YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators, 7-4. Harrisburg opened a 1-0 lead in the second after KJ Harrison scored on an error, the only run allowed by **Phil Pfeifer** in his 4.0-inning start. In the bottom of the second, Pfeifer gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead with a two-run single, the first hit of his professional career. In the fourth, **Frankie Tostado** extended the lead to 3-1 with an RBI single. Harrisburg jumped ahead with three runs in the top of the sixth. Harrison scored after a fielding error and Ali Castillo drove a single to tie the game. Cole Freeman put Harrisburg in front, 4-3, with an RBI single. In the bottom of the seventh, **Sandro Fabian** put the Flying Squirrels back ahead for good with a two-run single. Tostado clubbed a two-run homer, his second of the season, in the eighth to open a 7-4 lead. **Jose Marte** stranded two runners on base in the eighth with a pair of strikeouts. In the ninth, **Norwith Gudino** left a pair of runners on base to close out his fifth save of the season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at The Diamond. This series marks the only trip to Richmond this season for the Senators. The Flying Squirrels played the Senators on their first road trip of the season from May 11-16 at FNB Field. Richmond won the first three games of the series, capped by a no-hitter on May 13. Harrisburg recovered to win the final three games of the series, earning a six-game split.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won six of their last eight games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 4.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is tied for seventh in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked second in the league with a 3.34 ERA for the season.

THE SENATORS have lost 11 of their last 15 games and are currently in sixth place in the Double-A Northeast, 13.5 games behind first-place Bowie and 9.5 games behind Richmond. The Harrisburg offense is ranked 12th in the league with a .189 batting average. The Senators pitching staff is ranked third in the league this season with a 3.60 ERA. Harrisburg's roster includes four of MLB.com's top Nationals prospects, including LHP Tim Cate (8), 1B Drew Mendoza (11), SS Jackson Cluff (17 - on IL) and Jakson Reetz (26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Trenton Toplikar** makes his fourth start of the season. He last pitched on Tuesday against the Senators and fired 6.0 scoreless innings in a combined shutout win. Overall this year, Toplikar has worked 8.0 scoreless innings against Harrisburg in two outings. He has pitched in relief four times this season, posting a 0.96 ERA. Toplikar was drafted in the 16th round by the Giants in 2018 out of UC Riverside. In 2019, Toplikar began the season with High-A San Jose and made eight starts and seven relief appearances, going 3-1 with a 3.98 ERA. He was sent to Low-A Augusta on June 12 of that season and worked as a starter the rest of the year, going 5-2 with a 3.62 ERA in ten starts. **For more on Toplikar, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Mario Sanchez makes his eighth start of the season and his fourth against Richmond. He faced the Flying Squirrels in the series opener on Tuesday and was charged with a loss after allowing two runs over 6.0 innings with a season-high nine strikeouts. He first faced the Flying Squirrels on May 11, allowing four runs over 5.0 innings in a loss. On May 16, he threw 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision against Richmond. Sanchez was originally signed by the Nationals as a free agent and pitched in their organization from 2012-2016. He was with the Phillies from 2017-2018 before returning to Washington in 2019. Sanchez is in his third season at Double-A, compiling a 15-11 record with a 3.08 ERA in 49 games (33 starts). He pitched for Reading in 2017, going 4-2 with a 3.20 ERA. He also pitched with the Senators in 2019, going 10-5 with a 2.85 ERA in 23 appearances (19 starts). That year, he was selected as an MLB.com Nationals Organizational All-Star.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last 10 games since June 1, **Sandro Fabian** is batting .481 (13-for-27) with one homer, five doubles and nine RBIs while scoring four runs. Last Friday, he hit his third home run of the season. He followed on Saturday by going 3-for-4 with a run scored, a Double-A career high in hits. He entered as a pinch-hitter on Tuesday against Harrisburg and drove a two-run double. In the first game of Thursday's double-header, Fabian went 2-for-4 with a pair of doubles. On Saturday night, Fabian drove a two-run double to put Richmond ahead in the seventh inning. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .289.

STRINGING THEM TOGETHER: **Vince Fernandez** homered in back-to-back games for the second time this year earlier this week. Fernandez homered on Sunday against Altoona, a two-run shot, and followed with a solo home run against the Senators in the series opener on Tuesday. He also went deep in back-to-back games in Harrisburg on May 15 and May 16.

LOBBYING IN THE UPPER HOUSE: **Vince Fernandez** has clubbed four home runs in 23 at-bats against the Senators during the 2021 season. He is batting .304 (7-for-23) against Harrisburg on the year. In 2019 as a member of the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies), Fernandez hit .235 (8-for-34) with two homers.

TORRES ON A TEAR: In his last six games since June 1, **Bryan Torres** is batting .438 (7-for-16) with one double and one RBI. He has seen time defensively this season at catcher and second base. Torres is in his first Double-A season. Prior to 2021, he had not played higher than the rookie level.

MO' TIME: Over his last five games since June 5, **Kyle Mottice** is batting .357 (5-for-17) with a double and three RBIs. On the season, he is batting .333 (11-for-33) against left-handed pitchers compared to .212 (11-for-52) against right-handers. He has hit the ball to the opposite field on 46.5 percent of his balls put in play, which is the second-highest rate in the Double-A Northeast, trailing only Erie's John Valente (48.8 percent).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the second-best bullpen ERA in the Double-A Northeast at 3.11 on the season, trailing only Harrisburg (2.45). The bullpen is tied for the league lead with 13 saves. **Norwith Gudino** is third in the Double-A Northeast this season with five saves and **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for fourth with four saves.

AMAYA REBOUNDS: After surrendering five runs (four earned) in his first two Double-A appearances on May 4 and May 8 (G2), reliever **Luis Amaya** has worked eight straight appearances without allowing an earned run. That stretch spans 9.2 innings of work. The span has lowered his season ERA from 15.43 through the first two outings to 3.00. He has not allowed a run in his last six outings, covering 8.0 straight scoreless innings.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 21-14 record is the second-best start in team history through 35 games, trailing only the team's 22-13 mark in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010. That year, the Flying Squirrels went 22-14 through 36 games, a mark the team can tie with a win today.

GETTING ON THE BOARD: Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 44 consecutive games. That streak includes all 35 games of the 2021 season. The next closest streak in the league is Bowie, which has not been shut out in 43 consecutive games dating back to August 23, 2019.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .240 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963. Harrisburg's .189 average this season would be the lowest in the EL/AA-NE since the 1963 restructuring, surpassing a .208 team average by the 1968 Waterbury Indians.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
