The Lugnuts won the first game of the series, but the Loons have prevailed each of the last two nights, striking out 18 Lugnuts in each of those games.

Last Night: Loons 8, Lugnuts 5. Great Lakes bombarded Nuts starter **Oswaldo Berrios** with 13 hits in the first five innings en route to building an 8-0 lead, but the Lugnuts struck back with four runs in the 7th, including a **Jared McDonald** 442-foot two-run homer, and then placed their first three runners on base in the 9th before falling in defeat. Center fielder **Brayan Buevas** singled, doubled and walked twice in the loss.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Loons through Sunday, take a day off on May 23, and then continue this 12-game, 13-day homestand with a six-game series at the Beloit Sky Carp. The Lugnuts' next home game is on May 31, opening a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

Streiking: C **Jared McDonald** went 2-for-4 last night, reaching base in his team-high 13th consecutive game.

May Power: With another longball yesterday, the Lugnuts have slugged a league-leading 27 roundtrippers in 16 games in May after hitting 11 homers in 20 freezing games in April, the second-fewest total in the MWL. The Lugnuts are slashing .261/.346/.482 (.828 OPS) this month.

As a Team: The Lugnuts' offense ranks 3rd in the MWL in batting average (.249), 3rd in base hits (289), 3rd in total bases (468), tied for 2nd in home runs (38), 2nd in fewest strikeouts (325), 3rd in OBP (.334), 4th in slugging percentage (.404) and 4th in OPS (.738).

Among the MWL Leaders: 3B **Brett Harris** ranks 2nd in the Midwest League in OBP (.429), 3rd in slugging (.602), 4th in OPS (1.031) and tied for 4th in runs scored (22). INF **Euribiel Angeles** is tied for 5th with 38 hits, starter **Oswaldo Berrios** is tied for 4th with 35 1/3 innings pitched, and reliever **Angello Infante** and **Kumar Nambiar** are tied for 3rd with 12 appearances. Starter **Jeff Criswell** owns the only shutout in the league thus far, a seven-inning one-hitter at Lake County.

Speeding Things Up: The Lugnuts have played only one nine-inning game this year longer than three hours: on April 10 against Lake County, a three-hour, 31-minute game held before the pitch clock was strictly enforced. The Lugnuts' average duration for a nine-inning game this year is two hours and 36 minutes (with yesterday's right in line at 2:35) compared to three hours and 15 minutes last year and two hours and 54 minutes in 2019. Interestingly, the Lugnuts' average time of game 15 years ago, in 2007, was two hours and 38 minutes.

Lugnuts Alumni Spotlight: Starter **Jack Cushing**, who dominated for the Lugnuts last year and threw a seven-inning 9-K complete game at Great Lakes, fired eight scoreless innings to lead Double-A Midland to a 3-0 victory over San Antonio. Cushing scattered four hits and a walk while striking out five in lowering his ERA to 3.20. Fellow 2021 Lugnut **Michael Guldberg** went 3-for-3 with a walk, raising his batting average to .351.

166 Major League Nuts: Pitcher **Danny Young** (2016 in Lansing) debuted for the Seattle Mariners on May 9 with 2 1/3 scoreless innings in relief, becoming the 166th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fifth this year, joining Oakland A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and infielder **Christian Lopes** and Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra**.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2004: With all eyes on him and a Thursday night crowd of 9,823 in attendance, rehabbing Mark Prior made his first appearance since the 2003 National League Championship Series, beginning his road back to the Majors. Prior faced the minimum in three innings, striking out five and issuing one walk – to Drew Macias, who was then caught stealing by catcher Jake Fox to end the second inning. The Lugnuts defeated the Fort Wayne Wizards, 2-1, on two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Brian Dopirak tied the game with a two-out RBI double. Three batters later, Fox drew a walk-off walk to bring in Dopirak. Future Major Leaguer Carlos Marmol picked up the win, allowing one run in six innings and striking out eight.

