STEADY STUART: Mets No. 18 prospect **Tyler Stuart** is slated to make his 10th start of the season for Binghamton tonight. In his last start, Stuart took the loss after allowing three runs over five innings with six strikeouts against the Harrisburg Senators on Friday. The 24-year-old has pitched at least five innings in five-straight starts and has allowed three runs or fewer in eight of his nine starts. The 6-foot-9 right-hander struck out nine batters over seven innings, while allowing three runs against the Bowie Baysox on May 18, and he threw a season-high 101 pitches. Stuart led all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (2.20) last season.

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Bowie Baysox, 6-5, at Prince George's Stadium on Wednesday night. Luis Moreno struck out a season-high seven batters over a season-high five scoreless innings in relief. Ryan Clifford belted a solo homer, which marked his third Double-A home run. Jeremiah Jackson hit a two-run single that capped off a four-run fourth inning.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 75 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** belted a solo home run in the second inning on Wednesday at Bowie, which marked his third Double-A homer. Clifford has now homered in two of his last three games. The 20-year-old has reached base in seven-straight games and in 12 of his last 13 games. Over his seven-game on-base streak, Clifford is hitting .263 with a .482 on-base percentage, and a 1.166 OPS, with two homers, four runs batted in, five runs scored, eight walks, and two intentional walks. Clifford is currently tied for the second-most walks (46) in all of Minor League Baseball with MLB Pipeline's No. 1 overall prospect Jackson Holliday.

MDRE MDREND: Right-hander **Luis Moreno** spun his best outing of the season on Wednesday night at Bowie. Moreno struck out a season-high seven hitters over a season-high five scoreless innings in relief, while allowing just two hits and one walk. In two appearances against Bowie, Moreno has 12 strikeouts and has allowed just one run over 9.1 innings.

SCHWARTZ BOMB: First baseman **JT Schwartz** belted a solo home run in the top of the fifth inning on Tuesday night at Bowie, which marked his second long ball of the season. Schwartz's first home run of the season came on April 14 at Erie, and the 24-year-old went 32 games without hitting a home run. Schwartz hit four homers in 66 games with Double-A Binghamton last season and has hit 12 home runs in 246 professional games.

RELIABLE RAMOS: Right-handed reliever **Wilkin Ramos** currently has the second-most saves in the Eastern League with six. Ramos has not yet allowed a run over his first 12 appearances of the season. Over his first 12 appearances, Ramos is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, six saves, and an 18-to-3 strikeout-to-walk ratio over 17 scoreless innings of work. Ramos pitched 1.1 scoreless frames with a strikeout and two hits and two walks allowed against Bowie on May 18.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. -AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.
