- The Blue Jays fell behind early and couldn't overcome an 8-2 deficit in the final game before the All-Star break, dropping the series finale with Tampa 9-5.

- In a spot start, Juanmi Vasquez surrendered 5 earned runs in 2.1 innings and eventually took the loss.

- Arjun Nimmala lifted a seventh inning solo home run.

- The Blue Jays cut the lead to three with a two-RBI single from Robert Robertis in the bottom of the eighth inning.

BIG STRETCH

Coming out of the All-Star Break, the Blue Jays will play a very-important nine game stretch against the two teams ahead of them in the standings: three games at Lakeland, followed by six games at home with Fort Myers. Dunedin will host Lakeland for six games August 27-31. Their six game set with Fort Myers will be the final time the D-Jays play the Mighty Mussels this season.

SERIES SUCCESS

With last week's split with Tampa, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in eight of their last nine sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series). The lone series loss came at Lakeland, June 25-30, when the Flying Tigers took four of six games.

BREAKING ON A LOW NOTE

After winning three of the first four games against Tampa, Dunedin dropped the final two games of the series. Blue Jays pitching especially struggled, surrendering 19 runs on a whopping 30 hits - including a season-high 18 on 7/13.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

The Blue Jays have played 32 one-run games this season - the most in the FSL. The Jays are 16-16 in those contests. 58 of the Blue Jays 86 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 31-27 record in those games.

JAMMIN' IN JULY

The Blue Jays' team OPS in July stands at .805 through 12 games - the second-best mark in the FSL this month. Dunedin leads the league in runs scored this month, posing 65 (5.4 per game).

GIVING IT THE COLLEGE TRY

Of Toronto's 21 draft picks in last week's first year player draft, 16 were drafted out of college, including 10 of the team's first 11 selections. The selections could lead to an influx of college talent to Dunedin's roster. Of the team's 28 current players, just eight played college ball.

AWESOME ARJUN

Since making his return from FCL on June 27, Blue Jays No. 3 prospect Arjun Nimmala has found his stride at the plate. The 18-year old has a hit in 11 of his 14 games, hitting .300 with 11 XBH - including three home runs.

FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez represented Toronto in the All-Star Futures Game on July 13 in Texas, throwing one inning, allowing a solo homer. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.48), Ks (81), innings (75), and WHIP (1.01). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016. Perez had his best month of the season in June, pitching to a 2.86 ERA in 22 innings across four starts.

EIGHT IS SURE GREAT

Jorge Bautista's eight inning shutout effort on July 12 marked the first time since 2018 (Maverik Buffo, 7/9/2018 vs Clearwater) a Dunedin pitcher completed eight full innings. Bautista is the only hurler in the FSL to complete eight full innings this season and one of four pitchers to do so in Single-A in 2024. Despite the accomplishment, Bautista was not awarded FSL Pitcher of the week.

- Signed out of commitment to Texas Tech.
- Helped lead the Carlsbad Cavemen to a State Title in final high school season, starting at shortstop when he wasn't pitching. Hit .436 with 8 homers at the plate.
- Dad, Tim, pitched in the Padres system from 1997-99.
- Made pro debut with FCL Blue Jays last season; did not pitch following 2022 draft.
- Hometown of Carlsbad is located in southeastern New Mexico, 50 miles from Texas border. Carlsbad Caverns National Park is located 20 miles to the southwest.
