LAST TIME OUT

WORCESTER, MA (August 25, 2026) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders dropped the series opener 8-5 to the Worcester Red Sox. A five-run seventh catapulted the home team to victory along with their three Major League rehabbing bats.

Worcester capitalized on four walks and an error in the second inning to take a 2-0 lead. Major League rehabbers Isiah Kiner-Falefa, Roman Anthony, and Trevor Story all earned free passes.

The home team added one more in the third off the bat of #1 prospect Franklin Arias.

Marco Luciano broke up a perfect game by Jedixson Paez in the fifth inning. His solo shot was the RailRiders first hit and run of the contest.

SWB sent eight to the plate in the next frame to score three runs. Ernesto Martinez Jr. worked a walk, Anthony Volpe singled to reach, and Garver loaded the bases on a free pass. J.C. Escarra laced a two-run single and Luciano followed with an RBI knock of his own for a 4-3 lead.

The Red Sox countered with a five-run seventh. With five hits and a pair of walks, they took back the lead 8-4. Anthony hit a two-run bomb to start off the scoring.

Luciano launched his second homer of the game to right center. Despite a hit in the ninth, SWB fell 8-5.

Kyle Carr made his first appearance off of the Injured List throwing the first frame. Xavier Rivas (L, 4-4) tossed three and a third for a bulk of the contest. Danny Watson took the loss in his inning and two thirds while John Brebbia (W, 2-0) earned the win.

NEWS & NOTES

THE MARTÍNEZ WEEK - Ernesto Martínez Jr has now reached base successfully in 17 straight games. He extended his streak last night with a walk and a double in the ninth. Martínez Jr. has hit .339 over this time, accumulating twenty hits with five doubles. In 14 games in August, the lefty has hit .298 for his best month of the season. Martínez Jr. has hit 16 homers, marking the most he has launched in a single summer. He also now has 54 runs batted in which is nine away from the most he has had in a single season (62 in 2024).

DUKE'S RECORD PERFORMANCE - Duke Ellis set a new single season record with 45 stolen bases on the season. He broke the record of 44 set by Tommy Barrett in 1989. Barrett did so in 120 games, whereas Ellis marked his in 85 contests. Ellis also holds the franchise record for 87 total with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in 161 games. The prior record was held by Nick Punto who stole 82 bags in 263 games. Ellis's personal record is 57 in a single year done back in 2024.

MARCO x MARCO - Marco Luciano had a two-homer game last night for the RailRiders and his RBI single was a mere miss from going over the left field wall. It marked a dozen home runs in Triple-A. It was his fifth two-homer game of the season with three of them occurring in his time on the RailRiders. With 10 smacked in Double-A, he has totalled 22 in 94 games, which is one away from a career high set last season with Sacramento.

HOMER HITTING - The RailRiders move up in the ladder of most home runs hit in Triple-A this season. They are currently tied for third with 174 alongside Columbus. They are behind the league leading Saints with 221 and Charlotte with 176. Yanquiel Fernández has the most tallying 21 on the summer, while 29 different players have at least one on the books for the RailRiders.

RODRÍGUEZ IS ROLLING - Yankees #3 prospect Elmer Rodríguez was recalled to the New York Yankees to make a start tonight against Houston. He has made four starts for a 4.76 ERA with the New York Yankees. Rodríguez was picked up in a trade with Boston for C Carlos Narváez in 2024. Rodríguez has been stellar for the RailRiders in his 19 starts accumulating 97.1 innings pitched. He has earned eight wins while striking out 99 batters, compared to just 46 walks. The righty has lowered his ERA to 2.59 in Triple-A.

WHAT'S LEFT - The RailRiders have just four weeks of the season left, with two of those series at PNC Field. They will play a six-game set against Worcester this week to finish off August. September features a home series against Lehigh Valley and a trip to Rochester where they will play on Labor Day Monday. SWB wraps up their 2026 campaign with a week at PNC Field against Jacksonville, the Marlins Triple-A affiliate.
