## RIDERS SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER WITH MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders split a doubleheader against the Midland RockHounds on Thursday, winning game one by a score of 4-2 and losing a rain-shortened game two, 11-0. Midland (27-15) jumped ahead on an RBI single from Colby Thomas in the top of the first inning against Frisco (25-16) starter **Ryan Garcia** (3-2). The RockHounds added to their lead in the second inning when Caeden Trenkle belted a solo homer, his first homer of the season. Trailing 2-0 in the bottom of the second, **Keyber Rodriguez** grounded into a double play that brought **Josh Hatcher** across the plate to cut the Midland lead to 2-1. In the bottom of the third inning, **Aaron Zavala** provided a sacrifice fly that plated **Cooper Johnson** to tie the game at 2-2. **Cody Freeman** gave the Riders their first lead of the game with a single, scoring Kellen Strahm and Liam Hicks. Garcia finished his day after 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on three hits and three walks while fanning five. **Robby Ahlstrom** tossed a pair of scoreless frames on his way to a six-out save with a pair of punchouts in the 4-2 win. In game two of the twin bill, **Ben Anderson** (2-3) surrendered a solo homer to Jack Winkler in the top of the first. In the top of the second inning, Midland sent 10 batters to the plate and scored six runs. The frame was highlighted by RBI doubles from Sahid Valenzuela, Cooper Bowman and Thomas. Anderson exited after allowing six runs on six hits across 1.1 innings with one strikeout. Leading 7-0 entering the top of the fourth, Thomas belted a three-run homer off **Bryan Chi** to extend the RockHounds lead to 10-0. Gunnar Hoglund (5-2) did not allow a hit until the bottom of the fourth inning when Strahm led off the frame with a single, extending his on base streak to 27 games. He finished with 5.0 scoreless, one-hit innings while striking out four. Trenkle capped off the scoring with an RBI single in the top of the fifth, giving Midland an 11-0 advantage. After the conclusion of the fifth inning, the tarp came on for a short delay before the game was called due to inclement weather.

## TO BE FAIR, IN MY DEFENSE:

The RoughRiders have committed just 21 errors this season in 41 games, the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. Their .985 fielding percentage is tied for the best in MiLB as well (tied with the Syracuse Mets). Their 39 double plays are second in the Texas League and eighth among non-Triple-A teams. **Cody Freeman** is one of just 14 players in Minor League Baseball who has at least 80 total chances and has not committed an error while he is one of just two non-first baseman infielders with at least 80 chances and no errors.

## POWER OUTAGE:

Over their last 17 games, the RoughRiders have hit just nine home runs, which is the second-worst in the Texas League during that span. Frisco has hit 28 doubles during that stretch, good for sixth in the league, giving them a .386 SLG as a team (5th in the league). Along with the lack of power, they are also striking out fewer times than anyone else in the league (6.5 K/G as a team over the last 17 games) and hitting .266, which is second in the league. **Cody Freeman** (two) is the only Riders player with multiple home runs over the last 17 games.

## MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

**Keyber Rodriguez** has been tearing up the baseball over the last week. In his last eight games, Rodriguez is hitting .484 (15-for-31) with six multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, a triple, a home run, six RBIs, a walk, five runs scored and a steal. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .315 and OPS from .371 to .912 over the last week.

## IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has the longest on-base streak this season for the RoughRiders, currently at 27 games. During the streak, he hit .310 (31-for-100)/.397/.410/.807 with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, nine RBIs, 15 walks, six steals and 24 runs scored. The streak is the second-longest active streak in the Texas League. In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base streak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 161 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guider Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

## I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

**Cody Freeman** had a monster game on April 25th against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaine Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. In his last 24 games, he has batted .348/.379/.618/.997 with all five of his homers. This season, he has the seventh-lowest strikeout rate in the Texas League (12.8%) and has just whiffed five times in 17 games and 62 at-bats in May.

## THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .328/.365/.491/.856. Hatcher is second in the league in batting average (.333), sixth in RBIs (26) and ninth in OPS (.856). Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

### ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

### 2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Became the first RoughRiders pitcher to complete a quality start on 4/14/24 against Corpus Christi.

### 2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

### 2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

### 2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
