**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Durham Bulls continue their series tonight at First Horizon Park. Keston Hiura came through with a go-ahead, three-run double last night that helped the Sounds to a 6-4 win. Right-hander Caleb Boushley starts for Nashville, facing Durham's Anthony Molina.

**Caleb Boushley:** 29-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his 21st start of the season tonight for the Sounds. The right-hander is 6-4 with a 4.45 ERA (95.0 IP/47 ER) in 2023. He spun his second quality start of the season his last time out, holding the Norfolk Tides to one run over 6.0 innings. July was Boushley's best month as he posted a 2-0 record and 3.91 ERA in four starts, two of which were quality. He currently ranks among league leaders in starts (T-1st), innings pitched (6th), ERA (6th), WHIP (10th, 1.40), and opponent average (10th, .269). The Hortonville, Wisconsin native was named the 2022 Sounds Pitcher of the Year after going 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA in 25 starts. The Brewers acquired Boushley in the Triple-A phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021. He was originally drafted in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of UW-La Crosse.

**Anthony Molina:** 21-year-old Anthony Molina makes his fifth appearance of the season (fourth start) for Durham. He is 0-1 with a 3.71 ERA (17.0 IP/7 ER) with the Bulls in 2023. Molina appeared out of the bullpen his last time out, allowing seven runs (2 ER) on 10 hits against Charlotte on July 27. Before his promotion to Durham on July 7, Molina went 2-5 with a 4.61 ERA in 15 starts for Double-A Montgomery. In 2022, the right-hander paced the Rays organization with 14 wins between High-A Bowling Green (13) and Single-A Charleston (1). Molina was signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2018 out of his native Venezuela.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 6 (Tied), Second: 9, Third: 9, Fourth: 4, Fifth: 0, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Sounds For Six:** Nashville's 6-4 win last night was fueled by a six-run sixth inning, which featured 10 plate appearances and RBI doubles from Keston Hiura (3-Run), Patrick Dorrian (1-Run) and Brian Navarrete (1-Run). It is the sixth time the Sounds have plated six runs or more in a frame this season. The most recent occurrence before last night was an eight-run sixth inning on July 21 vs. Jacksonville.

**Deals and No Deals:** Nashville's roster was affected greatly by yesterday's trade deadline. Catcher Alex Jackson was dealt to Tampa Bay for Triple-A RHP Evan McKendry. The backstop hit .286 with 12 home runs and 35 RBI in 45 games with the Sounds this season. Jackson will be in the lineup tonight for Durham, while McKendry will take the mound against his former team tomorrow night. Infielder Luis Urias was traded to Boston after hitting .233 in 29 games with Nashville. Though not on Nashville's active roster, right-handed pitcher Peter Strzelecki (AZ) was also dealt yesterday. Strzelecki spent most of the season with Milwaukee (30 G), but appeared in 38 games for Nashville over the last three seasons.

**Pat's Bat on Fire:** Infielder Patrick Dorrian extended his hitting streak to eight games with an RBI double in the sixth inning last night. He's batting .321 (9-for-28) with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, five runs and a 1.136 OPS during the span, which dates back to July 21.

**Strong Arm Barn:** The Nashville bullpen has allowed just one run over the last three contests (11.2 innings), striking out 12 over the span. They've posted the lowest ERA of any relief corps in the International League (4.21). Nashville relievers also lead the circuit in fewest home runs allowed (42), fewest walks allowed (195) and WHIP (1.38).

**Brew Crew on the Mend:** A trio of rehabbing Milwaukee Brewers appeared for Nashville last night. Two-time National League All-Star Brandon Woodruff made his third rehab start of the season (first with Nashville), striking out four over 4.2 innings. Infielder Brian Anderson played third base and batted second last night, going 1-for-4 with a walk. Left-handed reliever Bennett Sousa tossed a perfect eighth inning, striking out one.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has two players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 655-564 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Boushley spun his second quality start of the season his last time out, holding Norfolk to one run over 6.0 innings of work. He matched his career high with 102 pitches thrown. Nashville held on to win a rain-shortened game, handing Boushley his sixth win of 2023.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** In his career, Boushley has faced the Bulls four times in the regular season, compiling a 1-1 record and 4.15 ERA (17.1 IP/8 ER). Not included is his start against Durham in the 2022 International League Championship Game (L, 2.0 IP, 5 ER).

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made first Opening Day start for Nashville, pitching in Game 1 of the season-opening doubleheader against Louisville
- Allowed just one earned run over first two starts (1.42 ERA), both coming in doubleheaders
- Earned the win in back-to-back starts on April 26 vs. Omaha and May 2 at St. Paul...posted 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP/3 ER) over span
- Went 2-0 with a 2.13 ERA (25.1 IP/6 ER) with 22 strikeouts, 0.91 WHIP and .196 opponent average over five starts from April 20 - May 12
