#### JUMBO SHRIMP WIN FIRST GAME OF 2022

Bryson Brigman homered and Norel González doubled, tripled and drove in three to lead Jacksonville to an 8-4 victory over Worcester. Ryan Fitzgerald led off the game with a solo home run, but González doubled in a pair to put the Jumbo Shrimp up in the second. After a three-run Red Sox fifth, Jacksonville grabbed the lead right back with a Brian Miller RBI triple followed by Brigman's two-run homer. The Jumbo Shrimp scored three more times in the sixth inning to widen the gap to 8-4. Jacksonville's bullpen pitched 4.1 innings of one-hit ball in the effort.

#### 'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen struggled through the season's first two games, with the club's relievers combining to give up nine runs on 13 hits in 10.0 frames. However, in Thursday's 8-4 victory over Worcester, the club's bullpen was a significant catalyst for success. In 4.1 innings, Jeff Brigham, Grant Davton and Aneurys Zabala combined to vield just one hit without walking a batter. The trio struck out nine and retired the final 12 Red Sox to come to the plate in sealing the victory.

#### POWFR UP?

Though Jacksonville have lost each of the season's first two games, the Jumbo Shrimp have popped four home runs thus far, tied for the most in the International League and representing one of the club's more encouraging signs. No Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. The last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its league in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

The Jumbo Shrimp finished 2021 with a strong 75-55 (.577) record, something the club accomplished despite a whopping 287 roster moves. Jacksonville used a remarkable 77 different players in 2021, shattering the previous club record of 65 set in 2018. Of those 77 players, 38 were pitchers, which tied a club record. The Jumbo Shrimp had 21 different pitchers start a game in 2021, again marking a franchise record.

DON'T CRY... SMILE BECAUSE IT HAPPENED Jacksonville finished the 2021 season, which marked the club's return to Triple-A for the first time since 1962-68, with a 75-55 (.577) record - the club's best mark since an 81-59 (.579) tally in 2014. The 2021 campaign represented Jacksonville's first winning record since that 2014 season, and the Jumbo Shrimp won with plenty of dramatics; Twenty-one of Jacksonville's 75 victories came in the club's last at-bat. Those close victories have helped the Jumbo Shrimp go a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the second-best record in the league in contests determined by those slim margins.

#### ROAD WAS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp boasted a 39-26 (.600) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark in 2021, ranking the club in a tie for fourth for the most road victories in Triple-A. Jacksonville's .600 winning percentage away from the First Coast equaled both the 2006 and 2014 Jacksonville Suns who each posted 42-28 (.600) away records, for the best road winning percentage for any Jacksonville team since at least 2005. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked 28th in Triple-A in runs scored at home, mustering just 256 (3.9 per game) of their 577 tallies (44.4 percent) at 121 Financial Ballpark. The club's .672 home OPS ranked dead last in the level. Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville placed 14th in

The 54-year-old piloted Triple-A Tacoma in Seattle's organization from 2007- 13 and again in 2019, tallying 494 victories, which marks the most wins of any manager in Rainiers franchise history. Overall in his MiLB career, Brown holds a 1,260-1,258 (.501) record as a minor league manager, needing just 40 victories to reach 1,300 for his career. Brown led Tacoma to consecutive division titles in 2009 and 2010, and during that latter season, helped the Rainiers win the franchise's first outright Pacific Coast League Championship since 1969. -Selected by the Marlins in the 20th round of the 2017 draft, Holloway opted to sign with Miami for a reported \$400,000 to forgo a commitment to play college baseball at the University of Nebraska Omaha.

-Holloway underwent Tommy John Surgery in June of 2017. During his rehabilitation, he lived with fellow Marlins prospect Braxton Garrett, who had the procedure done during the same month.

-Marlins prospect Matt Givin, who also required Tommy John Surgery after suffering a torn UCL, credits Holloway for taking him "under his wing" during the recovery process.

#### 2022 SEASON

#### 2021 SEASON

-Holloway began the season in the Marlins' bullpen but transitioned into a starting role on May 10 at Arizona. In that game, his first major league start, he ceded four runs, three earned, on five hits in 3.2 innings to suffer the loss. He started again five days later at the Dodgers, and yielded two runs on three hits in 3.0 innings, again being charged with the loss. All told, Holloway's numbers as a starter with Miami are 0-2 with a 10.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 14 H, 16 R, 14 ER, 16 BB, 12 K).

-As a reliever in the majors, Holloway did not allow a run in any of his six appearances, surrendering only four hits and three walks against 11 strikeouts in 11.0 frames. Opponents were batting just .108 against him. In nine overall appearances, he is 2-1 with a 0.75 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 10 BB, 24 K).

#### **2020 SEASON**

-Holloway made his major league debut on July 26, 2020 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia when the Marlins played at the Phillies. He pitched just one-third of an inning, but was not charged with a run despite allowing two hits and one walk.

#### **2019 SEASON**

-In 10 starts before the All-Star Break, Holloway went 2-3 with a 2.62 ERA. He yielded just 25 hits in 44.2 innings, striking out 51 against 30 walks. However, in 11 starts after the All-Star Break, Holloway was just 2-8 with a 6.08 ERA. He surrendered 52 hits in 50.1 innings, fanning just 42 against 36 walks.

-Holloway held right-handed hitters to a .630 OPS in 218 plate appearances. Lefties posted a .705 mark against him in 204 plate appearances.

#### 2018 SEASON

-Holloway's first outing since undergoing Tommy John Surgery in June of 2017 came on June 21, 2018, when pitching for the GCL Marlins against the GCL Astros. He went two-thirds of an inning, but then did not appear in a game until August 17.

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-As a senior at Ralston Valley High School (Colo.), Holloway went 6-1 with a 2.60 ERA and 50 strikeouts in 43.0 innings to earn a spot on the *Denver Post* All-Colorado team..
