FIFTH THIRD PARK FIRSTS: Top prospects Dylan Dreiling and Malcolm Moore hit the first two home runs in the history of "the Fraction" last night. Dreiling's bomb traveled 324 feet at a 32 degree launch angle, and two innings later, Moore launced a 108-mph missile 434 feet onto the grassy field beyond the right field bullpens.

MAKE A STATEMENT: The reigning South Atlantic League champs, the Bowling Green Hot Rods, roll into town for the first home series in Spartanburgers history. Last year, the Hot Rods were one of two SAL teams with a winning road record, and outscored opponents by 138 runs in the second half of the season.

A TRIP TO REMEMBER: The Spartanburgers left their nine-game Northeast roadstand with their first series win in franchise history. Throughout the trip, numerous "firsts" were recorded: first win (Victor Simeon), first run (Arturo Disla), first save (Seth Clark), first double (Malcolm Moore) and first ejection (Quincy Scott).

'24 TOP THREE: The Rangers' top three draft picks are in the Sparkle City to begin the '25 season. C Malcolm Moore, 2024 first-round draft choice, is the highest-rated Hub City player in both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America's top 30 lists, coming in at No. 5 and No. 6, respectively. Both publications also view OF Dylan Dreiling, the Rangers' second-round pick, as a top 10 prospect. Third-round pick, INF Casey Cook, ranks at No. 25 on Baseball America's index.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACE: Hub City welcomes 17 players who finished their 2024 season with the High-A (now Low-A) Hickory Crawdads; nine of the new Spartanburgers wrapped up their 2024 campaigns with the now-defunct Down East Wood Ducks.

LOCAL SHOWDOWN: The first-ever game played in Fifth Third Park was Spartanburg's collegiate crosstown rivalry: Wofford against USC Upstate on Tuesday, April 1. The Terriers took down the Spartans 5-2. "We're fortunate enough to win, but it's more the environment and atmosphere," said Wofford head coach J.J. Edwards. "[Playing the first game ever] is something you're going to say for the rest of your life.." The capped crowd purchased all 3,662 available tickets.

LAST NIGHT'S TICKET

- Hub City won its inaugural home opener 5-3 over Bowling Green.
 Almost 4500 fans were in attendance for Opening Day ceremonies,
 game action and postgame fireworks.
- Dylan Dreiling and Malcolm Moore both hit homers in the first and third innings, respectively. Dreiling's is the first HR in HC history
- Three Spartanburger bullpen arms combined for 6 2/3 scoreless innings. RHP Joey Danielson got the win.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jay Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevvs Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
