YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 4-3, in 10 innings. The Curve scored a pair of unearned runs in the top of the first to take a 2-0 lead. Seth Beer brought in a run on a fielder's choice and Yoyner Fajardo added an RBI single. The Flying Squirrels tied the game, 2-2, in the bottom of the third. After a leadoff double by **Alerick Soularie**, **Jimmy Glowenke** doubled him in and then scored on a double by **Andy Thomas**. In the bottom of the sixth, **Christian Koss** gave the Flying Squirrels a 3-2 lead with an RBI single. Altoona evened the score, 2-2, in the top of the seventh inning with an RBI single by Kervin Pichardo. In the top of the 10th, Tsung-Che Cheng moved the Curve ahead with an RBI single. Justin Meis worked two scoreless innings, including sitting the Flying Squirrels in order in the bottom of the ninth inning. J.C. Flowers pitched 2.1 scoreless relief innings for the Curve. **Hayden Birdsong** started for the Flying Squirrels and struck out six over five innings, allowing two unearned runs to lower his season ERA to 2.05. **Tanner Kiest** struck out two in 2.1 innings and allowed one unearned run. Altoona starter Sean Sullivan worked 5.2 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the finale of a six-game series at The Diamond. This series marks the first meetings between the two teams this year. The Curve return to Richmond for a six-game series from Aug. 20-25. The Flying Squirrels play two six-game sets in Altoona this year, the first from July 30-Aug. 4 and the last to close the regular season from Sept. 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 14-9 in their last 23 games, the second-best record in the league over that span, after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They had won five-of-six in two straight series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond last week. They are 2-3 in this week's series against the Curve and 4-7 over the 11 games played in the current homestand.

THE CURVE are in last place in the Southwest Division. They snapped a five-game losing streak with Thursday night's win and have now won three straight games for the second time this season. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF/1B Jase Bowen (No. 19) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26). There are seven Altoona players on Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects list, including Chandler (No. 3), Solometo (No. 5), Harrington (No. 6), Cheng (No. 7), Ashcraft (No. 10), Bowen (No. 26) and Gonzalez (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his 11th start of the season and the third of his career against the Curve. He started the series opener on Tuesday against the Curve and pitched six scoreless innings, his sixth scoreless start of the season. He also faced the Curve on August 4, 2023 in Altoona and pitched five scoreless innings, allowing two hits. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. In the Eastern League this season, Bertrand is ranked tied for third in HR/9 (0.47), fifth in groundball percentage (53.8%), fifth in BB/9 (2.05), sixth in ERA (2.68), tied for sixth in WHIP (1.11), seventh in BB% (5.6%) and tied for ninth in innings pitched (57.0). Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander Anthony Solometo makes his ninth start and 12th overall appearance of the year. He started against the Flying Squirrels on Wednesday and allowed two runs over two innings in a loss. Solometo has made one other start in his career against the Flying Squirrels. On August 2, 2023 at PNC Field, he allowed three runs over five innings in a loss. Solometo was selected in the second round (37th overall) by the Pirates in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, N.J. He has been named an MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star each of the last two years. Last year, he was also named an All-MiLB Prospect Second Team pick by MiLB.com and a Baseball America Class A All-Star. He made 12 starts last season with High-A Greensboro, going 2-3 with a 2.30 ERA before a June promotion to Double-A Altoona, where he went 2-4 with a 4.35 ERA in 12 starts. Solometo is rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Pirates prospect and No. 5 by Baseball America.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,055).

TAKE IT FOR GRANTED: In his last 23 games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .316 (24-for-77) with two homers, nine doubles, three triples, nine walks, 10 RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .210. McCray is tied for third in the Eastern League in triples (3), tied for fifth in doubles (14) and tied for fifth in extra-base hits (23). Last Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the previous weeks' series in Bowie. Prior to going 0-for-1 on Friday night, McCray had reached base in 14 consecutive games dating back to May 12, which was tied for the third longest active streak in the Eastern League and is the longest by a Flying Squirrels player so far this season.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: **Andy Thomas** is batting .328 (21-for-64) over his last 19 games since May 15 with two homers, six doubles, a triple and 16 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .250. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. On Wednesday night, Thomas came off the bench and hit an RBI triple in the eighth inning for an insurance run, the second triple of his professional career. On Thursday, he hit his second homer of the season. He added two hits on Friday and an RBI double on Saturday.

OPEN THE GATES: This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.42 ERA (5 ER/31.2 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings last week against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on Friday against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Gates followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on Tuesday night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 66 Double-A games, combining for a 3.28 ERA (35 ER/96.0 IP).

SETTING THE TABLE: Over his last eight games since May 31, **Carter Howell** is batting .367 (11-for-30) with a homer, two doubles, a triple, two walks, three RBIs and three runs scored. He has picked up two hits in four of his last-seven starts. In his 22 games batting first in the Flying Squirrels' lineup this year, Howell is batting .303 (27-for-89). He is also batting .340 (16-for-35) when leading off an inning. This season, he is batting .440 (11-for-25) in the first inning.

BLANK SPACE: Three of the Flying Squirrels' last four wins have been shutouts. They shut out the SeaWolves twice last week. Last Tuesday, **Hayden Birdsong** covered six scoreless innings before **Nick Swiney** and **Tyler Myrick** worked the final three in a 5-0 win. On Friday night, **Matt Frisbee** started and pitched 4.2 innings before being replaced by **Evan Gates**, who worked a career-high 3.1 innings. Myrick threw a scoreless ninth to close his fourth save of the year. On Tuesday to begin this series, **John Michael Bertrand** pitched six innings, **Mat Olsen** worked a scoreless seventh and Gates retired the final six outs in a 1-0 win over the Curve. The Flying Squirrels' seven shutout wins this season are tied for second-most in the Eastern League with Harrisburg, trailing only Akron with eight.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
