LAST LEG: After splitting last week's final home series of the 2023 season, the FredNats are fighting for their lives in the chase for the 2nd half crown in the Carolina League North. Fredericksburg travels to Salisbury, MD for the second time in the 2nd half to face the Delmarva Shorebirds - Single-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles - for the final week of the regular season. The Freddies come into play today 4.5 games back of the division lead with seven games to play - the two teams will play a doubleheader on Wednesday to make up for a rainout in July when Fredericksburg last visited Delmarva. The team's elimination number is three, which is a combination of wins from the Carolina Mudcats and FredNat losses needed to eliminate Fredericksburg. Lynchburg is also still in the mix, sitting 3.0 games behind Carolina and 1.5 games ahead of the FredNats. Those three teams are the only three still alive in the 2nd half. RHP Riley Cornelio gets the first of two scheduled starts this week against the Shorebirds. In two starts against Delmarva this year, Cornelio has allowed nine earned runs in seven and two thirds.

ABOUT LAST GAME: Lynchburg hit home runs in each of the first two innings of Sunday's game and led wire-to-wire, holding on to a 6-5 victory in the final home game of the regular season for the FredNats. Fredericksburg trailed 6-3 going into the bottom of the 9th and scored twice, but couldn't complete the comeback. Elijah Green hit his fourth home run of the season to right center, and John McHenry had two hits including an RBI double in the 9th inning.

TO THE MAX: Max Romero Jr. has been one of the hottest hitters in the Carolina League since returning from a second stint on the injured list in June. He currently own the longest on-base streak at both the Single-A and High-A levels of Minor League Baseball at 30, hit two walk-off home runs in August, and had his first multi-homer game of his professional career last week against Lynchburg. Since returning from the injured list on June 23, Romero is slashing .308/.461/.492 for an OPS of .953, and his wRC+ is 174 (100 is average). wRC+ measure overall offensive value in terms of runs created. His ISO (Isolated Power) is also .185 in that time frame, which means his extra base power is significantly helping the FredNat offense.

MORE HARDWARE: For the first time this year, a FredNat pitcher won a weekly award. RHP Luke Young was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for his effort last week against Lynchburg of 7 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 9 K. The FredNats have won eight games in a row that Young has started, and he has 19 strikeouts and just three walks in his last two starts. He set a career-high with 10 strikeouts two starts ago against Salem, and then followed that up last week with the longest start of the year by any FredNat pitcher of seven innings. He needed only 86 pitches to get through those seven frames as well. Young, a former 11th round pick of the Nationals out of Midland JC (TX), joined the starting rotation in June and has become the most consistent arm for Fredericksburg in the 2nd half of the season. Young becomes the fourth FredNat in the last six weeks to win a Player of the Week honor in the Carolina League, following Andrew Pinckney, Dylan Crews and Yohandy Morales, all of whom have been promoted from Fredericksburg since.

CLOSE IT OUT: After major early-season struggles, the FredNat bullpen has been a force for the team of late, and has been a huge reason why the FredNats are back in contention in the 2nd half. Fredericksburg is 48-5 when leading after seven innings this year, including 13 consecutive wins. The FredNats are also 46-3 when leading after 8, and haven't lost a game that they've led in the 8th inning since May.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 33, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

TONIGHT'S START: Riley Cornelio made his professional debut for the Fredericksburg Nationals in a start at Fayetteville this season, after being selected in the 7th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. The 22 year-old righty more than answered the bell, firing five innings with just one earned run, while picking up seven punchouts to just a pair of walks. However, he was saddled with the loss in a 3-2 defeat against the Woodpeckers.

A stalwart for the TCU Horned Frogs, Cornelio led the team in '22 with 15 starts, and also finished first with 77 strikeouts in 75.0 innings of work.

The right-hander excelled in Big 12 action, posting a 3.12 ERA with 40 strikeouts in just seven starts. His work earned him 2nd Team All Big-12 honors.

HIGH HONORS: Cornelio was a highly touted arm coming out of Pine Creek HS in Monument, Colorado. Baseball America tabbed him as the top overall draft prospect in the state for 2019, as he earned both the Perfect Game and Gatorade Colorado Player of the Year award in his senior campaign

LAST TIME OUT: Cornelio was effective in his most recent start at home, against the Lynchburg Hillcats. He gave the Freddies five solid innings, allowing three earned runs(four total) with four punchouts and three walks in a no-decision.
