ELECTRIC ELLY'S LIGHTNING BOLT

OF Leo LeCruz has not only been a sparkplug for the Tortugas lineup himself, he has made his teammates better in the process.
• In 48 games since joining the roster on July 16, De La Cruz has slashed .270/.303/.461 with an .785 OPS....He is 31-for-189 at the plate with 21 runs scored, 11 doubles, 7 triples, 5 home runs, 27 RBI and 7 stolen bases.
• Despite playing in just 59 games this season, the 19-year-old is fourth in the Cincinnati farm system in extra-base hits this season (34) with recently promoted OF Andy LeCruz in first (.43). He also leads the organization lead in triples (9).
• Since his debut, he has 5 more extra-base hits than any other player in the Reds' system...Cerdea is second (29).
• Since Ely's Daytona debut on July 17, the Tortugas lead the circuit in total bases (741)...Additionally, they are second in doubles (97), home runs (56) and slugging (.424) and third in hits (.434), OPS (.761), and triples (.21)...On the mound, Daytona leads the league in BAA (.221) and rank tied for third in wins (30-24).

HIP HIP JOSÉ!

OF José Torres have been hotter than Tortugas SS José Torres over the last few weeks:
• The 2021 third-round selection enters Saturday on a 3-game multi-hit streak....He is 6-for-his-last-10 at the plate with 4 runs scored, a double, 2 triples, 2 home runs, 7 RBI, and a walk.
• During the recent road trip, Torres has slashed .364/.425/.758 in 10 games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium....He is 12-for-33 at the plate with 7 runs scored, a double, 3 triples, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 4 walks, a hit-by-pitch, and 2 stolen bases.
• Narrowed down to his last 6 contests, the townson, Md. native has 5 multi-hit games....In that span, Torres is hitting .478 (11-23) with 6 runs scored, a double, 3 triples, 2 home runs, 10 RBI, 2 walks, a hit-by-pitch, and a steal.
• Overall in the month of September, Torres is slashing .396/.446/.729 with a 1.176 OPS....He is 19-for-48 with 8 runs, 4 doubles, 3 triples, 2 home runs, 13 RBI, 5 walks, and 5 stolen bases.
• During the season's final month, the N.C. State alum is tied for the Low-A Southeast lead in triples (3)...He is also second in slugging (.726) and total bases (35), tied for second in extra-base hits (9), third in batting average (.396), RBI (13), OPS (.176), hits (19), tied for third in stolen bases (5) and doubles (4), and seventh in on-base percentage (.446).

DOUBLE TROUBLE

The first time in quite a while, the Tortugas participating in an official doubleheader on Friday:
• Thursday's rain out against Palm Beach was Daytona's first postponement before first pitch since July 28 vs. St. Lucie at Jackie Robinson Ballpark.
• Prior to Thursday, the Tortugas hadn't been washed out in a contest that was washed out before starting since July 8 at Jupiter at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium.
• In all, Daytona has participated in eight doubleheaders so far this season....In 15 total games, the Tortugas hold a 8-7 record....Daytona has split 5 twinbills, swept one at Jupiter, and been swept in one (July 4 at Jupiter), and had one doubleheader contest rained out (June 24 at Clearwater).
• The Tortugas split both double-dips against Palm Beach this season on May 7 and on Friday....On May 7, the Cardinals took the opening game, 3-1...Daytona captured the nightcap, 5-7.
• The 8 doubleheaders in 2021 have been played at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium....Daytona holds a 4-4 record in those games.
• Overall, 7 of the Tortugas 8 twinbills during the 2021 regular season have been held in visiting ballparks.

TORTOISE AND THE HARE

While Tortugas in nature are not known for their speed, the Daytona Tortugas have displayed some impressive wheels in the season's final month:
• Coming into Saturday, the 'tugas have swiped 23 bags in 15 games during the month of September....The 22 stolen bases are the highest total for team in a single month this year...Daytona's previous high was 24 during May.
• Daytona also has their highest total of 119 held by the 2019 team.
• The Tortugas have stolen 119 bases in 2021, when it comes to stolen bases in the month....The previous high was 72.4% (21/29) in May.
• 7 different players have stolen multiple bags in the month....SS José Torres leads the team with 5, while IF/OF Leo Seminatti is second with 4.
• On the defensive side, Daytona has allowed just 4 stolen bases on 7 attempts in September.
• The Tortugas are third in Low-A Southeast in stolen bases....The Dunedin Blue Jays (30) lead the circuit with the Tampa Tarpons (28) in second.
• It is the most stolen bases in a single month for the Tortugas since they swiped 24 on 33 attempts during August of 2019....SS José Barrero and OF Andy Sugilio led the squad in that calendar month with 7 swipes apiece.

TICKETS, PLEASE!

