LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones shut out the Renegades, 7-0, to snap a three-game losing streak...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 5.0 innings of one-hit ball, striking out seven... The 21-year-old carried a no-hit bid through 4.2 frames before 3B **Kiko Romero's** single in the top of the fifth...RHP **Ben Simon** tied a career-high with 3.0 innings of spotless relief before RHP **Jake Stevenson** recorded the final three outs in the ninth...2B **Junior Tilen** registered three of Brooklyn's eight hits, adding a double, and a solo home run in the third...LF **Kellum Clark** reached base twice with a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch and an infield single, driving in a run each time...The Mississippi State alum also had an outfield assist at the plate, throwing out 2B **Roc Riggio** trying to score on a fly out...SS **Jesús Báez** also drove in two with a single in the Cyclones' four-run second.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES/FRANKS HISTORY: On July 3, 2001, the Brooklyn Cyclones began a remarkable streak of 113 consecutive sellouts at Maimonides Park...The run ended on July 14, 2004, over three years later, when 6,464 fans came to see the nightcap of a day-night doubleheader...In 2015, RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** became just the second Cyclone to be traded while playing for the club...The right-hander was dealt to the Los Angeles Angels in exchange for International Signing Bonus Slot Number 90 (\$239,400)...In 2016, the Cyclones took the field for the first time as the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Nathan's Famous...Behind 10 strikeouts from RHP **Harol González** and 4.1 innings of scoreless relief, the Franks beat the Connecticut Tigers, 5-4...In 2019, Brooklyn scored four runs in the top of the ninth, taking the lead on a 1B **Joe Genord** three-run home run, to defeat Hudson Valley on the road, 8-5.

KODAI ISLAND: The New York Mets announced on Monday that RHP **Kodai Senga** will make a Major League rehab start for the Brooklyn Cyclones on Wednesday night vs. Hudson Valley...The 31-year-old was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on March 28 (retro 3/25) with a right shoulder capsule strain...He was transferred to the 60-day injured list on April 10...He will be the sixth player to make a Major League rehab appearance for the Cyclones on Coney Island this year, joining RHP **Sean Reid-Foley**, RHP **Tyler Megill**, RHP **Drew Smith**, C **Francisco Alvarez**, and RHP **Edwin Díaz**...Senga was a National League All-Star in his 2023 rookie campaign for the Mets, tallying a 12-7 record with a 2.98 ERA (55 ER in 166.1 IP), 77 walks (110 BB%), and 202 strikeouts (29.11 K%) in 29 starts...The Fukuoka, Japan, native finished second behind Arizona OF **Corbin Carroll** in the 2023 NL Rookie of the Year voting...Senga signed a five-year, \$75 million contract with the Mets on December 17, 2022.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision last Wednesday night in Aberdeen and threw 5.0 spotless innings to earn the win on Tuesday vs. Hudson Valley...Over his last three starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-0 with an 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP), allowing only five hits and six walks (10.0 BB%), while striking out 25 (41.67 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (63)...He is also tied for second in batting average against (.194), fourth in ERA (3.02), and sixth in WHIP (1.22)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is third in FIP (2.18), fourth in strikeout rate (36.3%), seventh in strikeouts (99), and ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%).

ZILCH, ZERO, NADA: RHPs **Jonah Tong** (5.0 IP), **Ben Simon** (3.0), and **Jake Stevenson** (1.0) combined on Brooklyn's ninth shutout win of the season, a two-hitter, in Tuesday's 7-0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Each of Brooklyn's last two victories have come in shutout fashion...RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (6.0 IP) and **Josh Hejka** (3.0) united on a three-hit blanking in a 7-0 rout at Aberdeen last Friday...The nine shutouts are the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for fifth most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...After making one appearance at Triple-A Syracuse on April 8, the 24-year-old has entered 17 times in relief for the Cyclones in 2024...Colón holds a 1-0 record with a 5.91 ERA (23 ER in 35.0 IP), 15 walks, and 21 strikeouts...Since throwing a South Atlantic League season-high 6.2 innings of scoreless relief at Hudson Valley on June 12, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native held a 2.08 ERA (3 ER in 13.0 IP), yielding 10 hits, three walks, and striking out nine...RHP **Victor Castañeda** has been transferred back from Triple-A Syracuse in a corresponding move.

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...Lorusso is eighth in the South Atlantic League in slugging (.481), walks (39), and total bases (117)...tied for eighth in home runs (11), ninth in OPS (.851), and 10th in extra-base hits (27)...Lorusso is second among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.851)...He is also third in slugging (.481), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (27), home runs (11), and triples (3), and fifth in total bases (117) and RBI (40)...Morabito is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (34)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for third in the circuit in stolen bases (23) and tied for fifth in hits (52)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.322), on-base

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn will play a home-and-home six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley boasts four of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley in the first meeting on Coney Island (May 23-28), but the Renegades to 4-of-6 from Brooklyn in their last meeting in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...In 2023, the Cyclones went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 147-151 (.493).

percentage (.426), and stolen bases (34)...He also is second in hits (83), third in OPS (.837) and runs scored (45), and tied for fourth in walks (40).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with last Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games over the next 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 2-6 in the stretch...The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8.

