FROM THE CROWS NEST

TODAY IS A NEW DAY: Paced by a nine-run first inning, the Palm Beach Cardinals powered past the Bradenton Marauders 18-6 on Thursday night. The run total matched the most Bradenton allowed last season (9/1 vs TAM). Bradenton used a season high seven pitchers. Both the Cardinals and Marauders combined to draw 24 walks.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Marauders notched a season-high 14 hits and scored nine unanswered runs in their 12-6 win over the Cardinals on Wednesday afternoon. Their hit total matched their season high from 2024 (7/3 vs FIM) and gave them 27 over the first two games of the series. They finished 8-10 with runners in scoring position. Trailing 5-0 through the top of the fourth, Bradenton began to chip away, eventually scoring nine runs during their final-three trips to the plate. Five Marauders recorded multi-hit games including Derek Berg (2-for-4, 3B), Eddy Rodriguez (3-for-5, RBI) and Braylon Bishop (2-for-3, RBI). Relievers Jose Garces, Noah Takacs and Hunter Furtado combined for 4.2 innings of shutout ball while fanning eight hitters to slam the door.

ROUND OF A. PLAZ: Pirates No. 28 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Axiel Plaz** is off to a hot start in 2025. Through the first week of the season, he leads Bradenton - and is tied for the Florida State League lead - in hits (10) and and leads with 9 RBI, all of which have come in the first three games of this series. This season he is slashing .417/.500/.500. Yesterday, he finished 2-for-4 and drove in five runs, the most by a Marauders hitter in a single game this season.

TEJADA TOES THE RUBBER: After making his first start of the season on Opening Night last Friday in Daytona, RHP **Clevari Tejada** will take the ball for Bradenton tonight. In his first outing, he tossed 4 innings while allowing one earned run (2 R) on two hits and two strikeouts. In 11 home games last year betwen the FCL and Bradenton, he posted a 4.95 ERA over 11 apperances and four starts. In total he posted a 4.48 ERA over 68.1 innings.

TEENAGE TITAN: MLB.com's No. 42 prospect and 2024 first-round pick **Konnor Griffin** has registered elite-level exit velocities early on in his first pro season. Of his first four hits this year, the first three left the bat at 104 mph, 111 mph and 114.2 mph respectively. The latter is the highest recorded by a Single-A player this season and would place 17th in all of MLB. The only players to hit a ball harder at the big-league level this season include: **Riley Greene, Pete Alonso, Oneil Cruz, Aaron Judge, Ketel Marte, Ryan Mountcastle, Corbin Carroll,** and **Kyle Schwarber** among others.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Bradenton Marauders begin their home season this week with a six-game series versus the Palm Beach Cardinals. This matchup marks the first between these two for a home opener at LECOM Park in franchise history. In 2024, the Marauders finished 33-33 while playing in the Friendly City. Bradenton hasn't had a losing season at home since 2018 when they finished 28-41. Since 2019, they're 181-141 in the regular season at LECOM Park.

SCOUTING THE REIGNING CHAMPS: The Palm Beach Cardinals come to town fresh off their second FSL Championship in franchise history and first since 2005 (also made it in 2017, but series wasn't played due to Hurricane Irma), beating the Lakeland Flying Tigers in three games. Their 2025 roster features 18 returning players from last year's club and six members of the Cardinals' 2024 draft class. Last weekend, they took two of three games from the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels at home. Cade McGee was named FSL Player of the Week after going 4-for-11 with 2 HR, including a walk-off blast on Sunday afternoon's 11-10 victory.

TOP PROSPECTS & SPRING BREAKOUT: The 2025 roster features six of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline: Konnor Griffin (No. 2), Zander Mueth (No. 10), Jhonny Severino (No. 12), Yordany De Los Santos (No. 16), Tony Blanco Jr. [IL] (No. 21), and Axiel Plaz (No. 28). All six players played for the Pirates Spring Breakout Team on 3/14 in a 3-5 loss to the Philadelphia Phillies Prospects.

IT ALL BEGINS IN BRADENTON: Seven former Marauders were named to the Pirates Opening Day Roster (excluding rehab assignments), including four in the season's first starting lineup: Oneil Cruz (2019), Adam Frazier (2014), Ke'Bryan Hayes (2017), Jared Jones (IL - 2021), Mitch Keller (2016-18), Endy Rodriguez (2021), and Paul Skenes (2023). Thomas Harrington (2023) also made his Major League debut on 4/1 vs Tampa Bay, and INF Tsung-Che Cheng (2022) was called up on 4/7 making them the IO7th and 108th former Marauders to appear in the big leagues.
