LAST GAME

The Baysox took down the Erie SeaWolves 10-8 on Thursday night in 10 innings for their third-consecutive win for only the second time this season. For the second consecutive game, Bowie chased the Erie starter in the first inning, as back-to-back home runs from Joseph Rosa and Coby Mayo to lead off the game gave the Baysox an early 2-0 lead, with SeaWolves starter Ty Madden only recording two outs on 29 pitches before being lifted. Erie would quickly tie the game on a two-run shot by Andrew Navigato in the bottom of the first, before Anthony Servideo plated a run on a fielders choice and Cesar Prieto notched an RBI single to restore Bowie's two-run cushion. The SeaWolves would get to Baysox starter Justin Armbruster, scoring a run in the fourth and three in the fifth, before notching two more across on right-hander Connor Gillispie to take an 8-4 lead. The Baysox launched a two-run home run in each of the last two frames to tie the game. Rosa smacked his second long ball of the night in the eighth, before Rhodes tied it with his blast in the ninth. Bowie loaded the bases in the top of the tenth, before Prieto drove in two with his fourth hit of the evening to give the Baysox a 10-8 lead, as right-hander Wandisson Charles kept Erie off the board in the final two frames for Bowie's second extra-inning win in 2023.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with a record of 29-25 - tied with the Altoona Curve atop the Eastern League Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, Erie has not lost any of its last five series - a stretch that began by taking four of six from Bowie at Prince George's Stadium in early May. The SeaWolves have outscored opponents 229-144 in that span, after entering May holding the worst run differential in the league at -51. No. 2 Tigers/No. 84 overall prospect (via MLB Pipeline) Colt Keith leads a SeaWolves offense that collectively paces the league in OPS (.774) and slugging (.421). Keith ranks second in the league in average (.325) and hits (66), while sitting third in OPS (.965) and extra-base hits (27) and was named the Eastern League's Player of the Month for May on Monday. Keith joins RHPs Wilmer Flores (No. 4 DET), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), and Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), alongside LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET), as well as INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 28 DET) as other notable prospects on the Erie roster.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Sawyer Gipson-Long is tonight's projected starter for Erie. Gipson-Long has had impressive control on the strike zone in 2023, with 50 strikeouts compared to just 10 walks across 44.1 innings. He does, however, have the tendency to give up the home run ball, with seven of them on the season - most on the SeaWolves staff. Gipson-Long is coming off his best start of the season, as he fired six two-hit, shutout frames this past Saturday against Richmond, totaling eight strikeouts and walking just a single batter. The right-hander has not allowed more than two earned runs in any of his past five starts. Gipson-Long faced the Baysox in Bowie back on 5/5, picking up the win after five innings of one-run baseball on five hits, with two strikeouts and one walk. His lone run surrendered was a solo home run to Heston Kjerstad. Gipson-Long also featured in a start against Bowie on 8/30 of last season, where he allowed five runs (three earned) through six frames. Gipson-Long was acquired by Detroit in August of 2022 from the Minnesota Twins organization in exchange for RHP Michael Fulmer. He began 2022 at High-A Cedar Rapids, where he was teammates with tonight's Baysox starter, Cade Povich. Originally a sixth-round pick of the Twins out of Mercer, Gipson-Long features a fastball, slider, changeup, and a recently developed cutter, which he featured in last week's start for the first time.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 19 doubles and is second with 28 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles/ No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, hit his eighth home run of the season last night, giving him an extra-base hit in nine of his last 12 games, to go along with seven walks in his last six contests. Mayo leads the Baysox with 32 walks and a .927 OPS. He is in the midst of a 23-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 25 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29) and the third-longest such streak in the Eastern League.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 74 hits and a .374 average. Prieto has been on fire this week. The No. 16 Orioles' prospect tallied his second four-hit game of the season last night, and is now 10-for-14 on the week with 8 RBI. Last night's two-run, go-ahead single in the tenth inning gave Prieto the team lead in RBI with 27 on the season. He has at least three-hits in all three games this week and nine contests on the season with at least three knocks through his first 50 games. Overall, Prieto has feasted on Erie pitching in 2023, batting .514 (19-for-37) against the SeaWolves with four doubles, a home run, and six multi-hit performances. In addition, Prieto sits third in the Eastern League with his .423 on-base percentage.

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

After starting 4-10 away from home this season, the Baysox have won seven of their last nine road contests. After taking four of six from the RubberDucks in Akron, Bowie has won the first three of six games in Erie this week. The Baysox have had strong pitching outside of Prince George's Stadium more often than not this season, with their 3.42 road ERA as a staff leading all of Double-A. However, lately, it's been the bats coming to life. Bowie is averaging exactly six runs per game during this nine-game stretch away from home, including five performances of seven runs or more. In the 11 road games prior, Bowie averaged just 3.09 runs per game, losing nine of those contests.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. Eastern League Pitcher of the Week
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- 5/11 Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. Eastern League Pitcher of the Week
- 5/17 Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
- 5/23 After Bowie had taken a 2-0 lead in the second, allowed a walk and game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the frame. Only allowed two baserunners over final three innings.
- 5/28 Faced the minimum over the first two innings thanks to a double play. Allowed three doubles. First five batters reached safely in the fifth inning.
- 6/3 Gave up a single and home run to the first two batters. Needed 71 pitches for just the first three innings. Allowed a second two-run home run in the fourth. Career high in hits allowed