• With RHP Anthony Zimmerman's strikeout of Jupiter 3B Cody Morissette in the bottom of the fifth inning on Sunday, the Tortugas set a new single-season franchise record for strikeouts (1,168), as far as official records show dating back to the first minor league season on City Island in 1920.
• The 2021 club broke the previous record of 1,119 held by the 2019 team.
• The Tortugas are also on pace to break the Cincinnati Reds' Low-A record for strikeouts-per-nine-innings (10.46)...The 2011 Dayton Dragons hold the current mark (9.61)...The 2011 Daytona team also holds the record for most strikeouts by a Cincinnati Low-A affiliate (1,292).
• Daytona has the second-most strikeouts (1,168) among Cincinnati Reds' affiliates in 2021...High-A Dayton leads the system (1,217).
• Among pitchers with at least 20.0 IP in Low-A Southeast this season, the Tortugas have three of the top 15 pitchers in strikeouts-per-nine-innings: RHP Stevie Branche (3.16.39), RHP Vin Timpanelli (6.14.96), and RHP Evan Kravetz (15.13.90).
• Daytona also has four of the top 13 pitchers in the circuit (min. 20.0 IP) in strikeout percentage: Timpanelli (41.40%), Branche (51.40%), Kravetz (10.37.99%), and Stevie Branche (36.79.36).
• The Tortugas also have five of the best 30 pitchers in Low-A Southeast (min. 20.0 IP) when it comes to strikeout-to-walk percentage: Bonnin (6; 30.0%), Branche (16; 26.5%), Kravetz (17; 26.4%), RHP Carson Spiers (23; 25.0%), Timpanelli (30; 24.0%).

TORTUGAS POWER COMPANY

Daytona's offense has been one of the best teams in Low-A Southeast and the Reds' organization when it comes to the long ball in 2021:
• The Tortugas clubbed 35 home runs over 26 games (1.35 HR/game) during August, leading Low-A Southeast squads...Tampa was second (34).
• Since August 2021 was the first month Daytona paced the former Florida State League in home runs since July of 2019 where they topped the FSL with 23 home runs...1B Ibandel Isabel led the Tortugas with 6 home runs that month en route to his league-record 35 homers that season.
• During August, Daytona also led Low-A Southeast in total bases (401) and slugging (.458)...The 'tugas were second in doubles (53) and OPS (.787).
• For the season, the Tortugas are tied for first in the circuit in home runs (108) with the Bradenton Marauders' second (109) and the Tampa Tarpons in first (149).
• Daytona has hit more home runs (108) than any other Cincinnati affiliate in 2021...Double-A Chattanooga is second (101).
• The Tortugas have not led the Reds' Minor League system in homers since they clubbed 102 during the 2016 campaign....Double-A Pensacola was second (89).
• Justice Thompson's two-run blast in the bottom of the fifth in game two on Friday, September 3 vs. Fort Myers, marked the 100th long ball of the year for the Tortugas....It is the first time the franchise has reached the century mark in homers since the 2016 season (102).
• Since the franchise was re-established as the Daytona Cubs in 1993, the team has reached the 100-home run plateau just seven times....The organizational-high since then came during the 1998 season when the D-Cubs parked 119 home runs....3B Ronald Walker led the club that year with 24.

RECE'S PIECES

3B/OF Rece Hinds has been scorching hot since making his return to the Tortugas in St. Lucie:
• Since being activated off the injured list on Tuesday, August 24, the 20-year-old has posted a .289 average (22-76) with 11 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, 6 home runs, 15 RBI, and 4 stolen bases.
• On Saturday, September 11, Hinds set a new career-high with three base hits....On Wednesday, he collected two more hits for his 11th multi-hit game with the club....He also drove in three on Saturday, his seventh multi-RBI game of the campaign.
• Since going on the injured list, Hinds has collected 5 consecutive multi-hit games from Wednesday, August 25, until Tuesday, August 31.
• Over the 5-game multi-hit streak, the Sarasota, Fla. native was 10-for-23 at the dish (.435) with 7 runs, 2 doubles, a triple, 4 home runs, 8 RBI, and 2 steals.
• The 2019 second-round selection registered his first career multi-home run game on Sunday, August 29, in St. Lucie...Hinds poked a 2-run blast to left as a part of a 3-run 3rd inning and added another 2-run shot to left in the 9th in a 6-run trade....He also recorded a career-high 4 RBI on the game.
• Since playing his first rehab game in Arizona on August 7, Hinds is slashing .297/.307/.636 with a .960 OPS, 17 runs, 8 doubles, 3 triples, 8 home runs, 20 RBI, and 5 stolen bases in 30 games.

DAMN, DANIEL!

OF Daniel Vellonji has reached base on an impressive clip over the last few weeks:
• Entering Saturday, the 21-year-old has reached in 45 of 46 games started dating back to game two of a doubleheader on July 9 at Jupiter.
• Since he began his season, Vellonji has collected 9, 254 mark (42-159) with 40 runs, 9 doubles, a triple, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 44 walks, and 5 stolen bases....He is slashing .264/.425/.426 with an .853 OPS since the streak started.
• He's leads the league in on-base percentage (.419) with Bradenton C Endy Rodríguez in second (.417) and is second to Dunedin's 1B P.K. Morris (46) in walks (44) since July 5.
• For the year, Vellonji is second in Low-A Southeast in OBP (.402), third in walks (71), fifth in OPS (.809), tied fifth in doubles (21), and sixth in slugging (.407).

PLAYOFF PICTURE

While Daytona enters Saturday's contest in third place in the Eastern Division, 4.5 games back of first-place Jupiter, but the Low-A Southeast postseason will feature the two teams with the best overall records, and were eliminated from contention with September 5th's 10-2 loss to Fort Myers.
