FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue their final road trip of the 2025 season on Friday night, game four of a six-game set against the Knoxville Smokies at Covenant Health Park. Rocket City is coming off a 3-3 split with Columbus at Toyota Field. This marks the fifth and final meeting between the North Division rivals, with the Smokies leading the season series 15-11, and the all-time series, 72-71. The Trash Pandas will close out the season at Toyota Field, September 9-14, against the Chattanooga Lookouts.

TRASH PANDAS STIFLED IN KNOXVILLE ON THURSDAY NIGHT: The Trash Pandas were limited to just one hit in a 3-0 loss to Knoxville on Thursday night. Smokies infielder Pedro Ramirez went 5-for-5 with three doubles and two runs scored, while starter Connor Schultz tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in just his second Double-A start. George Klassen struck out seven over 5.0 innings for Rocket City, but the offense went 0-for-3 with runners in scoring position as Knoxville handed the Trash Pandas their 13th shutout loss of the year.

ROCKET ARMS: Over the last 15 games, the Trash Pandas' pitching staff has posted a 2.55 ERA — leading the Southern League, is 2nd-best in Double-A and 8th among all full-season MiLB clubs since August 18 — while racking up 127 strikeouts in 127.0 innings. The pitching staff has recorded eight shutouts this season, and six shutouts over their last 10 wins.

KLASSEN K'S PILING UP: RHP George Klassen made his 23rd start of 2025, and 30th of his career on September 4, which ranks 4th in franchise history. Klassen's 118 strikeouts this season ranks 6th in the Southern League, and places him T-4th (with Brett Kerry, '22) in franchise history.

COLÁS CASHING IN: OF Oscar Colás' has reached base in 20 of his last 24 games, leading the league with 22 RBIs, and belting five home runs during the stretch — including a two-homer game on August 14, a grand slam on August 8 in Columbus (the Trash Pandas' second of the season and 11th in franchise history), and a walk-off three-run triple vs. Columbus on August 27. Since May 30, Colás leads the Southern League with 13 homers, and T-4th with 43 RBIs.

SAM THE MAN: LHP Sam Aldegheri has six quality starts in his last nine outings since July 2. The Verona, Italy native is T-1st with six wins (6-2) over that stretch with a 1.98 ERA (12 ER/54.2 IP), 19 walks, and 43 strikeouts. His ERA ranks 3rd in the Southern League over that span. Aldegheri is 2nd in franchise history in wins with eight. He ranks among the league leaders in quality starts (T-3rd, 8) starts (T-9th, 22), innings pitched (5th, 121.1), wins (3rd, 8), strikeouts (11th, 104), and ERA (6th, 3.78), BAA (9th, .240), and WHIP (10th, 1.37).

SPORTS CENTER LOVES THE PANDAS: In back-to-back games on August 31 and September 2, the Trash Pandas landed on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10. Mac McCroškey checked in at No. 8 on August 31 with a sliding stop at second base, while Ben Gobbel followed at No. 9 on September 2 with a charging barehand play. Rocket City now has three Top 10 highlights—and one Not Top 10 appearance—so far in 2025.

CLIMBING THE FRANCHISE CHARTS: RHP Walbert Urena (122.1 IP), LHP Sam Aldegheri (121.1 IP), and LHP **Mitch Farris** (116.0 IP) rank among the Southern League's top six in innings pitched in 2025 and now sit 4th, 5th, and 6th in franchise history. The Trash Pandas record holder is RHP **Chase Chaney** in 2024 with 138.0 innings pitched. Urena is tied wth Chaney for the most starts in team history with 25.

UREÑSTOPPABLE: Over LHP Walbert Urena's his last three starts, the 21-year-old right-hander is 1-0 with a 1.40 ERA, allowing just three earned runs across 19.1 innings while striking out 17. His 25 starts places him T-1st in team history, with Chase Chaney (2024). Urena ranks among the league leaders in starts (T-2nd, 25), innings pitched (3rd, 122.1), and BAA (8th, .239).

