YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 7-2. **Ismael Munguia** led off the game with a solo homer on the third pitch thrown by Bowie starter Justin Armbruester. Coby Mayo tied the game with an RBI single in the third. In the sixth, **Andy Thomas** gave the Flying Squirrels the lead with an RBI groundout and **Hayden Cantrelle** added an RBI single for a 3-1 lead. Bowie scored a run on a passed ball in the bottom of the sixth to close the score to 3-2. The Flying Squirrels brought in four runs in the seventh. Munguia scored on a balk, Cantrelle worked a bases-loaded walk and **Riley Mahan** hit a two-run single to extend the lead to five runs. **Mason Black** struck out eight batters over four innings. **Raymond Burgos** and **Blake Rivera** each pitched a scoreless inning out of the bullpen. The Richmond pitchers combined for 14 strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today marks the fourth of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. The Flying Squirrels return to Prince George's Stadium for a six-game series from June 13-18. The Baysox visit The Diamond for a six-game set from July 4-9 and again from August 8-13. The Flying Squirrels are 9-6 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels are 7-4 in games following a win.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won eight-of-the-last-11 games and are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Altoona. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games before taking four-of-six last week against the SeaWolves. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in batting average (.253), runs (106), hits (150), total bases (232), RBIs (92), OBP (.350) and OPS (.741). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (200) and have the EL's second-best ERA (3.27).

THE BAYSUX have lost six straight and eight-of-their-last-nine games, including four-of-five in last week's series in Altoona. Bowie's pitching staff currently holds the third-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (3.39). Bowie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including Coby Mayo (No. 10), Heston Kjerstad (No. 12), Cade Povich (No. 13), Justin Armbruester (No. 20), Chayce McDermott (No. 23), Cesar Prieto (No. 25), John Rhodes (No. 27) and Carlos Tavera (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Kjerstad (No. 5), Mayo (No. 9), Povich (No. 12), Prieto (No. 17), McDermott (No. 18) and Rhodes (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his fourth start of the season and the sixth of his career against the Baysox. Last time out, Teng struck out eight batters over four scoreless innings and allowed one hit with no walks on Saturday against the SeaWolves. He is currently ranked fourth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (25). Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 2021 and 2022 seasons, Teng combined for 311 strikeouts, which was the fourth-most in the minor leagues during that span. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR BDWIE: Left-hander Cade Povich makes his fourth start of the year. He last pitched last Friday at Altoona and worked four innings, allowing five runs. Povich was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round in 2021 out of the University of Nebraska. He was traded from the Twins to the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas and RHP Juan Nunez for RHP Jorge Lopez. He reached Double-A for the first time last year, going 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA over six outings. He has made one appearance in his career against the Flying Squirrels, which was at Prince George's Stadium on September 6, 2022, when he allowed four runs in 0.2 relief innings.

STARTING STRONG: The Flying Squirrels lead the Southwest Division with an 12-6 record this year, tied for the best start in team history through 18 games, which they also did in 2018. The team's best start through 19 games was 12-7 in 2018. This year, Richmond went 4-0 to start the season, the longest unbeaten streak to start a year in franchise history.

RISPY BUSINESS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .318 (56-for-176) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .325 (26-for-80). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .310 average (88-for-284).

HITZ-GERALD: With his triple on Tuesday at Bowie, Tyler Fitzgerald became the first player in the Eastern League this year with three three-base hits. He added three hits in Wednesday's win over the Baysox, including a double, and scored three runs, and he hit a double on Thursday night. On the year, Fitzgerald is seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.328), seventh in OBP (.423), fifth in SLG (.557), seventh in OPS (.980), tied for third in hits (20), first in triples (3), tied for second in extra-base hits (9), tied for third in total bases (34) and tied for second in runs scored (14).

HEY, HAYDEN: Hayden Cantrelle has hit safely in 11-of-his-last-12 games, batting .318 (14-for-44) with four doubles, eight RBIs and 10 runs scored while adding three stolen bases. For the season, Cantrelle is tied for ninth in the Eastern League with 11 runs scored.

MATOS MANIA: Luis Matos has reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games. His 17-game on-base streak is the longest in the Eastern League this year. Matos has reached base 28 total times with 16 hits and 12 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. For the year, Matos has struck out just six times in 75 plate appearances (8.0 percent).

TAKE A WALK: Andy Thomas is tied for second in Eastern League with 16 walks. He leads the Eastern League with a 25.8-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in eight-of-his-13 games played so far this season. In the first three games of this week's series, he has hit .500 (5-for-10) with a homer, a double and four RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Patrick Bailey is ranked tied for fourth in batting average (.333) and tied for seventh in hits (18). Tyler Fitzgerald is seventh in batting average (.328), seventh in OBP (.423), fifth in SLG (.557), seventh in OPS (.980), tied for third in hits (20), first in triples (3), tied for second in extra-base hits (9), tied for third in total bases (34) and tied for second in runs scored (14).Carter Aldrete is tied for sixth in RBIs (12). Andy Thomas is tied for second in walks (16). Ismael Munguia is first in runs scored (15). Luis Matos is tied for fifth in runs scored (13). Kai-Wei Teng is fourth in strikeouts (25). Mason Black is tied for sixth in strikeouts (22).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is third in batting average (.371), ninth in OBP (.413), first in hits (26) and sixth in total bases (33). Heston Kjerstad is first in homers (6), first in SLG (.629), third in OPS (1.013), tied for second in extra-base hits (9), tied for first in total bases (39) and tied for second in runs scored (14). John Rhodes is tied for sixth in RBIs (6). Coby Mayo is tied for third in doubles (6), tied for second in extra-base hits (9) and tied for seventh in total bases (32).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Erik Miller (No. 15), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
