Closing Day Stakes... The Bowling Green Hot Rods enter the final day of the 2026 South Atlantic League regular season with a chance to claim the South Division crown in each halves. Bowling Green needs a win and a Winston-Salem road loss against the Rome Emperors to win the second half title. The Hot Rods have only won both halves in a season once before in their 17-year franchise history.

Record-Setting Speed... The 2026 Hot Rods have swiped a franchise-record 299 stolen bases this season, including 20 in this series. The 299 steals surpasses the previous franchise record of 262 in the 2024 season. Infielder Tony Santa Maria leads the South Atlantic League with 55 swipes, which would make him the first-ever Hot Rods player to lead their league in stolen bases.

A Dozen Walk-Offs... Jhon Diaz lifted a walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th inning to wrap up a 3-2 Bowling Green on Friday night. Bowling Green has set a new franchise-record with 12 walk-off victories this season, surpassing their previous nine walk-off wins during the 2021 season.

Double-Digit Dominance... Friday night starter Jonathan Russell punched out a career-high 10 over 4.0 innings. Russell is the fourth different Hot Rods player to boast a 10-strikeout performance this season, joining Anderson Brito, Jacob Kisting, and Trevor Harrison.

Saved Their Best For Last... Russell is one of two Hot Rods pitchers who have set their new career-bests in strikeouts over the last three games. Kaleb Corbett fanned five over 2.0 relief innings on Thursday night, one-upping his four with the Charleston RiverDogs on August 5, 2025.

The Drive For Five... Following Sunday's game, Bowling Green turns their attention to the SAL's Division Series against Winston-Salem. The Hot Rods have never faced the Dash in a postseason series. Bowling Green is in search of their fifth league championship in their 17-year franchise history and their first since 2023.