FROM ROCKET CITY TO A MAJOR LEAGUE WIN: Trash Pandas starter and Southern League strikeout leader **Mitch Farris** had his contract selected by the Angels on Monday, and by Tuesday night he was making his MLB debut. Farris earned the win in Los Angeles' 5-1 victory over the Royals in Kansas City, tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts. He became the 45th Trash Pandas alum to reach the majors, the ninth in 2025, and the 14th to be promoted directly from Double-A. Farris also became the third Trash Pandas player to win his MLB debut, joining Chase Silseth (5/13/22 at OAK), and Caden Dana (9/1/24 vs. SEA)

SOUTHERN LEAGUE STRIKEOUT LEADER: As Farris was promoted to the bigs on Monday, he ranks 3rd in Double-A with 142 strikeouts over 23 outings in 2025. Farris is 2nd in team history in single-season strikeouts, trailing only franchise record-holder Caden Dana, who struck out 147 batters in 2024. His 13-strikeout game on August 26 vs. Columbus was the third-most in team history behind Reid Detmer's 16 on June 26, 2021 at Chattanooga, and Brett Kerry's 14 on August 29 vs. Tennessee. Farris ranks among the league leaders in starts (T-8th, 22), innings pitched (6th, 116.0), and strikeouts (1st, 142)

BLASTING OFF IN THE ROCKET CITY: Since July 1, the Trash Pandas are 2nd in the Southern League (Pensacola, 43), and rank T-13th in Double-A with 39 home runs in 54 games. Oscar Colás (11), Ben Gobbel (6), and Korey Holland (4) have combined for 21 of those homers. The Pandas matched a club record with five long balls on July 3 vs. Knoxville and had four on August 14 vs. Knoxville. Overall, Rocket City ranks 3rd in the league with 87 long balls.

TOYOTA FIELD MAGIC WAS BACK: The Trash Pandas rallied from a three-run deficit in the ninth to stun Columbus 6-5 on Wednesday, as Oscar Colas delivered a three-run walk-off triple — the team's third walk-off win of the season, and first since Cole Fontenelle's game-winner on June 11 vs. Pensacola after **Denzer Guzman's** walk-off homer on April 5 vs. Chattanooga.

THE ELEPHANT IN THE ROOM: The Trash Pandas are 44-84 overall this season, and their 84 losses are the most in Minor League Baseball this season. Corpus Christi (AA-HOU) is second with 83 losses.

