the Brewers' 10-day injured list since July 5 with right forearm inflammation, is batting .213 (55-for-258) with 12 home runs and 36 RBI in 79 games with Milwaukee this season. The left-handed hitter suffered a $setback\ on\ July\ 15\ in\ Cincinnati, fracturing\ a\ finger\ in\ a\ bizarre\ incident\ at\ Great\ American\ Ball\ Park.$

LAST OUTING: Boushley had a tough go his last time out, surrendering five earned runs in 5.0+ innings against the Durham Bulls. The right-hander allowed three hits, walked two, struck out one and hit a batter. Boushley threw 92 pitches (53 for strikes), taking the loss in Nashville's 9-6 defeat.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley has one career start against Indianapolis, which came on June 29 of last season. He allowed four earned runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings (7.20 ERA) and did not earn a decision.
