**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Hartford Yard Goats, Eastern League affiliate of the Colorado Rockies.

Jack Mahoney, fresh off the injured list, takes the ball tonight for the Yard Goats. The 24-year-old righty from Algonquin, IL was Colorado's 3rd round pick in 2023 out of South Carolina. He grew up about an hour away from where Curve righty Mike Walsh did in the Chicago-area. In 26 career starts for the Yard Goats, he's gone 5-10 with a 5.57 ERA and walked 52 batters in 114.2 innings. Jack's sister, Shea, was a gymnast at the University of Alabama, wrapping up her career there in 2020.

**IF ALL THE ICE MELTS, IS IT JUST BERG LETTUCE?:** Catcher **Derek Berg** has emerged as a one of Altoona's top contributors at the plate in late-May. Berg has a hit in seven straight games dating back to May 17, in that time he's hitting .345 (10-for-29) with 2 2B, 3 HR and 6 RBI.

**IT'S NICE TO DUMITRU:** In his last 10 games, outfielder **Titus Dumitru** has hit .324/.390/.649 (1.039 OPS) with 6 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI since May 17. He is 7-for-19 with 4 2B and 2 HR this week at Hartford.

**WALKING THE TIGHT ROPE:** Each of Altoona's first four games with Hartford have been decided by one run.

**CAPTAIN MURDOCK:** Reliever **Noah Murdock** has bounced back from a rough team debut to become one of Altoona's most reliable arms out of the bullpen. He's unscored upon in his last 6 outings, covering 10.0 innings he's allowed just 4 hits, 2 walks and struck out 11 (0.60 WHIP, .121 BAA).

**'CURT SCHILLING?':** Right-hander **Khristian Curtis** ranks 1st among Eastern League hurlers with 57 strikeouts, 3rd among Double-A arms. Curtis tossed a career-long 7.0 innings on May 26 at Hartford, a start in which he allowed just one earned run and did not walk a batter for the second time in 10 starts this year. He ranks 2nd among Pirates Minor Leaguers in strikeouts behind Greensboro's Seth Hernandez (68).

**LAWNBALL LONNIE:** Outfielder **Lonnie White Jr.** homered in three straight games from May 15-17, the first such stretch of his career. Since arriving in Altoona, White Jr. has 10 extra-base hits in 24 games since joining the Curve on May 1.

This season, White Jr. is T-1st among Pirates minor leaguers with 12 homers, he also ranks 4th in RBI (32), 3rd in BB (31) and 4th in SB (14).

**SAN MARINO:** Named Altoona's 2025 Pitcher of the Year, righty **Alessandro Ercolani** has returned as a reliever this season and gone 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1 ER / 8.2 IP) in his last 7 outings.

**WILLY T:** Around a brief injured list stint, outfielder **Will Taylor** has emerged as one of Altoona's most consistent hitters. Taylor has reached in 13 straight games around the IL stint (.446 OBP) and stretching back to April 19 (23G) he's hitting .300 with 5 2B, 3 HR and 16 RBI, recording a .479 on-base percentage and a .979 OPS.

**ITS OUTTA HERE:** The Curve have recorded 13 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs. The Curve have hit 49 home runs in 49 games, they're on pace to hit 137 homers this season which would be the most in a season since 2023 when the club hit 122 round trippers. Altoona's franchise record of 143 homers in a season was set in 2022.

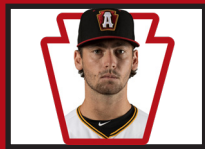

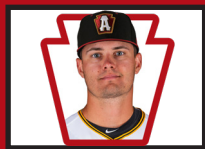
