TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve wrap up the series with the Harrisburg Senators, the Curve have played 15-of-39 games against the Senators already.

Jackson Kent fired 7 innings of 1-run ball on Tuesday and holds a 3.74 ERA in 4 previous starts against the Curve. Kent was Washington's 4th round pick in 2024 out of the University of Arizona and pitched twice against the Curve last August where they put 8 runs on him in 9.0 innings during the week. native of Hanover Park, Ill, Kent redshirted his freshman campaign in 2022 and broke out in a major way in 2024, earning All-Pac-12 honors. Kent majored in Leadership Learning Innovation with an emphasis in Community Educations and enjoys playing Golf and Fortnite in his free time.

EVERYBODY LOVES CURVE BASEBALL: Altoona picked up their first walk-off win of the season in their 38th game. Ivan Brethowr tripled home Omar Alfonzo in a 6-5 Curve win over Harrisburg.

WHAT WOOD WE DO WITHOUT HIM: Lefty Jaden Woods has set down 16 consecutive hitters over his last two outings. Woods has struck out 27 hitters this season, T-3rd most by an Eastern League reliever. Since his team debut on June 22, 2024, Woods has struck out 137 batters in 112.1 IP the most by a Double-A reliever.

DOMINATING DELGADO: Infielder Keiner Delgado has emerged as one of Altoona's most consistent hitters to begin the season. In his last 20 games, he's batting .314 with 6 2B, 2 HR, 15 RBI and a .435 OBP (.921 OPS). Since April 19 he ranks 6th in the EL in OBP (.435).

MOSS THE BOSS: Infielder Callan Moss holds a .367 on-base percentage during his 12-game on-base streak, stretching back to May 3.

PEN MEN: Stretching back from last Friday in Chesapeake to Wednesday in Altoona, Curve relievers tossed 19.0 consecutive scoreless innings. Matt Ager chipped in with 4.0 scoreless frames in his Double-A debut on Tuesday, May 12, piggy-backing on Jared Jones' rehab start.

Lately, righty Jared Bayless has become an important member of the staff. In 3 outings in May he has tossed 8.1 scoreless frames with only 1 hit and 1 walk and 9 K's, Bayless holds a 1.17 ERA in 7 games with Altoona this year, holding opponents to 0.59 WHIP. Lefty Cy Nielson is unscored upon in 11-of-12 outings this year and thrown 14.1 consecutive scoreless frames dating back to April 16. In that time he's allowed just 12 hits, 5 walks and struck out 16 across 9 outings. Closer Emmanuel Chapman has been unscored upon in the month of May, tossing 6.2 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts over 5 outings.

LET'S GET HEALTHY: 2023 Curve righty Jared Jones joined the Curve on Tuesday, May 12 and tossed 4.0 scoreless frames in his third major league rehab start. Jones, who is returning from an internal brace UCL repair, began a rehab assignment with Bradenton on Wednesday, April 29, has tossed 10.0 innings and allowed one run and struck out 11. Baltimore Orioles infielder Jackson Holliday went 1-for-8 against the Curve on rehab last week and outfielder Heston Kjerstad went 1-for-6 in two games. Tuesday was the 5th straight game for the Curve in which a major league rehab has played. Jones fired 4.0 scoreless frames on Tuesday, May 12 against Harrisburg and is slated to start Sunday's game for the Curve.

SLAMMING BABY: Altoona has an odd propensity for hitting solo homers early in the season. Entering Friday, the Curve have hit 38 homers, 23 of them have been solo. The 38 homers in 37 games for the Curve are T-5th-most in the Eastern League and have come from 13 different players, tied with Richmond for the most in the circuit.

CURT SCHILLING?: Right-hander Khristian Curtis matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts over 5.0 innings on Sunday, April 26. It was the 42nd time in franchise history that a Curve pitcher has punched out 10 hitters in a game and the first in 5.0 innings or fewer since Kyle Nicolas struck out 10 batters in 5.0 innings on May 2, 2023 at Richmond. Curtis is 1st among Eastern League hurlers with 44 strikeouts, 3rd among Double-A arms.

## CURVE CUTS

Jared Keith Jones... His father, Keith, was drafted by Arizona in 1997 and spent two seasons in their system as an infielder... Selected by the Pirates 13 picks after Carmen Mlodzinski in the 2020 MLB Draft and signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$2,200,000... Played outfield and pitched in high school and was viewed by scouts as one of the best athletes in the high school class of the 2020 draft... Was committed to play collegiately at the University of Texas... Added the curveball to his pitch mix during the COVID-19 shutdown in the spring and summer of 2020... In his final full high school season in 2019 was named the Whittier Daily News' Player of the Year after leading his team to the CIF-SS Division Semifinals with a 7-1 record and a 0.77 ERA, also hit .457 at the plate... Three times during his amateur career was a member of USA Baseball's Junior National Teams... Was Named the 2019 Perfect Game/Rawlings National High School Two-Way Player of the Year... Became close friends with MLB Pitcher/Outfielder Michael Lorenzen through La Mirada High School's Fellowship for Christian Athletes Program...

In 2023... Earned Altoona's Pitcher of the Year Award after holding his opponent to 2 runs or fewer in each of his 10 starts with the Curve to begin the season... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Struck out 6 in 4.2 in his Double-A Debut on April 8 vs. New Hampshire... Matched his career-high with 4 BB on 4/14 @ Erie... Placed on 7-day IL on 4/23 (retro 4/21) with lower back spasms, activated on 5/10 for 11 a.m. start vs. Akron... Struck out a season-high 7 batters in 4.0 innings on 5/16 at Bowie... Carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning on 6/8 @ RIC... Promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on June 15... Was named an MLB.com Organizational All-Star after ranking tied for first (with Thomas Harrington) among all Pirates minor leaguers in strikeouts, third in innings and tied for third in starts (ranked second among full-season pitchers in ERA)...

In 2025... Struck out at least seven batters in each of his first five starts from 3/30-4/22, becoming the fourth Major Leaguer to do that

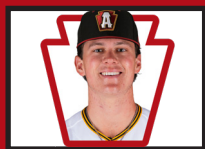
