Crucial Stretch: Today, 1/3 of the way through the 66-game first half, marks the start of 12 consecutive games against the Lugnuts' top competition in the Midwest League's East Division. First, the second-place Nuts welcome in the third-place (and defending league champion) Lake County Captains to Michigan's state capital, followed by a trip next week to first-place West Michigan. The Lugnuts are only a game behind the Whitecaps but only a game up on the Captains. Lake County boasts a pair of touted teenagers: the No. 3 (Jaison Chourio) and No. 5 (Ralphy Velazquez) prospects in the Guardians' organization.

Prospecting: The Nuts, for that matter, have the Athletics' second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman Tommy White (40th overall), southpaw starter Gage Jump (73rd), shortstop Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (75th) and outfielder Rodney Green, Jr. (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 18. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old Steven Echavarria, rated No. 12, and outfielder Nate Nankil, who is No. 28.

Atop the League: The Lugnuts' offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.283), base hits (199), fewest strikeouts (138), on-base percentage (.389) and OPS (.799). The Nuts also rank second in slugging percentage (.410).

Streaking: Clark Elliott (idle yesterday) enters today on a 15-game on-base streak; Tommy White (1-for-5) has hit safely in 12 straight games and reached base in his last 14 games; and T.J. Schofield-Sam (idle) has reached base in his last 13 straight games.

Speaking of Clark... Outfielder Clark Elliott terrorized Fort Wayne's pitching staff last week, reaching base in 13 of 17 plate appearances: six walks, five base hits and two HBPs.

APRIL 29TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2001: Aaron Krawiec sets a franchise record with 17 strikeouts in eight shutout innings, allowing two hits and no walks, as the Lugnuts defeated the South Bend Silver Hawks, 2-0. 2000 Cubs third-rounder Krawiec struck out 14 of the first 18 batters and pitched 6 1/3 innings of no-hit baseball. The gem earned him the honor of Midwest League Pitcher of the Week.

2008: The Lugnuts had 14 hits, the Quad Cities River Bandits had eight, and yet it took only two hours and six minutes for the Nuts to win, 3-1, at Clinton's Alliant Energy Field. Randy Boone tossed six scoreless innings, striking out four. This was the second game of a three-game series played in three different Iowa cities due to the Mississippi River flooding around the ballpark.

2022: Ángel Martínez lined a two-run walk-off homer to right, catapulting the Lake County Captains to a 4-3 victory over the Lugnuts.

In a Nutshell: Making his Lugnuts debut this season... only native Cuban on the team... noted for mid-90s fastball / split-changeup combo... one of three pitchers on the roster standing at least 6-foot-6 or taller (Kyle Robinson, Jake Pfennigs)... looking to become second ever Major Leaguer named Yunior (joining Santo Domingo native Yunior Marte, who spent last season in the Phillies' pen).

Hometown Hero: Though born in La Habana, Yunior grew up in Santiago de Cuba, which also produced such notable Major Leaguers as Bárbaro Garbey, Adeiny Hechavarría and Orestes Destrade.

Dominating in Cuba: Yunior pitched three seasons for Avispas ("Wasps") de Santiago de Cuba in the Cuban National Series, from 2018-2021... in 2019-20, at age 19, posted remarkable line: 0.00 ERA, 9 saves, 22 scoreless innings, 8 hits, 16 walks (two intentional) and 24 strikeouts... teammate: Oscar Colás, now with the White Sox... followed up in 2020-21: 2.11 ERA, league-leading 14 saves, 38 1/3 IP, 32 hits, 10 runs (9 earned), 25 walks, 45 strikeouts.

2023 - Joining the A's: Signed with the Athletics for \$100,000 three days before the end of the international signing period on May 8, 2023... made his pro debut with the Arizona Complex A's on June 5, allowing two runs (one earned) in four innings with no walks and four strikeouts against D-Backs Black... moved up to Stockton on June 17 and finished the season with 19 appearances out of the Ports' pen.

2024 - Back to Stockton: Pitched in relief for the Ports on Opening Day, April 5, and pitched a scoreless sixth before allowing three runs in the seventh inning, suffering the loss in a 7-2 defeat to Modesto... worked as a piggybacker throughout the year, alternating starts and relief appearances... tossed career five innings on four different occasions, allowing one run or fewer each time; curiously, these gems happened once a month - April 18, May 23, June 15, July 31... struck out seven Lake Elsinore Ports in three hitless innings, August 6, setting pro high... vs. lefties: .285/.356/.468, 6 HR... vs. righties: .255/.339/.418... base-stealers went 14-for-16 in successful attempts.
