**CARDINALS HEAD INTO BREAK WITH EXPLOSION, DOWN SUGGE:** The Cardinals registered new season-highs in runs and hits (16) as Springfield took down the Wichita Wind Surge 16-9 on Sunday afternoon at Hammons Field heading into the All-Star Break. With the win the Cardinals match a season-high going 11 games over .500. **RJ Yeager** and **Ramon Mendoza** each had 3 hits for Springfield, and **Jimmy Crooks** clubbed his 5th home run of the season. **Tommy Edman** drove in 3 runs in a rehab appearance for the Cardinals, and **Yeager** (3), **Mendoza** (2), and **Jeremy Rivas** all notched multiple RBIs.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Dylan File** makes his 17th start of the season in the series opener for Amarillo...Last pitched on Wednesday, July 10 at San Antonio and got the win firing 7.0 innings of one-run ball allowing just 5 H while striking out a season-high 10 batters...In the month of July has 15 K to just 1 BB...Struggled in June going 0-3 with a 7.52 ERA in 5 starts...Got the win against the Cardinals on April 20 at Hodgetown allowing 4 ER on 9 H over 5.2 IP...Amarillo won the game 9-6...Signed by the Diamondbacks as a minor league free agent on February 8...Signed with the Doosan Bears of the KBO for \$650,000 in 2023 but made just two starts (0-1, 8.00 ERA)...Missed the first month of the 2023 season after getting struck in the head by a line drive during spring training in Australia in late February...Spent the 2022 season with the Brewers at Triple-A Nashville going 8-6 with a 4.57 ERA in 26 appearances (19 starts)...Released by the Brewers in Nov 2022...Made 9 starts with Nashville in 2021 going 2-4 with a 5.27 ERA but season was cut short due to a fractured elbow...Reached Double-A Biloxi in his 2nd full season...Selected by the Brewers in the 21st round of the 2017 draft out of Dixie State...28 years old

**CARDINALS PAY VISIT TO PANHANDLE FOR QUICK SET WITH SOD POODLES:** Coming out of the All-Star Break, the Cardinals head to Texas for a quick three-game set against the Amarillo Sod Poodles (Double-A, Arizona Diamondbacks). It is the final regular season matchup between the two clubs; the Cards split a six-game series at Hodgetown in April.



### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

**IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE:** After dropping 4 of their first 5 games to start the 2nd half, the Cardinals have won 11 of their last 13 to run their 2nd-half record to 12-6. Over their last 13 games, the Cardinals are 2nd in the league in batting (.301) and tied with Wichita for 2nd in home runs with 15, trailing only Midland (21). The Cards are also 2nd in the league in runs during that stretch with 92 (7.1/game), trailing Midland by just 2 total tallies.

After dropping 11 of 12 at home, the Cardinals have gone 8-2 over their last 10 games at Hammons Field, lifting their home record to 22-24 (.478) overall.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** So far in 2024, the Cardinals have felt plenty at home on the road. The Birds are 27-14 (.675) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in all of Double-A. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.55 which is good for 2nd-best in the Texas League, 0.10 points behind Frisco (3.45). The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.61.

The Cardinals are also the top hitting road team in the circuit with a batting average of .258, 12 points higher than the next-best club (Midland, .246).

**POWER SURGE:** While the Cards have been on the wrong side of the home run ball during the 2024 season, Springfield has homered in each of its last 8 games and has outhomered their opponents 15-9 over its last 13 games. The Cardinals have slugged 7 homers in their last three games, including a season-high tying 3 homers on both Friday and Saturday last week against Wichita.

**CROOKS CATCHING FIRE:** Over his last 15 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. The former Oklahoma Sooner is 3rd in the league with a .382 average while adding 4 HR and 15 RBIs during that time with 3 doubles and a triple. **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging .691 and has a 1.143 OPS. Among active, qualified Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks'** .882 OPS and .416 OBP tops in the circuit while also ranking 5th in SLG (.466).

**Crooks** got off to a slow start in 2023, batting .197 with 11 XBH over his first 44 games with High-A Peoria and ended with a .312 average and .874 OPS over his final 73 contests.

**MATT LLOYD, RUN PRODUCER:** With 6 RBIs last week against the Wind Surge at Hammons Field, Cardinals OF/DH **Matt Lloyd** has seen his name rise to the top of the league leaderboard in that category. **Lloyd's** 53 ribbies counts for six more than anyone else in the Texas League, leading Jake Rucker (WCH) and Tim Tawa (AMA) who each have 47.

**WELCOME BACK:** After spending two and a half weeks in the injured list, **Noah Mendlinger** has picked up right where he left off in his return to Springfield. The Cards' utilityman is 7-for-18 (.389) in 4 games since his return, and going back to before his IL stint, has hit safely in 7 straight games. **Mendlinger** went 3-for-13 during a 4-game rehab stint with Low-A Palm Beach.

**TAKE ME TO CHURCH:** The 2024 season has been an up-and-down one for Cardinals OF **Nathan Church**. After busting out of the gates with a red-hot April that earned him Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month batting .349 with 3 HR and a .914 OPS, the former UC Irvine Anteater slowed down from the middle of May to the end of June, batting .179 with 0 HR and a .466 OPS in 31 games from May 23-June 30.

Since the calendar flipped to July, however, **Church's** bat has heated up again to the tune of a .295 clip with 2 HR. Over his last 9 games, Church is batting .333 with an OPS of .950.

**SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING:** With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the all-time franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander **John Stankoweicz**. For good measure, **Redmond** added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

**Redmond** also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 223.
