CARDINALS DO IT AGAIN, WALK-OFF ON MENDLINGER'S SINGLE:

Noah Mendlinger hit a walk-off single with one out in the bottom of the 10th inning as the Cardinals came from behind for the second straight night to defeat the Tulsa Drillers 3-2 on Wednesday night at Hammons Field. The Cardinals tallied just 5 hits, two by Mendlinger, and left 12 men on base. Nathan Church extended his hitting streak to 10 with a 7th inning single and Tink Hence. fired 4.0 scoreless innings allowing just 3 hits. Springfield has now won 7 of its last 8 and is 28-13 since the beginning of July.

DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Jerming Rosario** makes his 12th start of the season for the Drillers...Last start came on Friday, August 16 at home against Midland when he allowed 4 R (3 ER) on 4 H with 8 K over 4.2 IP...Did not factor in the decision...Pitched well in his only start against the Cardinals this season, allowing just 1 R on 3 H with 8 K and 4 BB over 4.2 IP on July 31 at ONEOK Field in a no deicision...Springfield won the game, 5-2...Added to the Drillers roster on June 13 from High-A Great Lakes... CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ON PACE...: With 67 wins through their first 116 games, the Cardinals are on pace for 79 wins in 2024, which would eclipse the franchise record for wins in a season. The current record is 77 wins which as been acheived twice: 2017 (77-63) and the Texas League title year of 2012 (77-61).

LONG, HOT SUMMER: Since the beginning of July, no team in Double-A has won more games than the Springfield Cardinals. The Cards are 28-13 since July 1, tied with the Portland Sea Dogs for the best record in Double-A during that time. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 4-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .281.

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 8 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 6 of their last 8 games, Springfield is 7-1 during that time. The Cards scored 32 of their 56 (57%) runs in the 7th inning or later, and have outscored their opponents 27-8 in the 8th inning or later.

HITS, HITS: The top offense in the Texas League all season long, the Cardinals have turned up the temperature as the summer has worn on. Despite just 5 hits on Wednesday, Springfield is batting .290 through 18 games in August, the top mark in Double-A by 18 points (Erie SeaWolves, .272). The Cardinals have double-digit hits in 8 of their last 10 games and are batting .324 since August 10. For the season the Cards are batting .269, tops in Double-A, and have scored 596 runs, most in the Texas League.

The Cardinals have also already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 44 longballs in 47 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 65 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest OPS (.765) and has scored 13 more runs (257) than any other club in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half.

TORRES BRINGS HOME TLPOW HONORS: For his performance last week in Frisco, Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the first time this season. Torres is the 2nd Cardinal to win the award this season; **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the week of April 15-21. **Cooper Hjerpe** earned Texas League Pitcher of the Week for June 17-23.

Torres had himself a week, batting .609 (14-for-23) with 2 2B, 4 RBIs and 8 runs scored against the RoughRiders. He added 3 BB and 2 SB and had a .654 OBP. Torres' week continues a red-hot month of August in which he is 2nd among qualified Texas League hitters with a .422 batting average (27-for-64) with 3 2B and 8 RBIs while getting on base at a .493 clip. Despite seeing an 8-game hitting streak come to an end on Wednesday night, Torres is 21-for-41 (.5612) over his last 9 games.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 40 games dating back to June 23, the final day of the 1st half, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .366 average, 10 HR and 38 RBIs and is slugging a league-high .634 and with a 1.061 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, **Crooks** batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS. He has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games and is batting .414 (24-for-66) with 4 HR and 18 RBIs over 15 games in August.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Among active, qualified hitters **Bryan Torres** (.325/.413) and **Jimmy Crooks** (.323/.414) are 1-2 atop the league in batting average and OBP, while **Crooks** leads the circuit in OBP, SLG (.507) and OPS (.921). **Torres** is 1st in hits (124) and is tied with **Nathan Church** for the league lead in runs scored with 69.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 22-for-22 and his 45 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 22 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 22.0 IP (0.41 ERA) and is 12-for-12 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one unearned run over his last 18 appearances, allowing just 11 H with 14 K over 21.0 IP. The Cardinals are 47-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
