LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn closed out their series against Jersey Shore with an 8-1 win on Monday night...Cyclones scored 4 in the 3rd on a 3-run 3B **William Lugo** triple and a sacrifice fly from RF **Stanley Consuegra**...Brooklyn added 3 more in the 4th on a CF **Alex Ramírez** double and a 2-run three-bagger from DH **Kevin Parada**...Ramírez and Parada each tallied a pair of knocks...Ramírez scored 3 runs and reached base 4 times, while Parada was aboard on 3 occasions...RHP **Cameron Foster** tossed 5.0 innings of shutout ball, earning his 3rd win of the season...RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (2.0 IP), RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** (1.0), and RHP **Manny Rodríguez** (1.0) finished off the 4-hitter out of the bullpen.

PITCHING IN: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has posted an MLB-low 2.71 ERA (112 ER in 372.0 IP) over their last 43 games, holding a 23-20 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (2.79) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 5 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.3% and a walk rate of 11.5%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted the fewest home runs (12) and have accrued the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.75) and 4th lowest opposing OPS (.598) in that time period...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.34) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.43) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERAs in MLB during that time (min. 40.0 IP).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.19) in the entire South Atlantic League, and 3rd lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East leads (3.13) in MLB, while Hudson Valley (3.50) is 2nd in the circuit...RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.10) is 1st and RHP **Wilkin Ramos** (1.54) is 6th in ERA among SAL relievers (min. 30.0 IP).

CAPTAIN KEVIN: C **Kevin Parada** has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .309/.371/.593 with a .963 OPS and 158 wRC+ in 21 games...Parada has accrued 11 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 17 RBI, 7 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...The Pasadena, Calif. native had a 10-game hitting streak (15-for-39; .385/.429/.821) and a 15-game on-base streak (.333/.397/.632) snapped on Saturday...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Tuesday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (16), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (28), 7th in total bases (115), and tied for 7th in hits (67).

AL-WAYS ON: OF **Alex Ramírez** is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in walks (19) and runs scored (19) and 4th in pitches-per-plate appearance (4.248) asince the beginning of June...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Tuesday, the Dominican native is 4th in franchise history in RBI (67) and is 24 behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark and 1 behind IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** (68) for 3rd...He is also 3rd in doubles (28), tied for 4th in hits (123) and tied for 5th in total bases (183).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** finished the 2-week homestand on a tear for the 'Clones offensively...Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .333/.419/.815 with a 1.234 OPS and 220 wRC+ over his last 8 games...Lugo is 9-for-27 at the plate (.333) with 2 doubles, a triple, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 3 walks, and a hit-by-pitch in that span...The Dominican native has raised his season batting average 22 points (.181 to .203) during that time.

O SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has pummeled the ball since returning from the injured list on prior to the Jersey Shore series...The 22-year-old has picked up a base hit in 4-of-5 games played...3 of his 4 hits have gone for extra bases...Consuegra is 4-for-17 at the dish (.235), but has scored twice, collected a double, homered 2 times, and garnered 5 RBI...Since his return on June 29, the right-handed slugger holds an .897 OPS and a .114 wRC+ with an ISO of .412.

MARATHON MEN: Brooklyn is in the midst of their longest stretch without an off day for the 2023 season...The Cyclones will play 12 games in 12 days from Wednesday, June 28, until Sunday, July 9...Brooklyn completes their 2-week homestand with a 6-game series at Maimonides Park vs. Jersey Shore until Monday, July 3...The 'Clones will then travel south to Wilmington for a 6-game set at Frawley Stadium against the Blue Rocks starting on Tuesday, July 4...So far, Brooklyn is 3-3 during the stretch...Following the 12 games in 12 days, Brooklyn will have a 4-day break for the Major League All-Star Game before returning to Coney Island on Friday, July 14, to open up a brief 3-game home series vs. Greensboro.

LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN: On Thursday and Friday, RHP **Tyler Stuart** and RHP **Blade Tidwell** became the first pair of Cyclones starters to toss 7.0-plus innings in consecutive games during the 2022 season...It was the first time Brooklyn had their starting pitcher toss 7.0-full frames in consecutive contests since three arms did it in three-straight days in 2022...RHP **Luis Moreno** (September 7), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (September 8), and RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (September 9) all went 7.0 frames in the final series of the regular season at Winston-Salem.

