### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and finish a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the sixth-of-18 games between the teams this season and sixth-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. New Hampshire returns to Reading from June 10-15 and the Fightin Phils head to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. Reading won the 2024 season-series over the Fisher Cats 11-6, and leads the season-series 3-2.

### Games 34/35 Recap

The Fightin Phils were swept in Saturday's doubleheader, falling 8-7 in game one and 4-3 in the second game of the twin bill. All five games this week have been one-run contests so far. In game one, Chuck King started and matched a career-high with three home runs surrendered, as he allowed six runs on eight hits over 4.1 innings pitched. Leandro Pineda had three hits, two runs and a RBI, and Felix Reyes had two hits and three RBI, including his third home run of the season. In the second game, Braeden Fausnaught suffered the loss, as he allowed four runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings of work. Aidan Miller and Keaton Anthony both stayed hot with hits in each game of the doubleheader, and Anthony had a double in both ends of the day on Saturday.

### It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller is currently riding a season-high six-game hitting streak, and is slashing .381/.458/.619 (1.077 OPS) over that stretch. Miller has now reached base in 25 of his last 28 games played in, dating back to April 12 and has a .350 on-base percentage over that span. Miller has also proven to be a threat on the base paths as his 13 steals rank tied for fourth in the Eastern League.

### Go Keaton Go

Keaton Anthony stayed red-hot with a double in both games of the doubleheader on Saturday. He has doubled in four-straight games, marking the first time a Fightin Phil had doubled in four-straight games since Madison Stokes did it from May 3-7, of the 2023 season. Since May 7 (eight games), Anthony is slashing .419/.455/.742 (1.197 OPS), with four runs, seven doubles, one home run and seven RBI. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 5th AVG (.318), 9th OBP (.374), 6th SLG (.527), 5th OPS (.901), 1st 2B (15), T-1st XBH (18) and 10th RISP AVG (.341).

### Mashing Mendez

Hendry Mendez picked up his second-straight multi-hit game on Friday night, and also homered in his second-straight contest as well. After not homering over the first 24 games he played in this season, Mendez now has home runs in three of the last eight games he's played in. This week, Mendez is slashing .353/.368/.824 (1.192 OPS), with four runs, two doubles, two home runs and five RBI.

### Let's Go Leandro

Leandro Pineda has turned things around in a big way, and it's continuing with an excellent week against New Hampshire. This week, Pineda is slashing .438/.500/.625 (1.125 OPS), with four runs, three doubles and two RBI. He has struck out just twice in 18 plate appearances.

### Alumni Spotlight

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Friday that Phillies No. 8 Prospect Mick Abel will make his Double-A debut on Sunday, starting on the mound against the Pittsburgh Pirates. Abel played in Reading in the back-part of the 2022 season and all of 2023. He struggled last season in Lehigh Valley (AAA), but has been spectacular for the IronPigs this season. Abel will become the first former R-Phil to make their big-league debut in 2025. With Abel's debut, the Phillies will become the last team in baseball to have a player make their major league debut this season.

### Packing the Park

Saturday's official attendance of 9,691 was the highest attendance at FirstEnergy Stadium since Aug. 25, 2018, when 9,787 fans watched Reading take on Portland. It was the first crowd over 9,000 since May 28, 2022, when it was 9,528 against Binghamton. Saturday marked the 21st largest crowd in the history of America's Classic Ballpark.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**May 18, 2011:** At Portland, the Phils score 10 runs over the final three innings to rally past the Sea Dogs, 13-4. Matt Rizzotti leads the charge, going 3-for-5 with two homers and five RBIs.

### Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters today with a 16-21 record, sitting in fifth place in the Northeast Division. 2024 was a down season for New Hampshire, as they finished with an Eastern League-worse 52-84 record. The Fisher Cats went 3-2 last week against Hartford at home and after this week return back home and welcome Somerset. The Fisher Cats' roster features six of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (13), RJ Schreck (20), Ryan Jennings (21), Jace Bohrofen (24), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

### On the Mound for the Cats

Righty Geison Urbaez makes the start tonight for the Fisher Cats. It will be his first start of the season as he has made six relief appearances and has a 0.79 ERA and 0-0 record (11.1 IP, 10 H, 4 BB, 10 SO). Urbaez last pitched May 11 vs Hartford, as he allowed no runs over one inning of work. Urbaez split last season between Dunedin (A) and Vancouver (A+), combining to go 1-1, with a 3.83 ERA over 18 games/six starts. He missed the entire 2023 season. The 24-year old signed with the Blue Jays in 2020 out of the Dominican Republic.