Name Game: Nicknamed Mac (from his middle name, McLean, pronounced "mick-LANE") by his parents to avoid confusion with his father, whose first name is also Brian.

Giant Ties: Mac's godfather is Mike Krukow, who pitched 14 years in MLB (1976-89) with the Cubs, Giants and Phillies, and is in his 30th season broadcasting for the San Francisco Giants. Krukow was honored as the 2015 and 2017 California Sportscaster of the Year.

Welcome Aboard: Mac becomes the 10th different Lugnuts starting pitcher this year, joining Osvaldo Berrios, Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Joey Estes, Diego Granado, the injured Grant Holman and Hogan Harris, the promoted David Leal and the demoted James Gonzalez.

Templeton High School: Was team captain on the varsity of baseball team all four years of high school, playing first base and pitching... honored as Max Preps First Team All-American, Max Preps First Team All-State and Under Armour Preseason All-American... member of Team USA... posted 1.46 ERA in 272 2/3 combined high school innings.

College Days: Mac majored in business at Gonzaga... pitched in 13 games, six starts, as a freshman: 3-1, 3.99, 49 2/3 IP, 17 BB, 37 K... in college debut, February 18, 2017, vs. Duke: 6 IP, 1 R, 8 K... started WCC championship on May 27: 6 IP, 1 R, 4 K vs. BYU... made 16 starts as a sophomore: 7-4, 2.95 ERA, 100 2/3 IP, 28 BB, 73 K... named to 2018 All-WCC Second Team and WCC All-Tournament Team... started WCC championship game again and earned win: 7 2/3 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 7 K in 17-2 win over Pepperdine... in junior year, started 13 games: 6-4, 5.06 ERA, 74 2/3 IP, 15 BB, 69 K... 2019 All-WCC Honorable Mention... in senior year, made four starts: 2.55 ERA, 24 2/3 IP, 8 BB, 33 K, .202 avg.... opened season with six shutout innings, 9 K, vs. BYU.

A Second Zag: Lardner played at Gonzaga at the same time as current Lugnuts teammate Brett Harris, overlapping in 2019 and 2020 in Spokane.

Midwest League – uh, High-A Central – Experience: Lardner was signed as an undrafted free agent by the St. Louis Cardinals in 2020 following the five-round draft, spending his professional debut season with the Peoria Chiefs (0-6, 5.91 ERA, 21 G, 14 GS, 67 IP, 22 BB, 73 K... opened season as the Chiefs' No. 3 starter and turned in four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, vs. Cedar Rapids on May 6, 2021, in his pro debut... did not pitch against Dayton nor Lansing... longest outing was his last: 6 2/3 IP on Sept. 18 vs. theernels... finished with 0.87 GO/AO ratio... allowed .305 avg. to left-handers, .253 to right-handers.

The Next Step: Released by the St. Louis Cardinals on March 28, Mac signed with the Washington Wild Things on April 7... said Washington manager Tom Vaeth, "Mac is an important signing for us, being a rookie and left-handed he helps fill the void left by Hennen's departure. Mac was very successful while at Gonzaga with a reputation as a strike thrower with a three-pitch mix. After bouncing between starting and relieving while with the Cardinals, we feel Mac will return to his old form pitching in the rotation..." unfortunately for Washington, the Oakland Athletics signed Mac on May 4.

Lugnuts Debut: Started against the Dayton Dragons on May 14... tossed perfect 1st inning, striking out Jose Torres and Justice Thompson... allowed leadoff double to Alex McGarry in the 2nd and two-out walk to Nick Quintana, but struck out Allan Cerda and J.V. Martinez to strand two... things unraveled in the 3rd inning, however: two outs, none on, Elly De La Cruz doubled, Justice Thompson singled, Alex McGarry homered, Rece Hinds doubled and Allan Cerda singled, ending his outing... Lugnuts rallied to Mac's defense, beating Dayton 8-7.