BEND, BUT NO TE-BRAKE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 12 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.23 ERA (3 ER in 22.0 IP) on 10 hits and 10 walks, registering 34 strikeouts (13.91 K/9)...That equates to a 39.5 K% (34/86) and 11.6 BB% (10/86)...Since moving to a relief role, Tebrake is 2nd among SAL relievers (min. 18.0 IP) in opposing OPS (.391), tied for 2nd in strikeouts (34), 4th in hits-per-9 innings (4.09), WHIP (0.91), ERA (1.23), and strikeouts-per-9 innings (13.91).

TURNING THE TID-E: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed 3-straight quality starts dating back to June 17 at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in all 3 outings, permitting just 2 run on 10 hits over 20.0 innings...He has walked only 4 (5.6 BB%) and struck out 26 (36.6 K%) in those contests...He

vs. WILMINGTON: After a 2-week homestand, the Cyclones open up a 6-game road trip against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS **Brady House** (3), LHP **Jake Bennett** (8), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (10), OF **T.J. White** (12), and RHP **Andry Lara** (15)...C **Israel Pineda** (19) and 2B **Darren Baker** (28) are on rehab assignments...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Frawley Stadium since May 9-14...Wilmington captured 5-of-7 games...In 2023, the Cyclones are 4-8 against the Blue Rocks through 2 series...Dating back to 2021, the 'Clones are 30-32 (.484) all-time against the 'Rocks.

whiffed a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 on Friday vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 8 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 5-0 with a 1.34 ERA (6 ER in 40.1 IP) with just 20 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 59 (36.6 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .146 batting average (20-137) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.146) and is 2nd in strikeouts (59) and ERA (1.34) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is tied for 4th in wins (5) and tied for 5th in strikeouts (86).

STU-PENDOUS: RHP **Tyler Stuart** tossed 7.0 more innings of 1-run ball on Thursday, earning his 3rd win...He set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), in his previous start on June 22 vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old was the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart was also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP **Conner Grey** tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum was the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP **Kevin Canelon** whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.42)...Triple-A Durham's LHP **Jacob Lopez** (1.90) is 2nd in the minors...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (89.1%), is 3rd in FIP (3.05) and WHIP (1.06), 4th in xFIP (3.42) and batting average against (.206), 5th in innings pitched (69.2), 8th in strikeouts (79) and strikeout rate (28.4%), and 10th in walk rate (7.9%).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 6-straight scoreless outings since that date (11.0 IP)...Gervase averages 13.78 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.7% strikeout rate.

FINISHING STRONG: After suffering a walk-off defeat in 3-of-4 games to start a road series in Aberdeen, Brooklyn closed out the month of June with a flourish...Starting with Saturday, June 17's win over the IronBirds, the Cyclones won 8-of-11 contests to finish the season's third month...In that time, the Cyclones had the South Atlantic League's lowest ERA (2.00) and batting average against (.165)...Brooklyn's 8-3 mark was tied for the 2nd-best record in the circuit in that time frame...Only Hickory (10-1) had a better win percentage.

OH MY, OMAR: OF **Omar De Los Santos** has added 29 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 99 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MLB...Only Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (105), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (103), and D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (100) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 58 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 3 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: RF **Omar De Los Santos** provided Brooklyn their 6th walk-off win of 2023, scoring on a wild pitch in June 25's victory vs. Hudson Valley...DH **Kevin Parada** delivered a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C **José Mena**'s added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** provided a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** garnered a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 6 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after June 16's loss at Aberdeen...20.3% (15-of-74) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 22.5% (9-of-40) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...35.1% (26-of-74) have been determined by just 1 run.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), and RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdy Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his 4th loss of 2023 last Wednesday vs. Jersey Shore...Permitted 6 runs (5 earned) over 6.0 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 3...Plunked 2 hitters and tossed a wild pitch...Tossed 90 pitches and 59 strikes (65.6%)...Relieved by RHP **Elieser Hernández** to start the top of the 7th with Brooklyn trailing, 6-2...BlueClaws went on to defeat the Cyclones, 8-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, *Baseball America* deemed Colón one of the Mets’ “14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30”

JEFE JEFFREY: Colón earned his first win in 2023 on June 1 at Jersey Shore...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem... That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season... Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA’S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)... He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
