#### GAME RECAP

The Reading Fightin Phils took an early lead in Thursday's game but couldn't hold it in the end. The R-Phils put up a fight but lost 7-5 to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (Blue Jays). Reading snapped it's scoreless innings streak pitched after 20 innings. Wendell Rijo, Johan Camargo and Jhailyn Ortiz all tallied two hits. Noah Skirrow drew the start on the mound. The righty gave up three runs on nine hits through 5.1 innings and finished with five strikeouts. Tyler McKay relieved Skirrow with one out in the sixth inning. He went 1.2 innings and gave up three runs on four hits. The righty picked up the loss in Thursday's contest.

#### CAMARGO COMING:

Johan Camargo started an MLB rehab assignment in Reading on Tuesday. In his first game with the R-Phils, he contributed two hits, two runs and two RBIs while batting third and starting at third base. He was the designated hitter in Wednesday's contest but found himself back at the hot corner on Thursday. He had two hits, a run scored and an RBI in last night's loss. The Phillies placed the infielder on the 10-day injured list with a right knee strain on June 29. This is Camargo's second time on the injured list in 2022. He landed on the 10-day injured list on June 7 with a right knee strain and rehabbed in Triple-A (Lehigh Valley). Camargo worked his way back to the Phillies and was activated on June 21 but reinjured his right knee. In 2022, his first season with the Phillies, Camargo has 32 hits through 47 games at the highest level. The Phillies signed Camargo as a free agent on Dec. 1, 2021.

#### SHUTOUT STYLE:

Reading's pitching staff combined for two shutout victories over New Hampshire to open the series and 20-straight scoreless innings. Through the games on Tuesday and Wednesday, nine Fightins pitchers combined for 18 scoreless frames and 23 strikeouts. Prior to the most recent streak, Reading's staff hurled 13 scoreless innings at New Hampshire on April 29-30. The streak ended at 20 innings on Thursday. In Tuesday's game, Ethan Lindow drew the start and picked up the win. He held the Fisher Cats to five hits and finished with five strikeouts over six innings. Trevor Bettencourt, Francisco Morales and McKinley Moore all pitched a frame in relief. Mike Adams made the first start of his professional career on Wednesday. He pitched two innings and struck out one. Erik Miller came in for the third inning, his first appearance since coming off the developmental list. Billy Sullivan, Matt Seelinger (who picked up the win) and Braden Zarbnisky each pitched two scoreless innings in relief.

#### THE FUTURE:

Catcher Logan O'Hoppe and left-handed pitcher Erik Miller leave today for the 2022 Futures Game, which is being held at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles on Saturday, July 16 at 7 PM ET. O'Hoppe, the Phillies' No. 3 prospect, leads the Fightins with a .283 batting average, 46 runs scored, 40 RBI and 14 home runs. Not only is O'Hoppe the leader in the batting order, where he's batted cleanup a team-high 50 times, he's also the team's anchor behind the plate. O'Hoppe has made 49 starts at catcher and throws runners out at about a 21% clip. The Phillies drafted O'Hoppe in the 23rd round of the 2018 MLB Draft. Miller is the Phillies' No. 10 prospect and he was selected by the team in the fourth round of the 2019 draft. The lefty spent a month on the development list but not before a strong start to the season. Miller made 15 appearances, including seven starts, and posted a 1.45 ERA. Through 25.2 innings, he has 34 strikeouts and holds opposing batters to a .174 average.

#### **RIJO RAKES:**

Wendell Rijo stayed hot at the plate on Thursday. He had his second-straight multi-hit game on Thursday as he connected for two hits, a run scored and an RBI while adding a stolen base. On Wednesday, Rijo hit two three-run home runs against New Hampshire, his second two homer game in the last week. Last week at Richmond, Rijo hit two solo shots in a 5-3 win. The infielder is up to eight home runs in 2022. He's batting .275 with a .357 on-base percentage, 44 hits, 29 RBI and 28 runs this season with the Fightins. In the last 10 contests, Rijo leads the team with a .424 batting average, a .545 on-base percentage, 14 hits, 13 RBI and 10 walks. He's also shown off his speed on the base paths with three stolen bases. Rijo made starts at third and second base during the season, making crisp plays on both sides of the infield.

**July 15, 2013:** At Reading, Alex Rodriguez makes a start for Trenton as he continues to prepare for a comeback after his MLB drug suspension. Greeted with a mixed chorus of cheers and boos each time he steps up to the plate, Rodriguez goes 2-for-4 and hits a 2-run homer off Austin Wright in the 5th inning of the Thunder's 6-5 win. Cesar Hernandez, a Triple-A All-Star infielder for Lehigh Valley, plays center field for the Fightin Phils and goes 2-for-4 with an RBI.
