TWO PIRATES ARE BETTER THAN ONE: On Tuesday, July 9, the Curve hosted MLB rehabs for RHP David Bednar and LHP Ryan Borucki. Bednar, recovering from a left oblique strain, and Borucki, recovering from left triceps tendinitis, are the second and third Pirates to rehab with Altoona this season after C Henry Davis played two games in late-June. Borucki and Bednar combined to toss 2.2 scoreless innings with 3 K's and allowed only one baserunner on a fielder error in their outing.

July 9 was the seventh time in franchise history that the Curve are hosting more than one Pirate on rehab in the same game, the first since 2022 when Altoona hosted INF/OF Tucupita Marcano, LHP Dillon Peters, and RHP Duane Underwood Jr. on June 28, 2022

SHUT THEM DOWN: Four of Altoona's seven shutout wins this season have come since June 1 (32 games).

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman Yoyner Fajardo has reached base safely in 21 straight games, during which he's batting .359/.452/.423 with 5 2B, 6 RBI, 12 BB, 10-11 SB Since June 1, his .337 batting average is 5th in the Eastern League.

QUITE A START: Since June 21 (16 games) Altoona starters have been the backbone of the team's success. Seven times in the last 16 games, a Curve starter has thrown a quality start (6.0 IP+ and 3 ER or fewer) with five outings lasting 7.0 innings or longer. Altoona's 3.54 ERA since June 21 is 7th-best among Double-A teams. Curve starters have gone 6-5 with a 2.85 ERA (28 ER / 88.1 IP) allowing 61 hits, 26 walks 0.99 WHIP) and 79 strikeouts in the last 16 games

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run four times in his last seven outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.64 FRA (14 FR / 47.2 IP) with 31 strikeouts

THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS: Righty Thomas Harrington matched his career-long with 7.0 scoreless innings on July 4 against Harrisburg. Since June 16 (4 starts) Harrington has gone 1-1 with a 1.57 ERA (4 ER / 23.0 IP) and allowed a 0.87 WHIP with 20 strikeouts. Harrington has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 8-of-10 outings with Altoona this year.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: Bubba Chandler has hit his stride since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 4 batters in 39.0 IP with 47 strikeouts, recording a 4-2 record with a 2.08 ERA (9 ER / 39.0 IP) with a 0.72 WHIP. Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23), the first to receive the honor since Mike Burrows and Quinn Priester took home weekly honors during the 2022 season. Since June 1, his 44 strikeouts are the 4th-most by a Double-A pitcher and he ranks 2nd in WHIP with a 0.69 mark.

Also of note, Chandler had consecutive 10 strikeout games on 6/21 at Bowie and 6/27 vs Akron. It was just the third time in franchise history that a Curve pitcher had struck out 10-or-more batters in back-to-back outings joining Tyler Glasnow (7/21/15 vs Erie, 7/26/15 vs Akron) and Roansy Contreras (5/4/21 vs Bowie and 5/11 at Binghamton). Chandler and Braxton Ashcraft's combined four 10-strikeout games this season make the Curve one of six teams, and the lone team at Double-A or Triple-A, to have two pitchers strikeout 10 or more in a game twice.

Chandler is also the 22nd player in franchise history to be selected to the MLB Futures Game which will take place on July 13 at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Altoona has had 21 players previously selected to the MLB All-Star Futures Game since its inception in 1999. C Henry Davis (2022), and RHP Roansy Contreras (2021) were the most recent players selected to the roster, 3B Ke'Bryan Hayes was the last Curve player to participate in the game, doing so in Washington, DC in 2018. Chandler would become the first active Curve player to pitch in the Futures Game since RHP Dovydas Neverauskas pitched in 2016 at Petco Park in San

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder Charles McAdoo made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo homered in each of the first two games he played for Altoona. He's reached base in 12-of-14 games since joining the Curve, batting .288/.413/.558/.971 with 3 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 6 RBI, 11 BB, and 12 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (90), 2B (18). RBI (58), T-4th in SB (15), and 2nd in OPS (.969), min. 150 AB's in minor leagues.

THE MEN FROM THE BAY: Roberto Mercado leads the Baysox after two seasons managing the Orioles High-A affiliate in Aberdeen. Mercado led the Ironbirds to a playoff appearance in 2022 and took home the organization's Cal Ripken Sr. Award given to the minor league instructor with the most dramatic impact during the season. The typically loaded Baysox are a bit light in the prospect department this year, but OF Dylan Beavers, C/DH Samuel Basallo and C Silas Ardoin highlight the osition player group.

THE FIRST TO PULL ON THEIR SOX: Seth Johnson takes the ball for Bowie tonight. Johnson didn't make it out of the first inning in his last start against Altoona on June 21. Johnson was drafted 40th overall in 2019 out of Campbell by the Tampa Bay Rays and was scooped up the Orioles in a 3-team deal that sent OF Tray Mancini to Houston while he was recovering from Tommy John surgery in 2022. Johnson previously tossed 4 scoreless innings against the Curve on April 17. Johnson is ranked as the No. 10 prospect in the Orioles system according to MLB Pipeline.

Told Andrew Destin of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette that he did not begin pitching until halfway through his Prep career at Southern Lee High School in Sanford, N.C.... Also played quarterback at Southern Lee... Mostly played shortstop prior to turning his attention to the mound... Had his senior season of high school baseball cut short by the COVID-19 Pandemic... Didn't receive significant interest from collegiate programs until late in his high school career and chose to walk-on at Campbell, a school located approximately 35 minutes from his hometown... Was put on scholorship after his freshman season at Campbell... Was the second-highest draft pick in Campbell and Big South Conference history, trails only teammate Zach Neto (Angels, 13th overall, 2022)... Has four siblings, Blake, Cooper, Ben and Elizabeth...
