By the Numbers

In Friday's 6-4 win over Fort Wayne, the Lake County bullpen pitched 5 shutout innings. The winning pitcher, LHP Adam Tulloch (2-0), RHP Alaska Abney, and RHP Allan Hernández combined to allow just 2 hits and throw 6 strikeouts. The Captains' bullpen ranks 4th in the Midwest League with a 3.66 ERA.

Captains INF/OF C.J. Kayfus leads the Midwest League with a .500 batting average with runners in scoring position so far this season. In this situation, the 22-year-old is 10-for-20 with 3 doubles, 1 home run, 16 RBI, 2 walks, a .522 OBP, a .800 SLG, and a 1.322 OPS.

Lake County starters have recorded 123 strikeouts through their first 25 games, ranking 2nd in the Midwest League and 6nd in all of High-A. LHP Parker Messick (33), MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect and RHP Austin Peterson (33) are two of three pitchers tied for the Midwest League individual lead in strikeouts.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Friday night at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake, The Captains scored 5 runs in the second, 1 in the eighth, and shut out the Fort Wayne TinCaps over the final 5 innings to win Game 5 of the series by a final score of 6-4.

TAKING ADVANTAGE: Lake County went 6-for-11 with runners in scoring position on Friday night, while stranding 12 Fort Wayne runners on base.

KAYFUS KRUSHES, MOONEY MASHES: 1B C.J. Kayfus posted team-highs of 3 hits and 2 RBI, while 3B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, went 2-for-4 and drove in an insurance run in the eighth inning with an RBI double

BULLPEN BLANKING: LHP Adam Tulloch (2-0), RHP Alaska Abney, and RHP Allan Hernández combined for 5 shutout innings out of the Lake County bullpen. Tulloch tied his seasonhigh of 3 innings for the third time this season, throwing a season-high 4 strikeouts, Abney extended his scoreless streak to 7.1 innings, and Hernández earned his first career Minor League save in his 37th appearance.

ON THE POND: With an RBI single in Friday's win, INF Nate Furman extended his on-base streak to 15 games, which is tied for team's longest of the season with INF Maick Collado. Furman and Collado are tied for the second-longest active onbase streak in the Midwest League.

CONGRATS, CC!: 19-year MLB vet and 2007 AL Cy Young Award winner CC Sabathia was named the 48th member of the Cleveland Guardians Hall of Fame on Thursday. While he did not pitch for Lake County, Sabathia went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA in three starts for its predecessor, the Columbus RedStixx (Columbus, Georgia).

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,759 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,387-1,372 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-five in the Midwest League in strikeouts (118, 1st), fewest walks (26, 1st), wins (7, tied for 1st), WHIP (1.19, tied for 2nd) innings pitched (118.0, 2nd), and ERA (3.66, 5m).

TOP QUALITY: Through 25 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded a Midwest League-best 7 quality starts (6+ innings pitched, 3-or-fewer earned runs). Cedar Rapids has the next-most quality starts by a Midwest League team so far this season with 4. The other 11 Midwest League teams besides Lake County have a combined 14 quality starts so far this year.

BASH BROS 2.0: Captains INF/OF C.J. Kayfus and INF Alex Mooney have been the Midwest League's premier slugging tandem so far this season. The duo has accounted for 33% of Lake County's run production, while hitting 8 of Lake County's 20 home runs.

COLLADO COLLECTING BASES: Captains INF Maick Collado has reached base at an incredible rate in his first 16 career High-A games. The 21-year-old has a .500 OBP, which is tied with Great Lakes' Alex Freeland for the Midwest League lead and is tied for 5th in all of Minor League Baseball. Collado also ranks top-10 in the MWL in batting average (.333, T-7th) OPS (.931, 8th), and walks (16, tied for 8th). He is also currently on a 15-game on base streak, which is the third-longest in the Midwest League. During this stretch, he is hitting .362 (17-for-47), 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 16 walks, and a .999 OPS.

MOONEY'S STELLAR SERIES: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, was named the second Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, for his performance in last week's series at West Michigan. The 21-year-old hit 8-for-21 (,381), with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, one walk, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches. Mooney's 2 home runs (tied for 2m²), 5 extra-base hits (3m²), and 7 runs (tied for 3m²) all ranked top-three in the Midwest League this past week.

MOONEY MAKES HISTORY: On Saturday, April 27, Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, tied a pair of franchise records. The 2023 seventh-round pick went 5-for-5 with 3 doubles, becoming the 16th Captain to record a 5-hit game, and the 13th to record a 3-double game. Mooney recorded the first 5-hit performance by a Lake County player since Bobby Ison on 8/7/2016 vs. West Michigan, and the first 3-double performance since current Double-A Akron RubberDucks OF Chase DeLauter on 7/9/2023 at Lansing.

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Six players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

LAST TIME OUT: Jake Miller (ND) did not record a decision in his fourth start of the season on April 28 at West Michigan. The right-hander tied his season-high with 4 innings of work, allowing 4 hits, 2 earned runs, and 1 walk, while throwing 3 strikeouts in striking out three in 66 pitches (44 strikes) in the 9-4 win. After **Miller** allowed 2 runs in the first inning, courtesy of a wild pitch and an RBI groundout, he retired 9 of his last 12 batters faced.

AGAINST FORT WAYNE IN '24: Miller made his season debut on April 12 at Fort Wayne, earning the win in relief as the piggyback pitcher. He pitched 3.1 innings, allowing 4 hits, 2 earned runs, and 2 walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts in 55 pitches (34 strikes) in the 7-6 win.

RETURNING CAPTAIN: After making 4 rehab appearances (3 starts) for the Arizona Complex League Guardians last year, **Miller** made his final 4 appearances (two starts) with the Captains. The right-hander went 0-1 with a 4.76 ERA and 5 strikeouts in 11.1 innings of work.

SURGERY RECOVERY: Miller began the 2023 season on the 60-day injured list due to recovering from Tommy John surgery on his right elbow. The right-hander then made four rehab appearances (three starts) for the Arizona Complex League Guardians. **Miller** pitched 8.2 innings, allowing 2 hits, one earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 9 strikeouts.

SINGLE-A SEASON: Miller made 9 starts for Single-A Lynchburg in 2022. The right-hander compiled an 0-1 record with a 4.81 ERA in 33.2 innings pitched, allowing 10 walks and throwing 43 strikeouts. **Miller's** last appearance with Lynchburg came on June 5, 2022, when he pitched a career-low one inning (since tied).

TERRIFIC TORERO: Miller pitched three collegiate seasons at the University of San Diego. The right-hander compiled a 9-7 record with a 3.14 ERA in 132 innings pitched, allowing 63 walks and throwing 151 strikeouts. As a sophomore in 2021, Miller was named 1st Team All-WCC after leading the conference with a 2.52 ERA in 60.2 innings pitched. On February 28, 2020, Miller threw a nohitter against Monmouth, allowing just 2 walks and throwing 10 strikeouts in 102 pitches. A notable baseball alum from the University of San Diego is four-time MLB All-Star, 2016 NL MVP, and 2016 World Series Champion Kris Bryant.

WHAT IS A TORERO?: A Torero, the nickname for Miller's alma mater, is Spanish for "bullfighter." In 1958, then president of the University of San Diego Father Charles Fink changed the mascot from Pioneers to Toreros after moving into California's Mission League. USD is located 1.3 miles from Old Town San Diego, an area with strong ties to the Latin American community.

FAMILY ATHLETES: Miller's uncle played professional baseball for the Chicago Cubs, his father played professional football in the NFL for the San Francisco 49ers and Oakland Raiders, and his grandfather played professional football in the NFL for Washington.
