TODAY'S OPPONENT: Moises Chace toes the rubber on Wednesday night, making his fifth start of the season and he'll face Aidan Curry for the Wood Ducks. The 20 year old righty dealt one of his best starts against the Shorebirds on Mother's Day where he struck out 8 batters across 6 innings on the mound, allowing just 3 hits and 1 run in a no-decision. Curry was originally an undrafted free agent by the Rangers in the shortened 2020 from Fordham Prep in New York City and originally was committed to Bucknell before signing with Texas.

took the one-run loss in the series opener, their third extra innings defeat in the last 7 games.

FEELIN' YOUNG: Carter Young has become an incredibly consistent hitter for the Shorebirds as of late. Since May 16, Young is batting .344 which is good for the second best average in the league in that 16-game sample size, behind Jacob Burke of Kannapolis (.375). He has scored 22 runs in that time frame which is tied for the most in the Carolina League, and has an OPS of .878. Young currently has a hit in nine straight at-bats going back to Sunday and has reached in ten straight plate appearances/

MOVING UP THE LADDER: Samuel Basallo's strong first season in affiliated baseball has elevated him to inside the Top 100 overall prospects for Baseball America as he comes in at No. 81 on the mid-season list. Basallo is now ranked the No. 7 prospect in a deep, Oriole's farm system and he is one of eight Baltimore prospects currently in the top 100.

PRADO AT THE TOP: Elio Prado has had a strong run going at the plate since moving into the leadoff spot in the order as he is batting 21/71 (.295) over his last 17 games, striking out only eight times in that time frame. Prado has scored 17 runs during that time, which is tied for most in the league.

PRESS THE RESET BUTTON: The Shorebirds will look to regain their early season form offensively after a tough month of May. In the second month of the season, Delmarva batted .215 with an average of 4 runs per game. The strikeout rate very much increased in May as the offense struck out 288 times for an average of 11 time per game (35.5% K-Rate) which was second-worst in the Carolina League.

EXTRA BELLONY: Isaac Bellony has made an instant impact for the Shorebirds since joining their roster on May 30. In eight games for the Shorebirds, Bellony is batting .323 (10/31) and has two doubles, three triples, and has driven in seven runs. He's collected two RBI in three of those games and is already the team-leader in three-baggers after picking up his third on Tuesday night versus Down East.

THE WOODIES ARE IN TOWN: The Shorebirds play host to one of the hottest teams in the league, the Down East Wood Ducks who just won five of six games against the Columbia Fireflies who previously had the best record in the league. These two teams last played in Kinston from May 9-14 where they split their six game series, but Delmarva was held to a .184 team batting average in the series with 65 strikeouts (10.8/game)

TODAY'S STARTER: Moises Chace gets the call as the starter on Wednesday night. He'll be making his 5th start and 11th total appearance of the season.

LAST OUTING (6/1 vs FBG): Chace's last appearance was one of his more difficult ones of the season as he only went 2.2 innings, allowing season-highs in runs and hits with five apiece. He tossed 79 pitches in the outing and did not factor into the final decision and in an 8-7 defeat in extra innings.

vs. DOWN EAST: Today will be the fourth time Chace will face the Down East Wood Ducks and the third time this season. Chace appeared twice in the first series these two teams played in Kinston. The first time he pitched was as a starter on May 9 and he recorded a new career-high for strikeouts with 8 across 3 innings. He then came out of the bullpen in the finale on May 14 and went 2.2 innings, recording 4 more strikeouts but allowed a career-high for walks with 5 although he picked up a winning decision. His final start of 2022 was versus Down East and he tossed five shutout innings, allowing just two hits and a walk as he earned a win in a 4-1 victory.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: The right-hander spend all of 2022 in Delmarva had a nice first season in full-season baseball as he finished the season making 19 appearances and 14 starts that covered 59.2 innings. His record was 3-5 and struck out an impressive with 64 with 42 walks. Opponents hit just .213 against him on the mound.



MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League.
