PITCHER OF THE WEEK RHP Patrick Halligan has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for May 11-17th. Halligan went 1-0 in two appearances (one start) for the Sea Dogs during the week, tossing six hitless innings with one walk and six strikeouts. On May 13th, Halligan pitched 2.0 no-hit innings out of the bullpen in a 9-6 Sea Dogs win. On May 16th, Halligan made a spot start for the Sea Dogs and tossed four perfect innings with four strikeouts.

OUT OF THE PARK! The Sea Dogs' 50 home runs on the season is the third most in the Eastern League behind Somerset (70) and Reading (54). Portland has 15 multi-home run games this season, and have scored 46% of their total runs via the long ball (83/180).

BATS HEATING UP In 24 April games, the Sea Dogs slashed .213/.319/.368 as a team, with 161 hits, 33 doubles, 3 triples, and 26 home runs. In 14 May games, the Sea Dogs are slashing .248/.340/.461 as a team, with 120 hits, 27 doubles, 2 triples, and 24 home runs, closing in on their April numbers in 10 fewer games.

HARTFORD RECAP All six games in last week's series were decided by three or fewer runs, with four one-run games, including their last three in a row, two that went to extra innings, and three walk-off wins for Hartford. The Sea Dogs hit 11 doubles, one triple, and 11 home runs throughout the week. Their 23 extra-base hits represents their most in a series this season, passing last week's mark of 20 extra-base hits.

EYES ON READING The Fightin' Phils faced the Northeast Division leading New Hampshire Fisher Cats in seven games last week. The Phils took the series 4-3, winning four of their last five after losing the first two games. They played double headers on both May 15th and May 17th, making up previous games postponed due to weather and field conditions. The week was highlighted by a 20-0 win on Saturday, May 16th, where all nine starters had a hit, and seven players had multi-hit games. Reading pitching has the third best ERA in the Eastern League, and Reading batters have the third most hits and extra base hits in the league.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY May 19, 2015 – Carlos Asuaje (4 RBI), Luis Martinez (3 RBI) and Mike Miller (3 RBI) combined for 10 RBI in Portland's 14-10 win over Altoona at Hadlock Field...The 'Dogs were down 5-2 after two innings, but scored 9 times during innings 4-6.

ON THE MOUND RHP Anthony Eyanson (0-0, 2.25 ERA) makes his second start for Portland. He gave up one run in four innings while striking out four during his Double-A debut on May 10th. Eyanson won April Pitcher of the Month in the South Atlantic League as a member of the High-A Greenville Drive. Eyanson made five starts in Greenville, allowing seven hits and one run in 20.1 innings of work, with 34 strikeouts and three walks. Eyanson is just two months into his minor league career after winning a College World Series Championship with LSU in 2025. In MLB.com's latest rankings, Eyanson checks in as the no. 2 prospect in the Red Sox organization behind Franklin Arias, and the 43rd best prospect in Minor League Baseball.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Acting Manager - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala enters his third season on the Portland staff after a highly successful tenure at Grove City College, where he served as Associate Head Coach from 2016 to 2023. During his time with the Wolverines, Sasala played a key role in the program's rise, highlighted by a school-record 30-win season in 2023 and a 16-4 conference mark. He also helped guide Grove City to a then-record 28 victories in 2019 alongside head coach Matt Royer. Sasala later stepped in as interim head coach for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, leading the Wolverines to a runner-up finish.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera also returns to the Sea Dogs coaching staff as a pitching coach for his second season. In 2025, Rivera helped guide a Portland pitching staff that recorded 1,435 strikeouts, the second-most in the Eastern League, while posting a 3.65 team ERA, the fourth-best mark in the league. Rivera spent the previous three seasons as the Salem Red Sox' pitching coach, where he led the staff to a 3.61 ERA, the fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, Rivera has been part of the Boston Red Sox organization since 2022, serving as a Development Coach with Salem before joining the Sea Dogs coaching staff.

Hitting Coach - Trevor Burmeister

Trevor Burmeister joins the Sea Dogs coaching staff as hitting coach after spending the previous five seasons in the Colorado Rockies organization. Burmeister began his coaching career immediately following his collegiate playing career at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, where he spent two seasons on the coaching staff. He then served one season at the University of Minnesota Duluth, where the offense ranked third nationally in NCAA Division II with a .352 team batting average and second in the nation with 102 home runs. Burmeister later returned to his alma mater, Madison College (NJCAA), spending three seasons under head coach Mike Davenport. During his time there, he was named the 2019 NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Baseball America.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Schmidt

Kyle Schmidt joins the Sea Dogs as defensive coach after spending two years with the Red Sox' Single-A affiliate, the Salem Ridge Yaks. Originally from Smithville, TX, Kyle attended the University of Richmond and became a starting catcher for the Spider Baseball Team. Following his 2019 season, Kyle was drafted in the 33rd Round of the 1st Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins. Kyle voluntarily retired after the 2023 season. During his playing career, Kyle played at every Minor League level while also being involved in multiple Major League Spring Trainings.

Athletic Trainer - Kelsey Branstetter

Kelsey Branstetter joins the staff as Portland's Athletic Trainer, her first year with the Sea Dogs and second season in the Red Sox organization. She spent last season as the Athletic Trainer for the Greenville Drive (High-A) and served in the same role for Triple-A Louisville (Cincinnati Reds) from 2023-2024. Branstetter graduated from Middle Tennessee State University, where she played four years of soccer. Following her undergraduate studies, Branstetter obtained a master's degree from Wichita State University.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch returns to the staff for his second season in Portland and his third year in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he supported the strength and conditioning programs for players returning to the field. In that role, he collaborated closely with Major League sports performance and on-field staff to ensure the highest level of care for injured athletes.

2026 in Greenville earned **South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month** honors in April for his work opening the season with the Red Sox' High-A affiliate, the Greenville Drive. Eyanson recorded a 0.54 ERA in four April starts, allowing one run on six hits over 16.2 innings, with 27 strikeouts and no walks. Overall, Eyanson made five starts for Greenville to the tune of a 0.44 ERA, allowing seven hits and one run with 34 strikeouts in 20.1 innings of work.

CAREER: Enters 2026 ranked as the Red Sox' No. 10 prospect by MLB.com, and by Baseball America as their No. 13 prospect...currently up to No. 8 in MLB Pipeline

PERSONAL: Attended the University of California, San Diego (2023-24) and Louisiana State University (2025)...In 2025, posted a 3.00 ERA (36 ER/108.0 IP) with 152 SO (3rd-most in Division I baseball) helping lead LSU to a National Championship...Earned the win in the championship clinching game vs. Coastal Carolina (6.1 IP, 3 R, 7 H, BB, 9 SO)...Was tabbed a First Team All-American by Baseball America, and a Second Team selection by D1 Baseball, ABCA, NCBWA, and Perfect Game...Also named Second-Team All-SEC and to the First-Year SEC Academic Honor Roll...In 2024 at UC San Diego, was a Second-Team All-Big West honoree...In 2024, played summer baseball with the Cotuit Kettleers of the Cape Cod League...Graduated from Lakewood High School (CA)...Notable MLB alumni include, J.P. Crawford, Travis d'Arnauld, and 2013 World Series Champion Mike Carp...Also played football his freshman and junior year as a quarterback, wide receiver, safety, and kicker.
