This Evening: The Lugnuts play the penultimate game of a six-game series tonight at the Cedar Rapids Kernels, Lansing's only road trip at a West Division team this season, 23-year-old right-hander Colin Peluse makes his sixth start of the season for the Nuts, opposed by 25-year-old Kernels right-hander Tyler Beck in his fifth start.

On Deck: The Nuts and Kernels play a matinee tomorrow, wrapping up the series, and then Lansing packs up and boards the bus for the seven-hour trip home. An off day follows on Monday, affording R&R, before the Dayton Dragons arrive in town for a six-game series running from Tuesday, June 29, through Sunday, July 4.

On the Air: Tonight's game is on MiLB.TV with broadcaster Chris Kleinhans-Schulz, and streaming online at <a href="http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing">http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing</a>, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Kernels 2. A night after the Kernels overcame four errors to defeat the Nuts, they committed two more costly errors in a tie-breaking three-run eighth, lifting the Lugnuts to their first win of the series and ending Cedar Rapids' eight-game winning streak.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

#### Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Recent Roster Moves: Today, outfielder Austin Beck was promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas. Two days ago, outfielder Lester Madden, Jr. was activated from the Injured List. Lansing now has 28 players active with four players (all pitchers) on the Injured List.

Alumni Report: 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., leads the Majors in OBP (.440), OPS (1.116), total bases (181) and RBIs (62); is tied for 1st in home runs (25); and ranks 2nd in slugging percentage (.675), 3rd in batting average (.340) and tied for 3rd in runs (58). Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette leads the Majors in runs scored (62).

Man of Steal: Infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is tied with South Bend's Delvin Zinn in leading all of Minor League Baseball with 29 stolen bases, eight more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield, Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 12 HBPs and is second in the High-A Central with 37 runs scored.

Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.71 earned run average (leading Cedar Rapids, which has lowered its team ERA to 3.75 by starting this series with three earned runs in 32 innings) with the second fewest walks in the league (147) and fourth most strikeouts (468). The Lugnuts also have the second best GO/AO ratio in the league at 1.22, trailing Cedar Rapids' ratio of 1.32.

A Fine First Impression: Right-handed reliever Zach Rafuse debuted, in both his first appearance of 2021 and his first appearance with Lansing, with six straight strikes last night, whiffing Jair Camargo and Gabe Snyder to set the tone for what would become two scoreless innings.

In Search of Pop: The Lugnuts have 18 base hits in this series, but only one - Max Schuemann's leadoff home run last night - has gone for extra bases.

Gorilla Ball: On the other hand, of the 12 runs Cedar Rapids has scored in this series, 10 have been scored on five swings - a series-opening grand slam from Gabriel Maciel, two home runs from Trey Cabbage and one apiece from Seth Gray and Jair Camargo.

Situational Spotlight: Lansing went 1-for-6 with runners in scoring position last night and is 1-for-29 in the four games of this series.

#### **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

2014: Trailing 6-5 to West Michigan with two outs and no one on in the bottom of the 9th, David Harris singled to left-center, Chaz Frank tripled him in, and Zac Reininger tossed a wild pitch to give the Lugnuts a 7-6 walk-off win. It was Reininger's first wild pitch of the year.

2016: The first seven Lugnuts batters in the bottom of the eighth inning all reached base and scored, helping the Lugnuts complete a four-game sweep of the West Michigan Whitecaps, 12-9, to open the second half. The game ended with a 5-3-6 double play.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Record-Setting, for Better or Worse: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons. On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 13 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Familiar Settings: 10 of the 28 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut to hail from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. Earlier this season, the Nuts featured two Michigan Wolverines in Jeff Criswell (injured) and Jack Weisenburger (promoted).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 17 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are more than a little familiar with one another. Reid Birlingmair and Charlie Cerny pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though William Simoneit played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing Colin Peluse by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake. Coincidentally, Peluse was hosted on his own Wake Forest college visit by 2019 Lugnuts infielder Johnny Aiello.



Last Outing: Started June 19 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits and a walk in four innings, striking out three... allowed two runs in the 3rd on a Leonel Valera RBI triple and a Jared McDonald passed ball... gave up a Deacon Liput two-run HR in the 4th... Lugnuts rallied from 2-0, 4-2, and 5-4 deficits to win 6-5 in 10 innings on Elvis Peralta, Jr.'s walk-off single.