BROOKLYN-BOUND BÁEZ: INF **Jesús Báez** clobbered his first High-A home run in Saturday's loss and has reached base safely in each of his first seven games at the High-A level...Báez is the No. 15 prospect in the Mets' organization according to *Baseball America* and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and is the first player in franchise history born in 2005...In 64 games at the Single-A level, Báez accumulated a .262 average (66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25), fourth in runs scored (40), sixth in slugging (.444), and tied for sixth in doubles (16)...Among full-season Mets farmhands, the infielder is second in doubles (16) and total bases (124), third in hits (73) and extra-base hits (28), fourth in RBI (42), tied for fourth in runs scored (43), and home runs (11), and fifth in slugging (.443).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster last Monday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (.136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite appearing in only four games for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 29 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (66) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for third across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (138).

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...INF **Nick Lorusso** has mashed at Maimonides Park...In 29 home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .362/.443/.667 with a 1.110 OPS on Coney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 14 walks to 16 strikeouts...Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.362), on-base percentage (.443), slugging (.667), and OPS (1.110)...The University of Maryland alum ranks sixth, tied for 17th, tied for fourth, and fourth throughout Minor League Baseball in those four categories, respectively...In 36 road affairs, Lorusso hits .196/.317/.341 with a .658 OPS, adding five home runs and 22 RBI with 25 walks to 42 K's...On the other hand, OF **Nick Morabito** is loving his time on the road...He is hitting .333/.429/.444 with a .873 OPS, adding two home runs, seven RBI, and 22 stolen bases...Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old is tied for the most road hits in the circuit (36)...He is also tied for fourth in runs scored (23) while swiping seven more bases (22) than any other player in the league...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .235/.297/.265 line with a .562 OPS, two extra-base hits, an RBI, and a stolen base over 16 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has also thrived at home posting a .318/.375/.467 mark with a .842 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 30 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .164/.266/.245 with a .511 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 30 contests.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES RHP **Josh Hejka** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Monday...The submariner earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 63 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka accumulated a 6-3 record with a 2.41 ERA (28 ER in 104.2 IP) and eight saves, walking just 25 and striking out 95.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Jesús Báez** (15), **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

AWARD SEASON: The Fukuoka, Japan, native finished second behind unanimous winner Arizona OF **Corbin Carroll** in the 2023 National League Rookie of the Year voting...Senga received 22-of-30 second-place votes...The 31-year-old also finished seventh in the NL Cy Young Award race...Senga received three third-place votes...San Diego LHP **Blake Snell** captured the award with 28-of-30 possible first-place votes.

FAMILIAR FACES: Senga has spent plenty of time around the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...On April 30, C **José Hernández** and OF **Karell Paz** went to Citi Field to hit against the right-hander in a live batting practice session before that night's game against the Chicago Cubs...On June 9, while the New York Mets hosted a watch party for the India vs. Pakistan cricket match, Senga threw a bullpen to Brooklyn bullpen catcher **Donnie Sivoilella**...Additionally, last Wednesday, OF **Omar De Los Santos** hit live BP against Senga at Citi Field.

AROUND THE WORLD: Senga represented Team Japan in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, fueling his desire to play Major League Baseball...The 31-year-old was named to the WBC All-Tournament team after allowing just one earned run over 11.0 innings (0.82 ERA) with 16 strikeouts in four appearances.

SUPER SENGA: Senga struck out 202 batters as a rookie with the New York Mets in 2023...He joined RHP **Dwight Gooden** as the only rookies in franchise history to reach that plateau in a single season.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second defeat at the High-A level last Thursday night at Aberdeen... Allowed two runs on four hits over 6.0 innings... Walked two and struck out eight...Tossed a wild pitch...Threw a career-high-tying 94 pitches and 57 strikes (60.64%)...Ejected by home plate umpire **Dylan Hulse**y after arguing balls and strikes following the final out of the sixth inning...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** to start the bottom of the seventh and Brooklyn trailing, 2-1...The IronBirds went on to defeat the Cyclones, 6-1.

KADE YOU DIG IT? Morris has hit his stride with Brooklyn over his last two starts, earning quality starts in each...Since June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds an 0-1 record with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER in 12.0 IP)...Morris has surrendered seven hits and walked four, while striking out 12...In that time, he is third in the South Atlantic League in innings pitched (12.0) and sixth in batting average against (.167).

PROSPECT RADAR: Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 21 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*...He is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster per the publication.

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shutout innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.
