THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2014, the Sounds swept a doubleheader against Round Rock at Herschel Greer Stadium. Matt Clark hit a walk-off 2-run homer to win game one, while Logan Schafer clubbed 2 RBI to take game two.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds head to the Hoosier State for the first time since September of 2021 to take on the Indianapolis Indians, affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Caleb Boushley makes his 22nd start of the season for Nashville, while Indianapolis is set to send Beau Sulser to the hill.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his 22nd start of the season tonight for the Sounds. The right-hander is 6-5 with a 4.68 ERA (100.0 IP/52 ER) in 2023. He took the loss his last time out vs. Durham, allowing three hits (2 ER) and surrendering five earned runs over five-plus innings. July was Boushley's best month as he posted a 2-0 record and 3.91 ERA in four starts, two of which were quality. He currently ranks among league leaders in starts (T-1st), innings pitched (5th), WHIP (8th, 1.38), and opponent average (9th, .265). The Hortonville, Wisconsin native was named the 2022 Sounds Pitcher of the Year after going 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA in 25 starts. The Brewers acquired Boushley in the Triple-A phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021. He was originally drafted in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of UW-La Crosse.

Beau Sulser: 29-year-old Beau Sulser makes his season debut for Indianapolis tonight. The right-hander went 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (14.0 IP/6 ER) in four starts with Double-A Altoona. In his final start for the Curve on August 1, Sulser held Richmond to one hit and one walk over 5.0 scoreless innings, fanning one. Originally drafted by Pittsburgh in the 10th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft, he was designated for assignment and claimed by Baltimore in May 2022. The Dartmouth product went 3-4 with a 4.13 ERA (56.2 IP/26 ER) in 20 games (6 starts) between Indianapolis (3) and Norfolk (17) in 2022. Sulser has a 3.63 ERA (22.1 IP/9 ER) in 10 career Major League games, all during the 2022 season.

Our Hiura: Keston Hiura launched his team-leading 17th home run of the campaign on Sunday night - a three-run blast that brought the Sounds back within a run. The infielder has knocked in a run in nine of his last 13 games dating back to July 20. Over the same span, his 17 RBI is tied for the third-most in the International League, trailing Memphis' Luken Baker (25) and Durham's Austin Shenton (18).

From Biloxi to Broadway: Infielder Tyler Black worked two walks his Triple-A debut on Sunday night. Black is touted as the No. 91 prospect in baseball and the No. 5 prospect in the Brewers system per MLB Pipeline. In 84 games with Double-A Biloxi, Black hit .273 (84-for-308) with 16 doubles, eight triples, 14 homers, 48 RBI, 61 walks, 47 stolen bases and 70 runs with the Shuckers. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in triples (8) and stolen bases. Black also ranked among SL league leaders in runs (2nd), on-base percentage (2nd, .411), OPS (4th, .924), walks (4th), extra-base hits (T-4th), total bases (5th, 158) and slugging (6th, .513).

Strong Arm Barn: Nashville relievers continue to be one of the International League's premier pens. They lead all IL relief corps in ERA (4.21), fewest home runs allowed (45), fewest walks allowed (203), WHIP (1.38) and ground outs per air out (1.37). The Sounds also rank among leaders in runs allowed (2nd, 246), earned runs allowed (2nd, 207) and hits allowed (T-3rd, 406).

Let's Get Rowdy!: Milwaukee Brewers first baseman Rowdy Tellez joins the Nashville Sounds on rehab assignment today. Tellez, who has been on the Brewers' 10-day injured list since July 5 with right forearm inflammation, is batting .213 (55-for-258) with 12 home runs and 36 RBI in 79 games with Milwaukee this season. The left-handed hitter suffered a setback on July 15 in Cincinnati, fracturing a finger in a bizarre incident at Great American Ball Park.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Tyler Black is the No. 5 prospect (No. 91 in baseball), left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 656-568 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Boushley had a tough go his last time out, surrendering five earned runs in 5.0+ innings against the Durham Bulls. The right-hander allowed three hits, walked two, struck out one and hit a batter. Boushley threw 92 pitches (53 for strikes), taking the loss in Nashville's 9-6 defeat.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley has one career start against Indianapolis, which came on June 29 of last season. He allowed four earned runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings (7.20 ERA) and did not earn a decision.

- Made first Opening Day start for Nashville, pitching in Game 1 of the season-opening doubleheader against Louisville
- Allowed just one earned run over first two starts (1.42 ERA), both coming in doubleheaders
