THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge continue a 12-game road trip today in the Natural State. Wichita dropped five of six in Springfield, dropping the series. The current series in Springfield the two teams split the four games.

THE HIT PARADE - Wichita has recorded double-digit hits in ten of its last 18 games and 24 times this season. The team is batting a league leading .279 in its last 19 games (181x648) with the second most runs 111 and tied for third in league with 25 home runs.

THE LONG BALL - The Wind Surge second in lead the league with 145 Home Runs. The Surge have six players with double digit homers. Wichita led the league last season with 171 home runs for the season.

VS NATS- The Wind Surge and Naturals meet for the final series of the season, NWA leads the season series 11-8. Wichita won the 2025 season series taking ten of the 18 games. The all time series is even between the two teams, 63 - 63.

RAIN - Last night was the first rain shortened game of the season and included the 10th rain delay of the season and first in the second half.

ON THE BUMP: Chris Vallimont will make his 11th start of the season this year for the Wind Surge. In his last start he pitched four innings allowed 4 runs on six hits in a no decision at the Naturals. Had an outstanding July, making six starts, 1-2 with a 3.16 ERA and 23 strikeouts in 25 innings. He combined with two other pitchers to deliver the first no-hitter of the season in The Texas League on July 25. In July he was 1-2 with a 3.16 ERA.

SURGE FALL IN SHORTENED CONTEST - The Wichita Wind Surge (15-22) fell 6-3 to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (15-22) in game four of a six-game series Friday night at Arvest Ballpark despite a strong outing from Riley Quick and a three-run home run by Jake Rucker. The game was shortened after a eighth inning rain delay. The Wind Surge held the lead for just half an inning after Rucker's three-run homer in the second before a fielding error and a throwing error helped Northwest Arkansas score four runs in the bottom half of the inning. Rucker paced the Wichita offense, as his three-run homer tied his season high with three RBIs and extended his on-base streak to 11 games. Marek Houston doubled to extend his on-base streak to 30 games, while Khadim Diaw's 17-game hitting streak came to an end, one game shy of the franchise record. On the mound, Quick turned in the best start of his Double-A career, allowing two earned runs over a career-high four innings. William Fleming and Kyle Bischoff each added scoreless relief appearances in the loss.

RUNNING WILD - Wichita stole a season-high eight bases on Thursday. The franchise record for stolen bases is nine, July 3, 2025 vs Tulsa.

HERE ME ROAR - Khadim Diaw hitting streak of 17 games ended last night, in the streak he batted .373 (25x67) with 12 runs scored, 2 home runs and 6 RBI. The 17 game hit streak is the longest of the season for Wichita and the Texas League. The longest Surge hit streak ever is Tanner Schobel in 2025 (18 games).

HOUSTON, WE HAVE LIFT OFF - Marek Houston has reached base in 30 consecutive games and his 12 game hit streak ended last Sunday. Since the start of the second half, he has the sixth best batting average in the league, 2nd in hits, 8th in RBI. He has recorded ten extra-base hits over his last 11 games.

LIGHT UP THE KENDLE- Caden Kendle had reached base in his first 20 games since coming to Class AA. The streak ended Friday night. He has the leagues best batting avg and OBP since July 1. Has driven in 15 runs through his first 21 games with Wichita and has recorded seven multi-hit games. Overall, Kendle has 29 hits in his first 74 AA at bats.

NOWLIN 99th GAME - Jaylen Nowlin recorded his 15th scoreless appearance on Sunday and pitched in his franchise best 99th career game.

RISPY BUSINESS - Wichita was 1 for 6 with runners in scoring position last night and 19 for 91 on the roadtrip.

ICT NOTES - Brandon Winokur extended his on-base streak to nine games and recorded his fifth multi-hit game of the season. Jake Rucker hit his sixth home run of the season, extended his on-base streak to 11 games and tied his season high with three RBIs..... 36 of the 40 wins the team have scored five or more runs. The Surge are 10-15 in one run games. Wichita is last in the league in batting average, 4th in walks, 1st HBP, and 9th in ERA, allowed most hits and SB's in all of AA. The team has 89 errors, 9th most in the league. Wichita has dropped 40 of its last 58 games, and is 25-54 since April 30th. The Surge have 40 wins, fewest in all of Class AA, only three teams have fewer in all of full season MILB.

STRIKE EM OUT! - The Wind Surge have recorded 43 double-digit strikeouts,.

KC TO THE SHOW - Kaelen Culpepper has been promoted to the Minnesota Twins, he becomes the 49th former Surge player to be promoted to MLB. He is the 9th this season and 9th from last years team. Culpepper's first MLB hit was a home run, joining Spencer Steer (Reds) 9/2/22, Matt Wallner (Twins) 9/17/22 as the only Wind Surge players to have accomplished that.

The contract of York Revolution right-hander Chris Vallimont has been purchased by the Minnesota Twins

Vallimont went 3-0 with a 3.99 ERA, the league's third lowest, in seven starts with York this season. He allowed just 34 hits in 38.1 innings and struck out 51 batters compared to just 11 walks. His 11.97 K/9 ranked third highest among qualified starters and his seven starts put him one shy of teammate Braden Scott for fastest in league history to 50 strikeouts in a season (since 2010).

The 29-year-old rejoins the Twins organization where he spent parts of three years early in his eight-year pro career. The Erie, PA native was originally a fifth-round draft pick of the Miami Marlins in 2018 out of Mercyhurst (PA) University and was a Midwest League Midseason All-Star with Clinton in 2019. He was dealt to Minnesota at the deadline that summer and spent most of his time at Double-A Wichita where he led the league in K/9 (12.86) and ranked second in total strikeouts (130) in 2021. Vallimont was added to the Twins' 40-man roster after the season and entered 2022 as Minnesota's #22 prospect before ultimately making his Major League debut with the Baltimore Orioles the following season.