- DENZER GUZMAN NAMED SL PLAYER OF THE MONTH: On Wednesday, MiLB named Denzer Guzman the Southern League Player of the Month for July, becoming just the sixth player in Trash Pandas history to earn the honor—and the first since Gustavo Campero in July 2024. Guzman was one of the league's most consistent and productive hitters throughout the month. He led the Southern League in OPS (1.020), slugging percentage (.580), extra-base hits (13), and total bases (47). He also finished second in batting average (.333), on-base percentage (.440), and doubles (9), while his 27 hits tied for fifth. Guzman was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake on August 2.
- KLASSEN AND ALDEGHERI DEALT IN JULY: LHP Sam Aldegheri and RHP George Klassen were two of the Southern League's best starters in July. Aldegheri led the league with a 0.78 ERA. In four starts, the lefthander went 3-0, allowing just four earned runs over 23.0 innings while recording 19 strikeouts and 10 walks. Klassen finished T-1st in the league with 26 strikeouts over four starts, finishing with a 3.32 ERA, striking out 26 and walking seven across 21.2 innings.
- PITCHING STAFF PACKED A PUNCH IN JULY: The Rocket City pitching staff racked up 213 strikeouts over 24 games in July—an average of 8.9 strikeouts per game—ranking 3rd in the Southern League and 9th across all of Double-A.
- SAM BROWN TRADED TO NATS: On Wednesday, the Angels traded Trash Pandas first baseman Sam Brown to the Washington Nationals as part of a four-player deal. A 2023 12th-round pick out of Washington State, Brown hit. 244 with 12 doubles, five homers, and 40 RBI in 92 games for Rocket City this season. He was named Southern League Player of the Week in mid-July and ranked fourth in batting average in May. In return, the Angels received LHP Andrew Chafin and RHP Luis García, while LHP Jake Eder also goes to Washington. José Quijada was designated for assignment.
- ROCKET CITY LIVED UP TO ITS NAME IN JULY. In July, the Trash Pandas launched 19 home runs over 24 games, 3rd in the Southern League and ranking T-10th in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch included a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. The surge was fueled by Oscar Colás and Ben Gobbel, who combined for 10 of the 19 homers. Colás led the league in that span with six, while Gobbel was T-4th.
- SOUND THE BLANKENHORN: OF Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 32 of 41 games since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder is tied for the league with eight home runs, and ranks 9th in the Southern League with an .752 OPS with six doubles, a triple, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 19 walks over that span.
- COLÁS BROUGHT THE BOOM IN JULY: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás finished July, 4th in all of Double-A with six home runs, plus he has three doubles, 15 RBIs, and 11 runs scored. On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings. That marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being Orlando Martinez's performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanooga.
- RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, moved to Triple-A on August 2 after being the youngest player in the Southern League the past two seasons, He ranked 3rd in the league and 5th in all of Double-A with 34 stolen bases at the time of his promotion on August 2—19 of which came in a blistering month of May. His 34 steals ranked 3rd in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and Kyren Parris' franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in stolen bases (3rd, 34), OBP (5th, 380), batting average (12th, .277), and hits (T-9th, 91). Rada had a team-best 26 multi-hit games, including five three-hit games.
- GUZMAN BLAZED THROUGH JULY. The San Pedro de Macorís native, also moved to Triple-A on August 2, was named the Trash Pandas Player of the Month, and was one of the hottest hitters in Double-A last month, leading the Southern League—and was 5th in all of Double-A—with a 1.020 OPS, 47 total bases, and 13 extra-base hits. He ranked 2nd in the league with a .333 batting average and is also was tops in slugging (.580) and 2nd in on-base percentage (.440). His nine doubles rank 2nd in the league, and his 27 hits were T-5th. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second five-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and four RBIs. He ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in several categories, including doubles (2nd, 23), extra-base hits (T-1st, 35), RBIs (6th, 53), total bases (T-6th, 139), home runs (T-7th, 11), and slugging (7th, .415), and OPS (12th, .749). Guzman led the team with 16 multi-RBI games.
- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern
 League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 OPS and seven extra-base hits, along
 with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the
 honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best .444 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series
 at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 OPS—also the
 highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win
 the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following
 Tucker Flint (Aug. 12-18) and Christian Moore (Aug. 5-11) in 2023.
- BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana ('24), OF Kyren Paris ('23), C Edgar Quero ('23), RHP Ky Bush ('22), and LHP Reid Detmers ('21).
- **KEEPIN' IT QUALITY:** Starter **Joel Hurtado**, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks third in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks fifth in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: INF Jeremiah Jackson became the 44th Rocket City Trash Pandas alumnus to reach the Major Leagues, and eighth this season, when he made his MLB debut on August 1, with the Baltimore Orioles. Over his time in Madison, Jackson appeared in 169 games between 2022 and 2023, earning recognition for his power and versatility before being traded to the Mets and later landing with Baltimore. He joins former Pandas Chad Stevens (debuted o July 3), Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 11), who all debuted this year.
- THE STREAK IS OVER!!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the "Dixie Association".
- **DELAYING THE LAUNCH:** From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.

August Was Good, Too: Over five starts, went 3-2 with a 2.84 ERA (10 ER/31.2 IP), nine walks, 24 strikeouts, and a 1.01 WHIP. He led the league in innings pitched.

2024 in Review: Sam Aldegheri went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA and 10 strikeouts over three starts for the Angels after making his Major League debut on Aug. 30 vs. Seattle. He earned his first MLB win in his second start, Sept. 6 at Texas, becoming the first Italian-born player to record a big league win since 1949 and the first pitcher born and raised in Italy to reach the Majors. He is the eighth Italian-born player in MLB history and the first for the Angels franchise.

Aldegheri was acquired from the Phillies on July 27 in the Carlos Estévez trade, after posting a 6-9 record and 3.59 ERA with 134 strikeouts in 19 starts between High-A Jersey Shore, Double-A Reading, and Rocket City. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, he led the South Atlantic League with 95 strikeouts and paced all High-A pitchers (min. 60 IP) with 12.57 K/9. He was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for June 10–16 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts against Wilmington.
