FRES-NOTES

COMEBACK CLAWS WIN ON THURSDAY: The Fresno Grizzlies (9-18, 47-45) scraped past the Stockton Ports (10-17, 36-55) 7-3 Thursday night from Banner Island Ballpark. The Grizzlies enjoyed their seventh comeback claws triumph in the seventh inning or later, snapping their five-game losing streak. Fresno's first victory since the All-Star Break also halted their three-game losing skid to Stockton. The Grizzlies improved to 76-29 all-time against the Ports (15-6 record this season) with a 41-10 all-time record (11-4 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. For the fourth consecutive contest, the Grizzlies scored in the first inning. Fresno has alternated one and two runs in those four games. Andy Perez swatted a first pitch single up the middle, his third straight affair with a leadoff hit (double, homer, single). Then, Jason Hinchman demolished a two-run blast to right-center field, his third homer of the year. The Ports took a 3-2 lead after plating one run in the fourth, fifth and sixth frames. The one-run Ports' lead held until the top of the ninth when the Grizzlies' comeback claws appeared, roaring for five runs. Hinchman, Nick Gile and Fadiel Cruz all drew walks, loading the bases for Ben McCabe with one out. McCabe worked the count full before he was beaten by a pitch, knocking the contest at three. Still with only one out, Caleb Hobson stepped up the dish, looking to push Fresno in front. On a 1-2 offering, Hobson clobbered a go-ahead, ground-rule double to center, adding Gile and Cruz. After a pitching change, Perez provided two insurance runs with a single up the middle, giving him another multi-hit night. The four-run advantage was enough in the bottom of the ninth, as the Grizzlies celebrated a huge win. Grizzlies' southpaw Albert Pacheco logged another quality start after six innings of three-run ball. Pacheco scattered eight hits and one walk while striking out five. He whiffed the first two batters of the game, induced one enormous double play and received some nice defensive help. Bryson Hammer (5-3) was awarded the win after two scoreless frames. Hammer left four runners stranded in his appearance. Sam Weatherly wrapped up the last inning with two punchouts.

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the fourth of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the third set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 76-29 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 41-10 all-time record (11-4 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

PEREZ PITCHES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Bryan Perez. Perez signed with the Rockies as an International Free Agent on January 15, 2021 out of the Dominican Republic at 16 years old. He was considered the Top Pitching Prospect Signee by the Rockies in that signing period. Perez is the nephew of former MLB All-Star, World Series champion and No-Hitter recipient Edinson Volquez.

NO WALKS WHEN YOU FACE JACE: Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska has issued one walk over his last seven outings (June 9-July 24), spanning 39 innings. Hobson allowed 42 hits and fanned 48 batters in that stretch. He has also not permitted a walk in four straight games (June 30-July 24), spanning 23 innings. Kaminska has scattered 20 hits and struck out 27 batters in that stretch.

ANDY PEREZ IS A MULTI-HIT MACHINE: Since June 27 (22 games), Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez has tallied 14 multi-hit contests. Perez picked up two or more hits from June 27-July 1 (5 games) and has enjoyed multiple hits in three straight games of the current series against the Ports. Perez has also led off all three games in the Stockton series, providing a hit in his first plate appearance (double, homer and single). Two of those three hits have come on the first pitch of the game.

ANDY IS DANDY: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez ranks among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. Perez ranks first in hits (102), first in total bases (159), tied for first in triples (6), second in extra-base hits (35), tied for second in doubles (21), third in RBI (57), tied for sixth in batting average (.288) and ninth in slugging percentage (.449).

ANDY PEREZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez joined the Grizzlies record books after logging his 13th career triple with two outs in the top of the first June 29 at San Jose. He is now tied with Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick for ninth all-time with those 13 triples. Up next for Perez are Clay Timpner and Jason Ellison, who have tallied 14 triples apiece.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on June 29 at San Jose was his sixth triple of 2024, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records AGAIN. Perez (2023), Preston Tucker, Nate Schierholtz, Jason Ellison and Calvin Murray each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native would become the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 67 times in 174 plate appearances (37 games; 39% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 37 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 32 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-29 (.310) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-37, 46% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (27/31 in stolen bases on the season).

RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 27 bases this season. Hobson is currently eight stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.

2023 (pro): Spent 2nd straight season stateside with the ACL Rockies, making 10 starts...Went 1-0 with a 7.43 ERA over 36.1 innings...Struck out 37 batters...Notched career-highs in almost every pitching category...Had 6 starts where he tossed 4 or more innings and allowed 2 earned runs or less.

2022 (pro): Spent 1st season stateside with the ACL Rockies, appearing in 4 games (3 starts)...Went 1-3 with a 9.00 ERA over 12 innings...Gave up 1 homer among his 15 runs allowed (12 earned)...Gave up 21 hits, walked 2 batters and struck out 9.

2021 (pro): Spent 1st professional season with DSL Colorado, appearing in 11 games (9 starts)...Went 0-1 with a 2.78 ERA over 32.1 innings...Had a 1.57 ERA (28.2 IP, 5 ER) as a starter and had a 12.27 ERA (3.2 IP, 5 ER) as a reliever...Struck out 35 and walked just 10 batters (1.14 WHIP).
