ Began the season on Cincinnati's 60-day injured list ... made one rehab start with Dayton (A+) and 5 with Louisville (AAA) ... reinstated from the IL on July 24 and optioned to Louisville, made 2 more starts with the Bats before being recalled on August 8 and made his Reds debut on August 8 at New York (AL).

Made 11 starts with the Mariners despite a pair of stints on the injured list.
On Seattle's injured list from 6/1-10 with right shoulder inflammation ... reinstated on 6/11 and made two starts before going on the injured list for the second time on 6/18 ... transferred to the 60-day injured list on 8/19.

Spent the season with Seattle, making 10 starts in the 60- game shortened campaign.
Ranked 5th in the American League among pitchers with at least 45.0 IP, trailing Shane Bieber (.167), Kenta Maeda (.168), Lucas Giolito (.184) and Cristian Javier (.188) ... made 4 quality starts, tied 2nd among MLB rookies.

2019
Spent most of the season with the Arkansas Travelers (AA) ... also made 4 starts with the Mariners in September.
Named to the Texas League mid and postseason All-Star Teams and led the league in wins (9), strikeouts (158) and WHIP (1.19), tied for third in starts (25) and fourth in ERA (3.55) and IP (131.2).

✓ Selected to participate in the All-Star Futures Game on July 9 at Progressive Field in Cleveland, pitching a 1-2-3 second inning with one strikeout.

Contract was selected by Seattle on September 10 ... made his MLB debut on September 12 vs. Cincinnati.

2018
Named the Mets' Organization Pitcher of the Year ... split the year between St. Lucie (A+) and Binghamton (AA), going 8-8 with a 3.59 ERA (54 ER/135.1 IP) and 156 strikeouts (10.4 K/9) ... promoted to Double-A on June 10.
Following the season, was rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 4 prospect in the Mets system.

Was acquired by Seattle from New York (NL) on December 3, 2018, with RHPs Gerson Bautista and Anthony Swarzak and OFs Jay Bruce and Jared Kelenic in exchange for INF Robinson Cano, RHP Edwin Diaz and cash.

Pitched in 20 games (16 starts) with the St. Lucie Mets (A+) ... in 16 starts, went 3-6 with a 5.74 ERA (50 ER/78.1 IP).

Made his pro debut with the Brooklyn Cyclones (A-), appearing in 11 games (8 starts) ... 8 of 11 were scoreless.

✓ Played 3 seasons (2014-16) at Boston College ... as a Junior in 2016, was a Third Team All-American by Baseball America, going 4-2 with a 2.06 ERA (15 ER/65.2 IP) and 72 strikeouts in 18 games (8 starts) with the Eagles.

✓ Graduated in 2013 from The Frederick Gunn School, a college preparatory school in Washington, Conn.

✓ Younger brother, Ryan, plays for the Phoenix Suns, was drafted 28th overall in 2024 by Denver, traded to Phoenix.

Originally was selected by the Dodgers in the 37th round of the 2013 draft, but did not sign.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.
