NOTES AND NUGGETS

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- This season, 48 of Omaha's 64 games (76%) have been decided by 4 runs or less, including a recent stretch of 21 straight games.
- Yesterday's 5-run margin of victory of Toledo was Omaha's first game decided by more than 5 runs since a 8-2 loss to the Columbus Clippers on May 17.
 - Across a 21-game stretch from May 18 to June 10, Omaha went 7-14, where every game had a scoring margin of 4 runs or less ... 16 of those 21 games had a save recorded, including 5 of Omaha's 7 wins ... over the Chasers' recent 13-game, 2-week homestand, 11 games featured a save, including the first 10, between May 27 and June 6.
 - While the games of recent have been close, only 27 of Omaha's first 42 games (64%) were decided by a margin of 4 runs or less.
 - 1-run games have especially been difficult for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers just 3-9 in games decided by a run ... 3 wins by 1 run is the fewest of any International League team, while 12 total 1-run games is tied for the 2nd-fewest.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

- While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.
- Omaha has successfully stolen 102 bases this year, and only been caught 16 times ... 102 steals rank 4th both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
 - 102-for-118 in steal attempts is a 86.4% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 4th-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: San Jose Giants, 89.1%, 106-for-119).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

- The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits at the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 619 strikeouts this season ... that is the most of any team in the league or at the Triple-A level.
- Over 553.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.06 K/9, which ranks tied 2nd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
 - With 619 strikeouts through 64 games, an average of 9.67 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,441 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

- The Omaha Storm Chasers lead the International League lead in both sacrifices (14) and sacrifice flies (28) as well.
- The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts in 2024, with 38 last year ... the 14 sacrifice bunt this year are the most in the league, 3rd at the Triple-A level, and tied 14th in the Minors ... **Tyler Tolbert**, **Harold Castro** and **John Rave** each have 3 sacrifice bunts, tied for the 4th-most in the league.
 - 28 sac flies are the most of any Triple-A club and the 4th-most in Minor League Baseball ... **Tyler Gentry's** 6 sacrifice flies lead the IL and are tied for the most at the Triple-A level, one off the Minor League lead.

LET'S OBSERVE MERV

- After a slow start at the plate in his return to Triple-A, outfielder MJ Melendez has been one of Omaha's best hitters over the last month.
- While he went 0-for-3 yesterday, Melendez has hits in 19 of his last 24 games, with a .304 average (28-for-92) with a .883 OPS since May 16 ... he has 6 homers and 18 RBI in this stretch, with 7 multi-hit games.
 - Since May 16, Melendez is tied 2nd in the International League in homers (6) and tied 4th in total bases (49) ... he is 2nd in steals (11) in that stretch as well.
 - Over his first 19 games with the Storm Chasers, Melendez hit just .156 (12-for-77) with a .468 OPS, between April 22 and May 14 ... he had hits in 10 of 19 games in that stretch.
 - Underrated in MJ's time with Omaha has been the exit velocities he's produced ... an average exit velocity of 94.1MPH ranks 2nd among 337 Triple-A hitters with at least 100 plate appearances this season ... Worcester's Roman Anthony (recently promoted to the Major Leagues) hits the ball hardest on average, at 95.0MPH.

WHAT A RELIEF

- Omaha's bullpen has produced 14 scoreless games this season, most recently last night's 3.0 scoreless frames from the relievers.
- 7 of 14 times the Storm Chasers' relievers have not allowed a run, it's been a stretch of 4.0 innings or more of scoreless relief ... last night
 - Going back to Sunday, Omaha's bullpen has combined to allow just 4 earned runs in 17.2 innings of work, a 2.04 ERA, 0.79 WHIP and .175 opponents' average.
 - 3 members of Omaha's bullpen have not yet allowed a run in June ... RHP **Ryan Hendrix** (4.0 IP), RHP **Andrew Hoffmann** (2.0 IP) and LHP **Evan Sisk** (1.0 IP).

