TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Christian Zazueta (0-0, 2.14 ERA)

- The 21-year-old was signed as an international free agent by the New York Yankees on January 17, 2022.
- Zazueta was traded to the Dodgers, along with Matt Gage, from the Yankees for Caleb Ferguson on February 5, 2024.
- He is the #6 ranked prospect in the Los Angeles Dodgers organization according to MLB Pipeline.
- In his professional career, Zazueta is 16-14 with a 3.90 ERA in 72 games (63 starts) while giving up 235 hits, 130 runs, 122 ERs, 35 HRs and 75 walks with 342 Ks in 281.1 IP.
- In 2025, Zazueta pitched for Rancho Cucamonga and Great Lakes. He was a combined 7-2 with a 2.41 ERA while giving up 53 hits, 19 runs, 18 earned runs, 7 home runs and 16 walks with 81 strikeouts in 66.1 IP.
- Zazueta was named the Branch Rickey Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Dodgers following the 2025 season.
- In his 11 games (10 starts) for Great Lakes in 2026, Zazueta was 2-2 with a 3.88 ERA while giving up 35 hits, 21 runs, 5 HRs and 12 walks with 66 Ks in 48.2 IP.
- In his six home games with Great Lakes, he was 2-1 with a 1.91 ERA and in five road games he was 0-1 with a 6.64 ERA.
- In his five starts for Tulsa, Zazueta is 0-0 with a 2.14 ERA while giving up 14 hits, 5 runs, 4 HRs and 2 walks with 34 Ks in 21.0 IP. He has struck out seven in four of his five starts. Four of his five runs allowed have scored on four solo home runs.
- In his four starts in July, Zazueta was 0-0 with a 2.81 ERA while giving up 13 hits, 5 runs, 4 home runs and 2 walks with 26 Ks in 16.0 IP.
- In his 16 games (15 starts) combined between Great Lakes and Tulsa, Zazueta is 2-2 with a 3.36 ERA while giving up 49 hits, 26 runs, 9 HRs and 14 BBs with 100 Ks in 69.2 IP.
- In his last start on July 25 against Arkansas, Zazueta pitched 4.0 innings and gave up 2 hits, 1 run, 1 HR and 1 walk with 7 Ks.
- With Tulsa, left-handed hitters are batting .071 with just 2 walks drawn and 16 Ks in 28 ABs. Right-handed hitters are batting .255 against Zazueta in 47 ABs.
- In his career, Zazueta is 6-7 with a 3.95 ERA in day games and is 10-7 with a 3.87 ERA in night games.
- In his career, Zazueta is 10-7 with a 3.62 ERA in home games and is 6-7 with a 4.23 ERA in road games.
- Leadoff hitters have earned 7 of the 14 hits and are batting .412 with 4 home runs and one walk against Zazueta

