THE LAST TIME OUT: J.C. Escarra drilled a game-tying solo home run to right field in the top of the eighth inning, sparking a comeback victory for the Bowie Baysox over the Altoona Curve, 2-1, on Opening Day at Peoples Natural Gas Field. Curve baseball returned to PNG Field for the first time in 614 days, but in 2021-fashion the game was halted for 1:27 due to rain in the middle of the seventh inning. The Baysox (1-0) grabbed the lead in the top of the ninth when Patrick Dorrian scored on a throwing error by Curve second baseman Ji-Hwan Bae. With one out and runners on the corners, Bae played a chopping ground ball to his right, tagging out one runner and throwing off balance to first. The throw got away from Mason Martin at first base, allowing Dorrian to score from third. Yerry De Los Santos (Loss, 0-1) was charged with the loss after surrendering the game-tying home run to Escarra with one out in the eighth and the go-ahead run in the ninth. The Curve scratched out their only run of the night in the sixth inning on a Cal Mitchell sacrifice fly to right off Baysox reliever Gray Fenter. Oneil Cruz led off the inning with an infield single and moved to third on a Martin hit to right field. Mitchell then drove Cruz home with a solid line drive to deep right.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve look to bounce back from a late-inning loss on Opening Day and send RHP Travis MacGregor to the mound. RHP Kyle Bradish is ranked as the #14 prospect in the Orioles system according to MLB.com, he makes his season debut on Wednesday night.

WE'RE BACK! The Curve took the field for the first time in 610 days on Tuesday night after the COVID-19 Pandemic led to the cancellation of the 2020 campaign. It had been 614 days since Peoples Natural Gas Field last hosted Curve baseball.

WE'RE FIRST! Altoona-Bowie and Portland-New Hampshire were the first Minor League Baseball games to get underway this season when both games threw their first pitch at 6:03pm. There were 55 total games slated to get underway across the country on Tuesday night as all levels of MiLB began on the same day for the first time in modern history.

THE LIMIT DOES EXIST: In compliance with local health guidelines and Major League Baseball COVID-19 protocols, Peoples Natural Gas Field can host up to 2,300 fans to begin the season. Fans can purchase tickets in seating pods of 2, 4, 6, or 8 and each pod is spaced at least six feet apart from any other in their respective section.

40-MAN CURVE: The Curve roster features four members of the Pirates 40-man roster in INF **Oneil Cruz**, INF **Rodolfo Castro**, RHP **Roansy Contreras** and RHP **Max Kranick**.

HE STRUCK HIM OUT!!: The Curve struck out 17 batters on Opening Day, the most in a 9-inning game in franchise history. It surpassed the previous record of 16 which stood since May 9, 2010 vs. Erie. Roansy Contreras struck out a career-high 11 batters in the loss, Jeff Passantino struck out four and Yerry De Los Santos struck out two.

THE BAYSOX: Bowie begins the 2021 season with two of the top four prospects in the Orioles minor league system in C **Adley Rutschman** and LHP **D.L. Hall**. The Baysox roster also features **Terrin Vavra** (No. 13, MLB.com), who was acquired from the Colorado Rockies in exchange for former Baysox righty Mychal Givens. Vavra spent the 2019 season with the High-A Asheville Tourists hitting .318 with 10 home runs and 52 RBI. He has a career .313 average in the minors. Other top prospects for Bowie include RHP **Kyle Bradish** (No. 14, MLB.com), who was acquired from the Los Angeles Angels in 2019 for RHP Dylan Bundy, and RHP **Cody Sedlock** (No. 28, MLB.com). The Baysox roster includes eight players that have previously suited up for Bowie: RHP **Diogenes Almengo**, LHP **Tyler Erwin**, RHP **Steven Klimek**, RHP **Tim Naughton**, Sedlock, INF **Alex Torres**, INF **Willy Yanh**, and OF **Zach Jarrett**.

FOR ALTOONA: RHP **Travis MacGregor** makes his first regular season appearance since August 19, 2018 when he went 2.0 innings scoreless in a start for Single-A West Virginia. MacGregor missed the 2019 season recovering from Tommy John surgery and the 2020 campaign due to the COVID-19 Pandemic....*For more on MacGregor, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: RHP **Kyle Bradish** makes his 2021 debut after the COVID-19 Pandemic kept him from regular season action.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features eight of the top-30 prospects in the Pirates organization according to Baseball America. INF **Oneil Cruz** (No. 2 Pirates, No. 50 overall), RHP **Cody Bolton** (No. 6), INF **Ji-Hwan Bae** (No. 9), INF **Mason Martin** (No. 16), OF **Cal Mitchell** (No. 19), **Rodolfo Castro** (No. 22), RHP **Max Kranick** (No. 23), and RHP **Travis MacGregor** (No. 28) are all ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects list.

Originally selected as a third baseman by the Cincinnati Reds in the 47th round of the 2007 draft, but did not sign, Benes converted to the mound when at Arkansas State University. Benes was selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 35th round of the 2010 draft and spent three seasons in their system accumulating a 9-11 record with a 4.57 ERA in 66 appearances.	His first managing experience came in the Athletics organization in 2014. In 2015-16, he was on the Detroit Tigers' major league coaching staff as the Assistant Hitting Coach. Newhan played parts of eight seasons in the big leagues and 14 seasons overall as an infielder and outfielder with the Padres (1999-2000), Phillies (2000-01), Orioles (2004-06), Mets (2007) and Astros (2008).