#### 2021 in Lansing: left-handers are hitting .205/.247/.288, right-handers .377/.441/.660

- Made 2021 debut by piggybacking Jeff Criswell and Shohei Tomioka on the fifth day of the season, Saturday, May 8th vs. Lake County, tossing three scoreless innings in the Lugnuts' 2-0 four-hit shutout victory... worked with catcher William Simoneit, a fellow Demon Deacon, to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base in the 6th inning... opened the ninth with two walks and was taken out in favor of Aiden McIntyre, who sewed up the win with two strikeouts and a comebacker. Pitched at Dayton, Saturday, May 15th... after Seth Shuman started and fired two perfect innings, twirled five strong innings of relief, allowing two hits and one run, one walk and seven strikeouts... gave up a Brian Rey solo homer while striking out the side in the 6th... departed with a 2-1 lead, but Michael Danielak gave up a two-run homer to Spillane in the 8th, leading to a 3-2 Lugnuts loss. Made first start of the season, May 22nd heavily anticipated prospect match-up vs. Fort Wayne southpaw Ethan Elliott never materialized, as Lugnuts hammered Elliott for three solo home runs while Peluse gave up 10 hits and eight runs in 3 1/3 innings, en route to 12-7 Lugnuts loss... allowed two hits but stranded the bases loaded in a scoreless 1st inning... gave up three runs on four hits in the 2nd, including a Grant Little two-run double... allowed a Jonny Homza solo home run in the 3rd... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, with new reliever Bryce Nightengale allowing all three inherited runners to score in a six-run TinCaps rally.
- Made his second start of the year and earned the win at home vs. Great Lakes on Saturday, May 29... pitched five innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits and no walks, striking out three... gave up solo home run to Andy Pages in the 1st... exited after allowing first two batters to reach base in the 6th, one of whom scored against reliever Bryce Nightengale... Lugnuts won the game, 7-3, with Jake Suddleson crunching a three-run homer in the 8th for insurance.
- Started June 5 vs. South Bend and overwhelmed the Cubs with 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings, allowing four hits, one walk and one run... struck out the side in the 1st... allowed only run in the 2nd inning on a Bryce Windham RBI single... struck out two more around a Josue Huma double in the 3rd... whiffed two in a perfect 4th... struck out two in a perfect 5th... departed after allowing a two-out single to Nelson Velazquez in the 6th... relievers Bryce Nightengale (2 1/3) and Aiden McIntyre (1 IP) combined for six more strikeouts in a 9-3 Lugnuts win.
- Started June 12 at West Michigan, charged with loss after allowing five runs on seven hits and two walks in 4 2/3 innings, striking out three... Lugnuts lost, 9-0... held the 'Caps scoreless for the first four innings before allowing five hits and five runs in the 5th.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increases from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 28 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing. His command has always been solid going back to his days at Wake Forest, and it showed up in his debut season in the Class A Short Season New York-Penn League, walking just six batters across 24 innings. Approaching his first full season in the Minors in 2021, Peluse will get a chance to show what he can do with his improved repertoire. His repeatable delivery projects him to stick as a starter."

Draft Day: Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of 10 Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 20th round (Jack Weisenburger), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 3 GS, 1.37 ERA, 26 1/3 IP, 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).

High School: At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team... was also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... in second start, junior year, on the Middletown Cavaliers baseball team, tossed no-hitter with 11 strikeouts at Wilmington Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, and then woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm... the injury led to Tommy John surgery, causing Peluse to miss entire senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.

Hometown: Middletown, Delaware, is in New Castle County, located in the northern part of the state just across from the Maryland border... it hosts the Olde Tyme Peach Festival each August and the Big Ball Marathon every Labor Day (a 24-hour baseballi marathon for charity played with an oversized softball, the "big ball")... St. Andrew's School in Middletown was the site for the filming of Dead Poets Society (1989), starring Robin Williams, with the theater scene in the movie filmed at Middletown's Everett Theatre... there was also an episode of The West Wing filmed at St. Andrew's School... Tampa Bay wide receiver Chris Godwin is from Middletown and attended Middletown H.S.
