### DAILY SPECIALS

**DOG DAYS:** Hub City is currently 5-10 in August with a .211 team batting average and a 4.42 ERA (second-worst in the SAL). In August, the Spartanburgers have only hit 2 HRs in 15 games, and their .277 SLG is the worst in the league.

**GO TO WORK, GUT!** Anthony Gutierrez knocked three hits last Friday for his team-leading 10th three-hit game of the season. In August, Gutierrez is batting .304 and has reached base in 10 of his 12 games started. The Rangers' No. 25 prospect also has swiped 7 bags in August.

**CURRIED CYCLONE:** Since returning from the ACL, Aidan Curry has racked up 18 strikeouts and only allowed two ER in 13 IP. Curry picked up his third win of the season last Wednesday with 5 frames of one-run ball. 2/3 of his pitches were in the zone.

**BAD BEACH FOR BATS:** The 'Burger bats were held to one run three times at Jersey Shore. Hub City went 12-49 with RISP and left 52 runners on base at ShoreTown Ballpark. Tuesday in Brooklyn continued the trend, as Hub City was shut out, left 8 on base, and went 1-11 w/ RISP.

**BULLPEN BLUNDERS:** Over the two week road trip, the Spartanburgers' bullpen allowed 33 runs, 31 of which were earned, over 41.1 IP. Bullpen arms were 1-6 with 2 saves in 8 opportunities.

**TOP 30 RESHUFFLE:** With the addition of the latest MLB draft prospects, Hub City's top prospects have been part of a Pipeline rerank. Malcolm Moore (#11) and Dylan Dreiling (#15) are still the 'Burgers' top prospects, but pitcher Dalton Pence was nudged out. Anthony Gutierrez also dropped down to No. 25.

**RACE TO THE FINISH:** Tied at 9-9 in head-to-head, this week's results will be a major factor in determining whether the Spartanburgers or Drive take the 2H playoff spot. Greenville plays v. BG and @ WS in their final two series. The tiebreaker if the teams split this week is win % over the last 20 games of the season (HC 1-1, GVL 1-1).

## CLUB INFO & COACHING STAFF



The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Spartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



### Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



### Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.

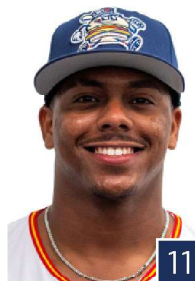