GAMEDAY NOTES

- The Drillers 65% winning percentage puts them on an historic pace as no Drillers team has ever won 60% of its games for an entire season, and it has been nearly 100 years since a Tulsa professional team has won at a better pace. One needs to go back to 1932 to find a better winning % for a Tulsa squad. The 1932 Tulsa Oilers, who played in the Class A Western League, finished with a 98-48 record and a .671 winning % and were the last Tulsa team to win at a higher %. The winningest Drillers team by total wins was the 2019 squad that finished with 78 victories (78-51). The Drillers team with the best winning % was the 1992 team. They finished with a 77-59 record and a .566 winning %.
- The Drillers have hit 15 home runs, the second most in Double A this week with 25 of their 40 runs scored coming from the long ball.
- The Drillers currently have the second-best full-season record among full-season Minor League teams. Bowling Green has the best record in Minor League Baseball at 71-28.
- In July, Tulsa finished 15-9 and had a team batting average of .287 and a 4.98 team ERA. Zahir Hope led the Drillers and had the best batting average in July among active players in the TL at .372 and led the league with 28 RBI and hit the most home runs with 10.
- Tulsa is batting .301, the highest against any opponent this season, and the pitching staff has a 4.30 ERA against NW Arkansas this season. Josue De Paula leads Tulsa players, batting .361 with 5 HRs and 15 RBI and pitchers Kelvin Ramirez and Carson Hobbs have not allowed a run in 17.1 combined innings pitched against the Naturals. The Drillers also lead the TL in runs scored (121), hits (163), doubles (38), home runs (35) and walks (84) against NWA. Tulsa pitchers have struck out the second most NWA hitters in the TL this season with 151.
- Over the past 37 games, Tulsa has a .262 team batting average, the fifth lowest in the TL, and has struck out 380 times, which is the second most in the TL during that span. Tulsa starting pitchers have a 6.12 ERA over the last 37 games, which is the second highest in Double A, and the relievers have a 3.40 ERA in that span, which is the lowest in Double A. Tulsa pitchers have also given up 45 home runs during that span with 37 coming in the last 26 games.
- The Drillers have recorded 351 of their 593 RBI this season and hit 70 of their 135 home runs while batting .270 against relievers compared to batting .266 against starters.
- Tulsa's 33 home wins are the most in the TL and the second most in Double A behind Richmond with 35. The 32 road wins are the most in Double A.
- Since the Drillers ended their season-long, five-game losing streak on May 16, they are 45-18 and lead the Double A in hitting at .278, hits (599), runs scored (422), home runs (97), walks drawn (321) and OPS (.852). Tulsa has also scored at least six runs in 39 of the last 63 games.
- Tulsa has 35 comeback victories this season with 19 coming at ONEOK Field and 16 on the road. The Drillers have scored 111 combined runs in the eighth and ninth innings, which are the second most in the TL. The Drillers largest comeback win was when they rallied from five runs down twice on April 22 at Frisco in game two of a DH and on June 13 against Wichita.
- The Drillers are 37-11 when scoring first and have scored first in 28 of 51 road games and in 20 of 49 home games.
- De Paula currently leads active players in the TL in average with .313, hits with 118, runs scored with 82 and OPS as .942.
- Hope is tied for the third most RBI in all of Minor League and Major League Baseball and leads the TL with 87. He is also second in the TL in hits with 109 and is tied for the fourth most home runs hit with 23.
- The Drillers have allowed a combined 215 runs (196 ER) to score in the first, second and third innings for a 5.88 ERA, which is the second highest ERA in those innings in the TL. Tulsa's offense also leads the TL for the most combined runs scored in the first, second and third innings with 218.
- Tulsa's pitching staff has issued 513 walks, the second most in Double A. The Drillers offense leads Double A in walks drawn with 504.
- The Drillers have a .264 team batting average against left-handed pitching, which is the second highest in the TL. Tulsa is also batting .270 against right handers, which leads the TL and is the second highest in Double A.
- Seventy-nine of the Drillers 135 home runs have been hit with runners on base, which are the most homers with runners on base in Double A.
- Carson Hobbs has not allowed a run in his last nine outings over 14.1 IP with 17 strikeouts.
- The Drillers have a 1.85 ERA in the ninth inning and are hitting .285 in that inning. Both are the second best in Double A.
- Jose Izarra and Jake Gelof have each earned a hit in six straight games. Gelof has also driven in a run in four consecutive games and nine total during that span.
- Mike Sirota has reached base in nine straight games and 24 times total during that span. He has also scored a run in five consecutive games.

DRILLERS WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT- The Tulsa Drillers hit five home runs and scored half of their runs in the first two innings to earn their fourth straight win against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 14-7 on Friday night at ONEOK Field. Tulsa scored four in the first inning using Jake Gelof's sacrifice fly, Zahir Hope's home run and an RBI single from Frank Rodriguez. In the second, Tulsa scored three more using Josue De Paula's two-run blast and a run-scoring wild pitch. Hope hit his second homer and Chris Newell and De Paula followed with RBI doubles in the fifth inning to give Tulsa ten runs. Tulsa hit two final homers, as Elijah Hainline and Mike Sirota each hit two-run shots in the sixth and seventh innings.
