THE SURGE – The Wichita Wind Surge wrap up a six-game series against the Tulsa Drillers. The Surge lead the current series four games to one and have matched a season best four game winning streak. The Surge are in first place leading Arkansas by two games, NW Arkansas by 2 ½ and Tulsa 3 ½ games. The Surge have held the top spot in the division for 48 of 65 games this season.

PROPELLER SERIES – The Propeller Series was proposed by Coors Light to bring more meaning to the games between the two teams that are separated by just 178 miles. The cities of Wichita and Tulsa have both played important roles in the aviation industry, making the Propeller Trophy a proper reward. The Drillers and Wind Surge will play a total of 30 games this season with the Propeller Trophy going to the team and city with the most wins. If the series ends in a 15-15 tie, the team winning the final game will win the trophy, making a possible winner-take-all final game possible. Wichita leads the season series 9-8.

LAST GAME – Surge rallied scoring seven unanswered runs to defeat Tulsa 8-7 in ten innings. Wichita trailed 7-1 in the sixth inning and the offense scored three in the sixth, three in the seventh and plated the game winning run in the tenth to win. Everyone in the line up had a hit with BJ Boyd adding three hits and three RBI.

COME BACK KIDS – The six run comeback was the largest come from behind win of the season. The Surge have a pair of six run comebacks, May 13 vs Amarillo. Wichita has come from behind in 18 games to earn the win and last night was the fifth walk off win.

EXTRA – EXTRA – The Surge improved to 3-2 in extra inning games.

DAY BASEBALL – Wichita is 8-4 in day games. The club is batting .286 with a 3.14 ERA in day games as opposed to .249 and 4.25 in night games.

SHUT EM DOWN - Wind Surge pitchers dealt their sixth shutout of the season Thursday night, third highest in the league. Tulsa is batting .181 against Wichita pitching in 17 games.

ON THE HILL – Austin Schulfer is set to make his team leading 14th start of the season tonight. Schulfer has made four starts against Tulsa and is 1-2 with a 5.68 ERA. In his last start Schulfer, pitched five innings, allowed three runs on two hits in the loss. Schulfer has the 4th best ERA in the organization with a 4.45 ERA.

BALAZOVIC! - Surge starter Jordan Balazovic pitched seven shutout innings Thursday night and matched a league best 11 K's in a start, five AA Central Pitchers have done it this season. He has not allowed a run in his last 18 2/3 innings pitched and is 2-0 in his last four starts with a 0.77 ERA, 15H, 3BB, 32K in 23 1/3 innings pitched.

THE OFFENSE – Wichita has scored 9, 9, 7, and eight runs in the last four games.... The Surge offense prior the outburst averaged less than four runs per game in the previous seven games.

BECHTOLD'S BOMBS – Andrew Bechtold has 11 home runs this season and has 5 home runs in his last 11 games. He has been involved in three back to back home runs tandems. The 11 homers have Bechtold tied for 6th in the Twins organization. He has 12 hits in his last 38 at bats, batting .315 with 5 HR and 9 RBI in the homestand.

NOTES – The Surge pitching staff have 605 strikeouts this season, second in AA-Central, trail Tulsa by four Wichita is 12-9 in one run games this season, 21 one-run games leading the league. Wichita is 2nd in the league with a .256 team batting average. The Surge pitchers are third with a 4.03 team ERA and third with six shutouts.

Background: First-Team All-Horizon League honors after going 6-5 with a 2.96 ERA in his senior season at UW Milwaukee. He led the 2018 team with 87 strikeouts. That set his career total in black and gold at 241 – eclipsing the Panthers’ previous career strikeout record of 239. Along the way, he set a new club record with 15 strikeouts in a game on April 6 at Northern Kentucky. He broke his own strikeouts-in-a-game record in the process; Schulfer and five others held the previous record of 13. He also led the 2018 team in wins and innings pitched with six and 91.1 respectively.
