SAN ANTONIO BRINGS OUT BATS IN WIN OVER RIDERS:

All nine Frisco RoughRiders hitters reached base for the second-straight game on Wednesday night, but the San Antonio Missions used two big innings to win 13-3 at Riders Field. San Antonio (7-10, 44-42) had scored just two runs in the previous two games but put five runs on the board in the second inning and seven runs in the eighth to pull away. Frisco (8-9, 39-46) scored one run in three separate innings and threatened several other times, but stranded nine runners in scoring position. **Justin Slaten** (2-2) allowed three earned runs in his first start of the season, recording three outs including one strikeout and took the loss. Raul Brito (3-0) held off Frisco over 1.1 hitless innings to collect the win. In both games this series, Frisco and San Antonio have put all nine hitters on base at least once. On Tuesday, Frisco never trailed in a 6-2 win. On Wednesday, San Antonio never fell behind. **Trevor Hauver** had two hits to lead the way for Frisco. **Chris Seise** and **Aaron Zavala** had the two extra-base hits for the Riders, doubling in back-to-back at-bats to score a run in the second inning. **Robby Ahlstrom** was the first reliever out of the Frisco bullpen. Making his Double-A debut, Ahlstrom retired the first batter he faced on one pitch via a flyout. He ended up allowing one earned run in two innings of work before **Reid Birlingmair** took over for just his second Double-A appearance. Birlingmair put away the first five batters he faced and allowed just one hit over two scoreless innings. Zavala and **Evan Carter** helped put RoughRiders on the board by drawing walks to open the bottom of the first inning. **Thomas Saggese**'s sacrifice fly tied the game at 1-1 and gave Saggese his team-leading 66th RBI, good for third in the Texas League. **Liam Hicks** led off the fourth inning with a single and scored on a wild pitch later in the inning while Zavala, Carter and **Luisangel Acuña** all drew free passes in the inning. San Antonio built up the lead in the eighth inning by putting the first nine batters, followed by a sac fly. Frisco then turned its second double play of the game to end the inning. The Riders now lead the league by turning two on 74 occasions this season.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.16 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and second in the league to Amarillo (6.17). Including Slaten, they have used 16 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 30 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.64 (90ER/106.0IP) while the bullpen has a 4.75 ERA (81ER/153.1IP). Over the 30 games, the Riders have the fifth-best offense in the league by OPS (.769) and have hit 29 home runs.

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 15 games, he has driven in 17 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .353/.385/.529/.914 with two homers and 13 RBIs in nine games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 22 games since his return, he has eight multi-hit games, batting .341 (29-for-85)/.424/.600/1.024 with three doubles, two triples, five home runs, 16 RBIs and 18 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 34 games, he is hitting .351/.435/.641/1.076 with nine home runs and 31 RBIs. The California native is currently fifth in the league in batting average (.308), third in RBIs (66), second in hits (102), fourth in doubles (20) and second in total bases (167).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .567 average (17-for-30) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.494 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .456 (26-for-57) on the initial offering while his 26 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 36 and is on pace for a career-best 60 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 110 bases in 132 attempts (83 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of four teams with at least seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .346/.414/.442/.856 in July. He is fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.308), third in hits (100), third in doubles (21), second in runs (60) and first in steals (36).

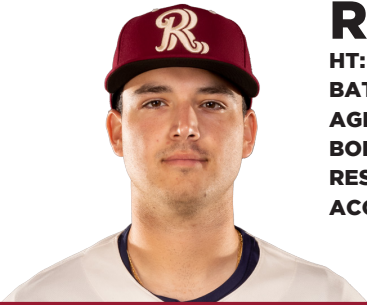

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