TODAY'S START

- Hatch is making his **11th start with Omaha** this season ... made Omaha's 2025 Breaking Roster, after signing a Minor League deal with the Royals in February ... spent 2024 in Japan with the Hiroshima Toyo Carp.
- In his 2nd stint with the Storm Chasers this season ... went up to the Majors June 5, did not appear in the game.
- Playing his 9th professional season this year ... Royals are Hatch's 4th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Cubs, Blue Jays, Pirates and in Japan ... has appeared in 39 Major League games from 2020 to 2023.
- Hatch was a starting pitcher in Japan last season ... he began his professional career as a starter, his first 80 games were starts, from 2017 into 2020 ... from his MLB debut on July 26, 2020 through 2023, just 44 of his 112 appearances were starts, with 33 total relief appearances in his 39 MLB games.
- Goes by his middle name, Thomas, to honor his grandfather whom he was named after.

Threw his 3rd quality start of the year, to tie **Luinder Avila** for the team lead ... but only got 1 run of support and a no-decision ... the 2nd Omaha pitcher this year to throw 7.0 innings (also: Avila, 5/10 @ LOU) ... worked around doubles in the 1st and 3rd innings, with 1-2-3 innings in the 2nd, 4th, 5th and 7th ... retired 10 straight from the 3rd into the 6th inning ... did not come out for the 8th inning, where Matt Walner hit a 3-run homer for the Saints.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- In his Omaha debut on April 3 vs. Louisville, allowed 1 run on 2 hits over 5.0 innings, with 6 strikeouts.
- Has allowed 2 runs between the 1st and 2nd innings this year (16.0 IP) ... 20 of 22 runs allowed have come between the 3rd and 6th innings (22.2 IP).
- Had his contract selected by Kansas City prior to the Royals' doubleheader on June 5 ... did not appear in the 1st game @ St. Louis, was designated for assignment prior to Game 2, to open a 26-man roster spot for **Cole Ragans** to start Game 2 of the doubleheader ... cleared waivers and sent outright to Omaha on June 8.

 - Appeared in 5 games in Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB = Japan's MLB equivalent) ... also pitched 15 games for Hiroshima's Western League affiliate (one of the two minor leagues in Japan).
 - Totaled 94.1 innings in 20 games between the two levels in Japan, going 5-7 with a 3.53 ERA (37 ER in 94.1 IP).
 - 2023**
 - Split his year between the Blue Jays and Pirates organizations, appearing in 18 Major League games and 31 Minor League games, between 4 different clubs, for 49 total outings (5 starts) ... had 5 separate MLB stints (May 16-23, June 11-16, July 1-7, August 2-4 with Toronto and August 8-September 19 with Pittsburgh).
 - Designated for assignment by Toronto on August 4, claimed off waivers by Pittsburgh on August 8 ... largely pitched in the Minors with the Blue Jays, but almost exclusively pitched in the big leagues with the Pirates.
 - Released by the Pirates in November 30 signed with the Hiroshima Toyo Carp to play the 2024 season in Japan.

 - Spent nearly the entire season in the Minors, pitched in 28 games (22 starts) for the Buffalo Bisons (AAA) ... went 8-7 with a 4.67 ERA (68 ER in 131.0 IP) and 113 strikeouts ... 10th in the International League in strikeouts.

 - Spent much of the year in the Minor Leagues with the Buffalo Bisons (AAA), pitching in 15 games (14 starts) with a 2-6 record and 4.04 ERA (29 ER in 64.2 IP) and 70 strikeouts to 19 walks (3.68 K/BB).

 - Added to Toronto's 40-man roster in the offseason, made the Blue Jays' Opening Day roster and spent the entire 60-game season in the Major Leagues ... named Toronto's Rookie of the Year by *Baseball America*.

 - Made his postseason debut with a 1-2-3 8th inning in Game 1 of the AL Wild Card Series on September 29 at Tampa Bay ... playoff debut was his 26th birthday, the 2nd player in team history to pitch in the playoffs on his birthday.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
