FRES-NOTES

FOSSUM'S GRAND SEASON: Kyle Fossum smashed his fourth grand slam of the season in the series opener Tuesday. The Grizzlies have eight grand slams on the season and the last four have come from Fossum. All four of his have come in the last two months and Tuesday's was his second consecutive game belting a grand slam. Of his five other home runs, only one has come with anyone else on base as he's hit four solo homers, the first of which came in Ontario on April 16th.

DALIS DAYS OF SUMMER: Wilder Dalis has been on an absolute tear in July – a .388 average, 1.230 OPS, and 7 home runs across 21 games, numbers that would headline any month for any hitter in the league. His 30 RBI this month alone are more than double the next-closest teammate, and it's the driving force behind a Fresno offense that's hit .282 as a team in July – comfortably its best month of the season.

ON BASE COMPANY: Dalis hasn't carried the offense alone. Carlos Renzullo has strung together a strong July of his own – a .338 average and .841 OPS – while Cam Hassert has carved out a highly effective role, drawing 13 walks in just 43 at-bats for a .475 OBP and a .963 OPS. Between the three of them, Fresno's lineup has had real length, patience, and balance all month long.

A MONTH BUILT ON THE BATS: Fresno's .864 team OPS in July is its best mark of any month this season, powered by a lineup that's drawn 135 walks and kept the line moving from top to bottom. It's a big reason the Grizzlies enter the final days of July riding high in the standings, with the offense setting the tone night after night.
